UoT Holds the 2nd Meeting of the Academic Council

The second meeting of UoT Academic Council was held here on 19th September, 2014. Vice Chancellor University of Turbat Prof Dr Abdul Razzaq Sabir chaired the meeting. He gave a brief summary of the University achievements of the past one and half years. He said that University of Turbat had achieved a great deal in a relatively short period of time. Getting recognized from Higher Education Commission, successfully conducting regular classes for M.A and MSc, induction of new Faculty members, Foreign Scholarships for the Faculty, setting up a state of the art library and laboratories were some of the highlights down the lane of its success story. The Vice Chancellor further stated the University of Turbat was endowed with the sacred mission of filling the educational vacuum in the region and expressed his gratitude to the people of Mekran for their unwavering commitment toward the cause of Education and reposing their confidence in the newly established University.



In the meantime, in order to shore up the domain of higher learning and Educational research, the Academic Council reached some vital decisions that included initiating Science subjects in UoT, encouraging students and faculty towards research and according approval of the Committee for getting the colleges in Mekran affiliated with University of Turbat. The council also approved different Boards of Faculty for Arts and Science subjects, agreeing to of the recommendations put up by the board and selection of new Chairpersons for different Departments as well as starting MPhil classes in the departments with PhD Faculty. The council agreed to recommendations that different Diploma and Certificate courses under Departments of Computer Science, English and Commerce may be started to cater the growing needs of the local youth.

Pro VC UoT Dr Abdul Saboor, Registrar Mohammad Hayat, Controller Examinations Tanvir Wadar and the Head of Departments, along with other members also attended the meeting.

UoT Holds its 2nd Finance and Planning Committee Meeting

The 2nd meeting of UoT Finance and Planning Committee was held here on 19th Oct, 2014 at the Main Campus of University of Turbat. Vice Chancellor UoT Prof Dr Abdul Razzaq Sabir presided over the meeting. While addressing the members, Vice Chancellor UoT reiterated his commitment to the provision of quality Education in Mekran and expressed his satisfaction over the overall pace of developmental projects at University of Turbat. He held that the recent decision to incorporate Science

Subject at the university is monumental and will provide the locals with the opportunity to study Science Subjects right in their hometown, obviating the need to cover long distances for the same.



In the meanwhile, the Finance and planning committee took some important decisions that included the approval of next UoT annual budget, establishing UoT endowment fund, monitoring the revision of PC 1 so that developmental projects get completed well in time and according approval to the UoT Fee structure.

The meeting was attended by Prof. Dr. Abdul Razzaq sabir, in chair, PVC UoT Dr. Abdul Saboor, Pro VC LUWMS Dr. Gul Hassan, Managing Director PPRA Balochistan, Noor ul Haq Baloch. Registrar UoT, Mohammad Hayat, Director Finance UoT, Ghulam Farouq, Controller Examinations UoT, Tanvir Ahmed, and the Chairpersons Departments of Management Sciences, and Commerce, Mumtaz Ahmed and Mohammad Mushtaq respectively.

UoT Holds its 3rd Finance and Planning Committee Meeting

Later on the third meeting of the Finance and Planning Committee took place at Karachi on 15th of November, 2014, and it was chaired by VC UoT, Prof. Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir, in which the revised PC-1 of the University of Turbat was discussed in detail and approved.

UoT inks MoU with UNDP

University of Turbat has inked a MoU with United Nations Development Program (UNDP) Pakistan, to provide a framework of cooperation and facilitate collaboration between the Parties, on a non-exclusive basis, in areas of common interest, including collaborate in enhancing civic education by engaging UN Youth Volunteers from the University. To establish coordination mechanism between the University, and UNDP Pakistan is also a main clause of the MoU. It is worth mentioning that this is the first ever MoU inked by University of Turbat with an International Organization.



UoT Obtains PERN Service Access

University of Turbat has achieved one its milestones being connected to PERN 2. Pakistan Education & Research Network is the only research and education network of Pakistan which was launched in 2002. The purpose of this national research and education network is to provide communication infrastructure to the universities, institutions of higher learning and research organizations to meet their networking and internet requirements. The network has evolved significantly and is providing valuable services, like high-speed internet, audio/video conferencing, and access to digital library resources.

Lecture Program on Balochi Linguistics by Dr. Gul Hassan (PVC, LUAWMS)

Department of Balochi, University of Turbat, organized a lecture program entitled "The origin of Balochi Language." As the topic referred, the speaker of the day Dr. Gul Hassan gave a comprehensive lecture on the Balochi Language, starting from the very foundations of the language and its birth.



The occasion was blessed with the presence of Vice Chancellor, Pro-Vice Chancellor, Registrar, Chairperson Department of Balochi, Faculty members and the students of the concerned department.

Dr. Gul Hassan, Pro-Vice Chancellor (LUAWMS) Uthal had gave an in depth historical background on the genesis of the language and discussed all the aspects. During the session, the students asked several questions related to the topic and recieved convincing replies.

After the lecture concluded, both the Vice Chancellor and the Pro-Vice Chancellor put forward their gratitude to the speaker and admired the role of the Department of Balochi in taking such steps. One Day Training/Workshop for the Visiting Faculty of UoT

University of Turbat felt vacancies when its different lecturers from Department of Commerce and Management Science, proceeded abroad for higher education. So the departments has to hire faculty to continue academic activities.



On hiring different visiting faculty members, a One-Day Training session was organized on 19th, September, 2014. With Mr. Mukhtar Hussain from Computer Science Department and Ms. Samina Faqir from Economics Dept as the resource person. The training enabled the participants to improve their teaching and communication skills. The training included two sessions, first session was of Microteaching and the other session comprised the semester rules.



Two months training at HEC Islamabad Master Trainer Faculty Professional Development Program

On 22nd August, 2014, Mushtaq Mohammad Badini, Lecturer/Chairperson of Department of Commerce joined a 2 month long training at HEC Islamabad under 23rd Master Trainer Faculty Professional Development Program.

The teaching is an instructional procedure designed to relate to the objectives of teaching and material available. Teaching is a rational ordering and balancing in the light of knowledge and purpose, of the several elements that enter into the educative process, the nature of pupil and the total learning situation.

During the entire session of the training Mr. Mushtaq learned that how one can improve the techniques of effective teaching methods specially through micro teaching which does not only limited with the techniques but with the small activities in the class can contribute a lot towards effective teaching. Overall there were different modules of training but the micro teaching module was very fruitful because it was

comprises of two modules and took almost seven days (combined with micro teaching cycle 1 and 2). Communication skill cycle was very interesting and very much related to the intended purpose of the training because the key to effective teaching is the effective communication skill. As one said that "if all my possessions were taken from me with one exception, I would hope to keep my power of communication For by it I would regain all the rest"

The training was very interesting and very much informative, the contents were good, facilities were good, supervisors, trainers, extracurricular activities, tour and trips, lower staff cooperation each and every thing was remarkable. HEC's efforts regarding faculty professional development is on the mark and is appreciable.

Two New Departments Introduced in UoT
