
**MESSAGE FROM

Introduction

The first step of prosperity was taken on 23rd November, 2009, when the then Vice Chancellor of University of Balochistan Professor Dr. Masoom YasinZai inaugurated the Sub-Campus Turbat of University of Balochistan as a pre-step of making an independent university within limited time.

The campus offered BBA 4 years, BSCS 4 years and B.Com 2 years in the first batch on January 2010. With the immense efforts and contribution of the devoted staff, the campus managed regular classes and cheating free environment. In an era of three and half years, two batches of B.Com were passed and the third batch will pass out at the end of current year.

The above mentioned efforts resulted to an independent university as University of Turbat on May 18, 2013 when the first Vice Chancellor Professor Dr. Abdul Razzak Sabir took over the charge. Soon he announced the admissions for master programs in four new departments. These programs are MA English, MA political Science, MA Balochi and MA Economics. Besides, currently University announces the admission in MBA 3.5 Years, M.Com and MCS programs. The university is seeking for the energetic and

devoted youth of the region who are enthusiastic to be engaged in academic activities for further serving the nation for a better cause.

Historical Background






GOVERNANCE





After completion of entire required formalities, submission of feasibility report, visit of the HEC evaluation team, and on their recommendation, the University of Turbat was recognized by the HEC Pakistan as 158th Public Sector University in the country and Second Public Sector General University in the Province vide Notification No. 15-40/HEC/ A&A/2013/1477 and dated 12th March 2014.

Introduction

Currently, the University is offering undergraduate and graduate program under two faculties i.e Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, and Faculty of Science and Engineering including the departments of Management Science, Computer Science, Commerce, English, Balochi, Political Science, Economics, Chemistry, and Education.

All the courses of different programs are aimed at research as niche, for which the students are encouraged to bring innovation and exploration in the fore as a prime task.

The sub Campus of University of Balochistan at Turbat has transformed into as a full-fledged University of Turbat, vide UoT Act. 2012, Bill No. 5 of 2012 of Balochistan Assembly, Quetta, vide Notification No. PAB/Legis: V (5)/2012 dated Quetta the 28th June 2012. It was functioning as a Sub Campus of University of Balochistan since 2009, and was offering the following three Bachelors level programs in the respective Departments:

Department of Management Sciences



The department of Management Sciences was established since the inception of the University of Balochistan, sub-campus Turbat on 23rd November, 2009 and started its classes on 1st January 2010. University hired four lecturers for the said department, and currently there are ten regular lecturers and six visiting lecturers. Besides these lecturers University of Turbat is about to induct four (4) more lecturers against the vacant vacancies of lecturers on study leave.

So far four BBA, one MBA (morning) and one MBA (Executive) batches are continuing their classes successfully. The first energetic batch of Bachelors of Business Administration has passed out on December 2013 and second BBA batch has passed out in December 2014.

In May, 2013 sub-campus Turbat was converted into University of Turbat along with its entire assets, liabilities and services. Soon after, the Vice Chancellor appointed Lecturer Waseem Barkat as the first Acting Chairman of the department.

After the depart of Mr. Waseem Barkat for Ph.D. in Malaysia, the Vice Chancellor appointed Mr. Mumtaz Ahmed as Acting Chairman of the Department of Management Sciences.

Soon after, the worthy Vice Chancellor decided to commence the Master of Business Administration (Executive) classes and within short span of time the MBA (Executive) classes started on 1st September 2013, and this batch will pass out in May 2015.

The Department has successfully started Master of Business Administration (Morning) as its third program of the department which were started on 1st January, 2014.

Computer Laboratories



The University of Turbat (UoT) has a well furnished and equipped computer labs working under the Computer Science Department and IT section of the University, there are more than 200 latest new computers have been provided to the University Computer Laboratory. This service provides net services to the Central Library, departments, faculty and administrative offices 24 hours. In the Central Labs, PCs are provided, offering a range of standard office software for document creation and presentations. Specialist provision is available to support research and advanced study within the University. Computers in the campus are connect- ed to the University's main server through a wide area network giving access via the internet to the major information, research and communications networks worldwide.

Transport Facilities



The University of Turbat has four buses to provide pick and drop facility to the students living in Turbat city and suburbs. The University also provides transport facility to its students for field work and annual picnics once a year to each department on need basis. The study tours for students are partly financed by the students and supplemented by the University, subject to availability of funds.



Cafeteria

The University of Turbat at its City Campus has a well-furnished Cafeteria having fast food and tea shop facilities only for campus students and faculty members.

University Public Library



ORIC

Introduction

The Information and Technology departments is highlighted some of its achievements during the period of 2014. The milestones achieved are enormous. Information Technology department is the backbone of any organization. Internet has made the world a global village. Information Technology is the gateway that global village. Organization are empowering their Information and Technology departments to meet the challenges of modern era. University of Turbat has established its Information Technology department in 2013 and Muhammad Sameer was assigned the charge of Information Technology Department. One of the achievements after affiliation was to get connected to Pakistan Education and Research Network (PERN 2) by Higher Education Commission. On 1 Nov, 2014 The University was enlisted in PERN 2.

Matter related to Information Technology are overseen and regulated by Information Technology department. Inter-departments are provided technical assistance for smooth work progress. For better communication, Infrastructure for internet is developed. Fully furnished computer labs with latest specification, each system fully integrated with latest software and capable of running the up to date graphic tools such as Auto CAD and Maya etc. Wi-Fi Service is provided to students, faculty and administration. Students can access network and internet resources through different hotspots. For security measures Wi-Fi clients are allowed to access internet with proper registration. Information Technology department enhances the collaboration of internal departments and administration with in University.

The National Education Research and Education Network, Pakistan (PERN 2)

University of Turbat has achieved one its milestones being connected to PERN 2. Pakistan Education & Research Network is the only research and education network of Pakistan which was launched in 2002. The purpose of this national research and education network is to provide communication infrastructure to the universities, institutions of higher learning



and research organizations to meet their networking and internet requirements. The network has evolved significantly and is providing valuable services, like high-speed internet, audio/video conferencing, and access to digital library resources.

FINANCE

Salient Features

The main source of financing of University of Turbat at present are the project funds. The project, titled "Establishment of University of Turbat" was approved by the ECNEC during May 2011 at a total cost of Rs. 1580.391(M).

Although the commencement year of the Project given in the PC-I was 2011-12 and funds amounting to Rs.25(M) and Rs.10(M) were released during Financial year 2011-2012 and 2012-13 respectively ; however, the project was actually started during the Financial Year 2013-14 after induction of full time VC and other key officers namely PVC, Director Finance/Treasurer and Controller Exams.


The Project had provisions for Civil works as well as for other operational and administrative costs such as HRD (Scholarships), purchase of various equipment, furniture and fixtures, books and journals, transport and security systems, salaries for faculty, administrative staff and project execution staff and miscellaneous operational expenses.

In the PC-1, the academic activities of the

university were projected to be started during the 5th year i.e. after completion of the Project; however, as per decision of the government; the academic activities were started during 2009, initially under Turbat campus managed through UoB and later on from July 2013, managed by UoT itself.

This change in schedule of academic activities as well as the time gap between the preparation of the PC-I and starting actual project on ground, created a wide gap between the PC-I provisions and actual costs incurred/ to be incurred. This has necessitated revising the PC-I and the revised PC-I has already been prepared and is under process for approval of the competent forum. In the meanwhile, in the light of the guidelines given by HEC, civil works have been awarded to a numbers of Contractors up to the overall financial limit of PC-I although the individual cost items have increased the PC-I limits. This has mostly happened in the case of civil work components and pay and allowances.

The position of receipts and expenditures of the project funds up to 30th June, 2014 is as under.

As can be seen from the above table, the total expenditures of the project were higher as compared to the funds received through HEC. The short fall was met from Bridge financing and Grant in aid provided by GOB to meet financial commitments of the Project. Had these funds not been provided by the Provincial government; the project work could not have been started as per schedule resulting in more delays and further increase in rates.

Revenue (Recurring) Expenditures and Receipts

Although the commencement year of the Project given in the PC-I was 2011-12 and funds amounting to Rs.25(M) and Rs.10(M) were released during Financial year 2011-2012 and 2012-13 respectively ; however, the project was actually started during the Financial Year 2013-14 after induction of full time VC and other key officers namely PVC, Director Finance/Treasurer and Controller Exams.

Budget for Recurring Expenditures

In order to reduce the burden on the development funds and to meet a number of non-development (Recurring) expenditures for the F/Y 2014-15, HEC was requested for granting an amount of Rs. 153 (M) under recurring budget; however, HEC has allocated an amount of only Rs. 30(M) under this head for the Financial Year 2014-15 out of which Rs. 8(M) have been released up to 30th September 2014.


Endowment Fund

The honorable Chief Minister of Balochistan Dr. Abdul Malik Baloch, had announced during the stone laying ceremony of the UoT Project on 06th February 2014, to provide funds for establishment of Endowment fund. Accordingly an amount of Rs. 50(M) was received from GOB during last quarter of F/Y 2013-14 which was invested in three years term deposit in NBP @ 11.75 % P.a after obtaining comparative rates of interest through open and transparent bidding.

This fund is meant for investment in the long term deposit/securities in order to meet long term financial needs of the University and the profits/interest are utilized for providing scholarships and other benefits to the Students.

Grant in Aid






International Day of Mother Languages was celebrated, at University of Turbat






He also said that the UoT is a new higher




educational institution in the province and it has deep relations with the UoB. More agreements would be signed with the University (UoT) in order to improve the existing relations in future, he vowed.




HEC Team visit for Evaluation & Recognition





aromatic taste.



Department of Computer Science Holds “Hour of Code” at Campus





A Brilliant Life Cut Short




