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## INTRODUCTION

The people of the Mekran in Balochistan had always longed for a university nearby. Their dream finally materialized in the shape of a full fledge University in May 2013 under the University of Turbat Act 2012. This was made possible due to the zealous efforts put in by academic and administrative staff at the sub campus with the support of natives, political parties, provincial government and management of University of Balochistan. Despite the heavy odds and daunting challenges, University of Turbat is on way to bring educational revolution in the domain of higher learning in Mekran Division.



Soon after taking oath as Governor Balochistan, Honorable Mohammad Khan Achakzai and then Chief Minister Balochistan Honorable Dr. Abdul Malik Baloch extended exceptional support and assistance for the development of University of Turbat.

Professor Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir and Professor Dr Abdul Saboor Baloch took over the charge as first Vice Chancellor and Pro Vice Chancellor University of Turbat respectively.

Within a short span of time of three years the Vice chancellor and his team with the support of qualified faculty members and energetic and smart working administrative staff, introduced graduate and post-graduate programs in various departments

including Department of Management Sciences, Computer Science, Commerce, English, Political Science, Economics, Education, Chemistry and Balochi with M. Phil courses.

Since its inception as Sub Campus of University of Balochistan in November 2009, the program of BBA 4 years, BSCS 4 years and B. Com two years have already been introduced in the Campus.

With eight hundred students and around 90 employees, the University has been providing financial assistant to students through Prime Minister Reimbursement scheme, Balochistan Endowment Fund, and Need Based Scholarship. The pass out graduates and alumni of University are expected to play a vital role in the activities of Pak China Economic Corridor to bring prosperity in the region.

Following the nonstop academic success and unfaltering achievements along with the completion of entire formalities, the University of Turbat was recognized by the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan as 158<sup>th</sup> public Sector University in the country and second public Sector General University in the province on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2014 within short period of only 10 months after switching over to a full-fledge University from a sub campus.

In this short span of time university of Turbat earned number of accolades which have been acknowledged by the society and people from all walks of life in the region and in the province.

Universities are recognized and acknowledged worldwide mainly by its research and publications output going hand in hand with academic development. Research and publications have been the defining distinction of the University of Turbat ever since its establishment. Earnest efforts are consistently made to promote a vibrant research culture and provide a conducive environment to both its faculty members and students for exploration and innovative market oriented higher learning. University of Turbat launched its very own annual research journal GIDROSHIA for this specific purpose while Department of Balochi also plans to bring out its research journal (MEERI) in near future.

The Office of Research, Innovation, and Commercializing (ORIC) with the aim to promote and enhance research activities, providing a complete platform to the researchers and augments their research skills from working bench to a furnished product.

As many as 32 faculty members have been sent to different universities of Pakistan and abroad for M. Phil, MS and PhD under local, split and foreign scholarship program as per approved PC-1. Ten among them have rejoined the institution after completion of their studies. Half of them after completion of their degree are expected re-join University of Turbat in the end of 2018.

As per as research and publication is concerned, a bi-annual newsletter “KECH NEWS” is another symbol of distinction for the University. Therefore, University of Turbat is enlisted as one of those successful general Universities which have achieved the enviable feat of publishing their Annual Research Journal, Bi-annual Newsletter, Annual Report and Prospectus



in such a short span of time. This is truly a big success story for a university in such a far flung and remote area in the province having less access to the main cities in the province and country. University of Turbat, being a student centric university, is extending all possible facilities to its students for quality higher learning, research, and extracurricular activities. Having established a well-furnished and equipped computer lab with special grant in aid by honorable governor Balochistan

Muhammad Khan Achakzai with latest computers, graphic cards connected with internet giving access to the major information and communication networks worldwide to enhance research culture and advanced studies within the university.

Directorate of Information Technology, the backbone of the university, is one of the paramount achievements, connected to Pakistan Education and Research Network (PERN 2) by the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan, providing Wi-Fi services to students, faculty members and administrative staff.

Two libraries namely campus library and university public library with more than eighteen thousand books on different subjects, national and international research journal, publications, periodicals, and newspapers.

Moreover, Directorate of Public Relations, a career counseling and affairs cell have been established to help the students to resolve job related issues such as finding work and setting career goals.

Despite its own hostels for girls and boys, University of Turbat has also rented two building for boys' hostel, one for girls' hostel and one building for guest house where all basic needs and facilities are provided.

Auditorium, seminar Hall, university sport complex and walking track are the worthwhile facilities for the students and faculty members.

University also provides transport facility to its students for pick and drop, field work and annual educational trips. There is also a well-furnished Cafeteria with fast food and tea shop facilities for students and faculty members.

The Quality Enhancement Cell (QEC) with the support of Quality Assurance Agency of Higher Education Commission of Pakistan is working effectively according to the needs of modern time in a changing world. It is vested with the responsibility to ensure quality education with the futuristic mindset, encourage different academic activities, faculty training and development workshop, and preparing self-assessment of different departments.

University of Turbat organizes seminars, workshops, training sessions, literary and academic events, international lecture series, business galas, sport festivals and study tours for the students.

University of Turbat has signed a number of MOUs with leading national and international universities including educational institutions for promotion of higher learning and research skills and to exchange a framework of cooperation and facilities with the signatories.

University of Turbat also plans to sign more MOUs with national and international educational institutions in near future. University succeeded to hold the meetings of its statutory and other bodies like Syndicate, Academic Council, Finance and Planning, Faculty Council and Board of Studies, as well as senate meeting well in time.

**Sub Campus at Gwadar:** Soon after the principle approval of Honorable Governor Balochistan/ Chancellor University of Turbat Muhammad Khan Achakzai and on directives of the Higher Education Commission Pakistan, University of Turbat has set up its Sub Campus at Gwadar, and Mr. Ijaz Ahmed Baloch was assigned the charge as coordinator Gwadar Campus.

University of Turbat Sub Campus in CPEC central city Gwadar will be transformed into a full fledged university of Gwadar at par with international standard in near future. Initially, BS and Diploma programs in some market oriented subjects will be started in the Sub Campus Gwadar from the academic year, starts from January 2017, to meet higher education needs of the people of Gwadar and rest of the area.

University of Turbat has also been assigned the task by Higher Education Commission Pakistan to prepare a PC-1 for a full fledged University of Gwadar to be established in near future. University of Turbat will submit the Charter of University of Gwadar to concern forums for approval very soon.

**Development Work:** Under the University of Turbat Project, the civil work on university building at Ginna some 15 kilometer away from Turbat city at north is fast underway, four academic blocks and admin block have been completed and the classes of new academic year 2017 will be started in its newly built complex. The new building is comprised on academic



block, admin block, central library, boy's hostel, girl's hostel, residential colony, sports complex, Family Park, mosque, and a Medical Center.

**Future plans:** Many ideas and projects are in pipeline as the part of short and long term strategic plan of the University of Turbat. Introducing new science and market oriented subjects, sending more scholars abroad for higher studies, training and refreshment courses, starting Ph.D., M. Phil, diploma and certificate classes in different subjects, affiliation of degree colleges and educational institutions with university of Turbat, hosting more national and international conferences, searching more internship programs in reputable firms, company in public and private sectors for students and generating revenue by its own resources are among the main mission of future roadmap of the university of Turbat.

- To impart Higher quality education to the least privileged region of the country by providing tertiary education at the door step of general population of Mekran in particular and Balochistan in general.
- To provide tertiary education facility in each field of science and arts at an international standard.
- To bring a research culture in the society by imparting the research as a key ingredient of the academic activities.
- To provide a research oriented system in which the entire faculty and students will be engaged in the assignments of research.

## **STUDENTS AFFAIRS SECTION**

This office plays the role of catalyst towards the integrity, excellence and good image of students. In accomplishment of the roles, In-charge Student Affairs is responsible to act as a bridge between the administrative staff and students. Office of Student Affairs, University of Turbat, is an administrative function section under the leadership of Committee of the University. The primary function of the committee is to inform the Deans of the concern departments about student problems or suggest courses of action or to recommend policy and to seek improvements for the development of students. The students that participate in the Student Affairs Committee are the liaisons between the department and the students, and the Dean's Office. Student affairs section is responsible for creating an environment for the students to express their concerns related to curriculum and non- curriculum activities and to provide them opportunities for their personal growth.

Moreover, office attends to students' problems and coordinate students' activities for their personality grooming. In addition, the department arranges study trips, organizes sports events, Gala and debates that will help in nurturing the potential capacity of the students.

## **STUDENTS CODE OF CONDUCT**

University of Turbat is committed to provide high quality education that is compatible with changing needs of the world. University of Turbat has right to expect from students to maintain principle values, pursue exceptional conduct and character in campus. At the same time, students have the responsibility to conduct themselves in a lawful manner and in compliance with the University's standards. The purpose of this Code is to specify acts of student misconduct for which an offending individual will be subject to disciplinary sanctions under the University Disciplinary Procedures.

The Code of Conduct specifies behaviors that students should avoid as they are inconsistent with the essential values of the university. A student shall be held accountable through the University Discipline Process if he/she makes the decision to engage in these behaviors.

The Code of Conduct behaviors include, but are not limited to:

### **ABUSE/ENDANGERMENT/HAZING OF A PERSON**

Physically harming or threatening to harm any person, intentionally or carelessly causing harm to any person or creating a condition that endangers the reputation and safety of self or other students.

## VIOLATION OF ACADEMIC INTEGRITY

Academic integrity is a basic guiding principle for all academic activity at University of Turbat, and all students of the University are expected to act in accordance with this principle. Students should act with personal integrity and respect other students' dignity and rights. Academic integrity includes a commitment not to engage in or tolerate acts of falsification, misrepresentation or deception.

### **CHEATING**

Cheating is an act or an attempted act of deception by which a student seeks to Copy of all or any portion of another's academic work and submitting it as one's own or allowing another person to copy one's own paper during Exam or Quizzes—whether intentionally or irresponsibly.

### **INVOLVEMENT**

A student shall not assist another student, group of students in committing or attempting to commit a violation of this Code of Conduct. A student who has knowledge that another person committing or attempting to commit a violation of the Code of Conduct, is responsible to stop him amicably or to convey such act/intention to the knowledge of University administration, and failure to do so when reasonable under the circumstances may be the basis for a violation of this policy.

### **FALSE INFORMATION**

Making a false or misleading oral or written statement that misrepresents the character, qualifications, or reputation of other students will be held accountable through the University Discipline Process.

### **ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND SMOKING**

University of Turbat has strictly prohibited Students to possess alcohol, using drugs and smoking in university campus and hostels; severe action shall be taken against those who found to be guilty in violation of the rule.

### **DANGEROUS OBJECTS**

The possession or use of any potentially dangerous object or weapon, including but not limited to: ammunition, hunting knives, swords, firearms, other explosives, is prohibited.

## **DAMAGE OR DESTRUCTION**

Actions involving the students to endanger or actually harm or ruin University property are tantamount to breaching the code of conducts and shall be treated as a crime.

## **CODE OF HONOR**

The University of Turbat Honor Code is at once an objective and ruling. University of Turbat established in the year of 2012 with a mission to provide quality education and committed to excellence, tradition and innovation that makes it unique institute of the province and as well as in the country. The injunction is simple that students must have to follow it in order to preserve the smooth running of university activities.

Students vow never to lie, steal or cheat and accept that the consequence for flouting this assurance is permanent dismissal from the University. Students have to face grave consequences if they found breaching or violating code of honor.

## **QUALITY ENHANCEMENT CELL (QEC)**

As per requirements and guidelines laid down in Quality Assurance Manual of Higher Education Commission Quality Enhancement Cell (QEC) at UoT was established in July, 2013. The function of the QEC is to promote quality culture in Higher Education by ascertaining the implementation of quality standards and continuous enhancement of the quality parameters. QEC at UoT has responsibility of quality assurance and enhancement with immense dedication and loyalty. ### **Category C: Others**

Specific number of seats is reserved for all other applicants. List of such applicants is as follows.

1. Direct dependents of Personals serving in Balochistan, domiciled outside Balochistan.
2. Direct dependents of Pakistanis working abroad.
3. Foreign students.
4. Disabled persons.
5. Sports Quota Students in category C must submit an affidavit in a format provided in Appendix B.

Note: If the seats in Category B and C are not fulfilled then the same will be provided to the students of Category A.

## ADMISSION POLICY

### BACHELOR'S PROGRAM

#### Admission Criteria

##### Who Can Apply

- Intermediate or equivalent with at least 2nd division from any recognized Board /University.
- Minimum 45% total marks or 2.00/4.00 CGPA in the last degree in any discipline from any university recognized by the HEC.
- Minimum qualifying marks in the Entrance Test is 50%.
- Have to qualify the entry test and to appear before the Admissions Committee for an interview on the Specified date and time.

##### How to Apply

- Admission form is available in admin section of university. Admission form can be obtained against payment of Rs.300/- from Habib Bank Limited, Turbat branch.
- Application can be submitted at the admission office. (09:00 a.m. to 02.p.m)
- Following documents should be submitted along with the application form.
- Photocopy of National Identity Card and local certificate.
- Photocopies of mark sheets and certificates of Intermediate, and Matriculation.
- Three recent passport size photographs.

##### Determination of Admission Merit

- Minimum qualifying marks in the Entrance Test is 50%.
- Have to qualify the entry test and to appear before the Admissions Committee for an interview on the specified date and time.

## NEW SEMESTER RULES AND REGULATIONS OF UNIVERSITY OF TURBAT

The New Semester Rules and Regulations of UoT have been developed in the light of Higher Education Commission of Pakistan Semester's Guidelines and, in line with the semester rules of some other leading universities of Pakistan.

### ➤ **ORIENTATION WORKSHOPS ON NEW SEMESTER RULES AND REGULATIONS.**

Examination Controller Office organizes series of Orientation Workshops on New Semester Rules and Regulations for both Faculty and New comer students ever year accordingly. These rules and regulations are imparted to newly faculty members and new comer's students under different programs.

### **ATTENDANCE, STRUCKOFF AND READMISSION**

1. Students shall have to be punctual and regular to attend all lectures/seminars, laboratory periods, and Field work as required for each course during the semester session. A student shall be eligible to appear in the terminal examination provided that he/she has attended not less than 75% (cumulative) of lectures/seminars delivered in all theory courses. He/she has to complete 75% attendance in the laboratory/field work for grading of laboratory / fieldwork course.
2. The name of a student will be stuck off if his/her monthly attendance is less than 25%.
3. The student will have to get himself/herself readmitted within one week with fee Rs.500/- and within further three (03) days with fee Rs.1000/-. On failure of readmission, his/her admission shall stand cancelled.
4. There will be three chances only, for readmission for a four years' program and two chances for a two years' program. A student readmitted 3/2 times during the session of study program shall not be allowed a further readmission and his/her admission shall stand cancelled.
5. A student seeking readmission shall not be exempted from the payment of readmission fee.
6. A student will not be allowed to sit for terminal examination of any semester unless he/she has no out-standing dues for the said semester. Accounts Branch of the University will issue a clearance certificate in this regard.



## **ACADEMIC STANDARDS AND COMPUTATION OF GRADES**

1. A student must secure Grade D to promote in a course.
2. A grade F will be awarded to a student in a course for not achieving the desired competency. The student will have to reappear in all assignments, quizzes, mid-term and terminal examinations when offered subsequently. No special classes will be conducted by the Department for such students.
3. A student must maintain GPA of 2.00 on a cumulative basis during his/her academic program, any student with a GPA less than 1.50 will be dropped from the rolls of the University forthwith.
4. A student securing a GPA between 1.50 and 2.00 will be put on probation for one semester.
5. At the end of semester, student will be required to improve his/ her GPA and bring it up to the required minimum of 2.00.
6. If a probationer shows an improvement, but his GPA is still below 2.00 his/ her probation may be extended for another semester.
7. If he/ she still fail to bring his / her GPA to 2.00 by the end of the next semester he/ she will be dropped from the rolls of the University.
8. A student with Grade D can repeat the course, when offered by the department.
9. GPA is computed at the end of each semester.

# Facilities available for Students



## Libraries

Libraries play a pivotal role in the academic life of a University. Libraries should not be considered as store of books, journals and magazines but as a dynamic instrument of education. The University of Turbat is lucky to have three libraries at its inception stage.

### The City Campus library

Situated in the heart of the UoT City Campus building which is organized on above lines. The books and reading material available in City Campus Library support not only every course in the curriculum i.e. Management Sciences, Commerce, Economic, Political Science, English and Balochi but also include selected stock of general material of books on History, Anthropology, Islamic Studies, Geography, Archeology, Regional Studies, languages and literature, published by National and International publishers, Library also has sub-scribe national and international periodicals, publications, news-papers in English, Urdu and Balochi etc. The whole library system at campus library is being computerized and HEC has been asked to provide facilities for online library service which will be available through a net Work. The library also has a reasonable number of inter-nationally published Research Journals.

### University Public Library

The University of Turbat has a very impressive and vast library building in the mid of the city having more than 6000 books on different subjects including anthropology, archeology, his-tory, Islamic studies, geography, languages and literature, regional studies, etc. published by national and international publishers.

The University Public library remains open to all students, teachers, researchers and its members from different walks of life from Turbat and suburbs from 10:00 a.m. to 2.00 pm and from 4.00 pm to 8:00 p.m. On-line research facilities and access to internet are conveniently available to teachers as well as students.



## Digital Library

The University of Turbat is planning to establish a digital library to provide researcher's access to the International scholarly literature to the faculty members and students of the University. The facility will be based on online electronic delivery system. The Digital Library will also provide access to high quality peer-re-viewed journals database and articles on a wide range of discipline to the scholars and students up to the mid of 2014.

## Video Conference

The University of Turbat has developed two Video Conference Hall to provide facility to around 50 to 150 people at a time. The main purpose of this video conferencing facility is to develop communication and interaction through distance learning at global-level.

## Computer Labs

The University of Turbat (UoT) has three well-furnished and equipped computer lab working under the Computer Science Department and IT section of the University, there are more than 70 latest computers have been provided to the University Computer Laboratory. This service provides net services to the Central Library, departments, faculty and administrative offices 24 hours. In the Central Labs, PCs are provided, offering a range of standard software for document creation, graphic card and presentations. Specialist provision is available to support research and





advanced study within the university. Computers in the campus are connected to the University's main server through a wide area network giving access via the internet to the major information, research and communications networks worldwide.

### **TUTORIAL AND GUIDANCE AND CAREER COUNSELING CELL**

In University of Turbat a Tutorial and Guidance Services section working under Quality Enhancement Cell facilitates the learning process of the students and makes them able to establish their educational and professional objectives. The tutors during the course of studies keep in touch with the progress and development of the students and help them to solve those issues which are likely to affect their academic recital. The counseling cell guides the students for their future career/jobs and helps them to establish and achieve their vocational goals. It plans to arrange lectures and presentations by professionals to guide the youth for their future plans.

### **STUDENT FINANCIAL AID OFFICE**

University of Turbat under its Finance Directorate has established a student Financial Aid office to find ways to bring scholarships for the needy students.



## TRANSPORT FACILITY

The University of Turbat has five buses to provide pick and drop facility to the students living in Turbat city and suburbs. The University also provides transport facility to its students for field work and annual picnics once a year to each department on need basis. The study tours for students are partly financed by the students and supplemented by the University, subject to availability of funds.

## AUDIO VISUAL AIDS

The University of Turbat from its inception is using audio-visual aids in the class rooms, workshops, and seminars to facilitate the students and research scholars during their learning process.

## MEDIA AND PUBLICATION WING

A six monthly Newsletter “KECH NEWS” is the main organ of the University publishing academic, extra-curricular activities and other achievements of the University. The Newsletter publishes twice a year. Vice Chancellor Dr Abdul Razzaq Sabir is the editor in chief and Director Public Relations Mr. Ijaz Ahmed is the editor of the Newsletter. University of Turbat publishes an Annual Research Journal ‘GIDROSHIA’ from the year 2013 having research articles by researchers, University teachers, and interested scholars on various aspect of Social Sciences, Arts and Humanities, Business and Management Sciences, Computer Science, Earth Sciences, Natural Sciences



and Basic Sciences.

### **HOSTELS:**

There are hostel facilities for male and female, including all basic facilities, i.e. bed, foam, Indoor game, water cooler, kitchen, grassy. Furthermore, security facilities are available for female and male hostel.

### **CAFÉ TERIA**

The University of Turbat at its City Campus has a well-furnished Café Teria having fast food and tea shop facilities only for campus students and faculty members.

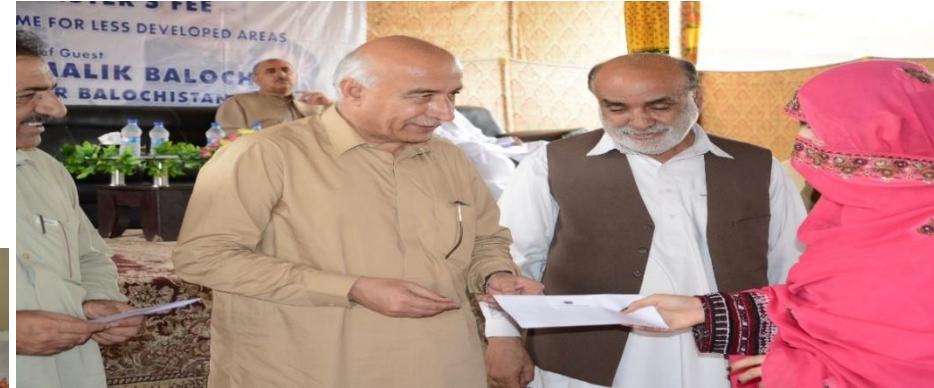
## SPORTS FACILITIES

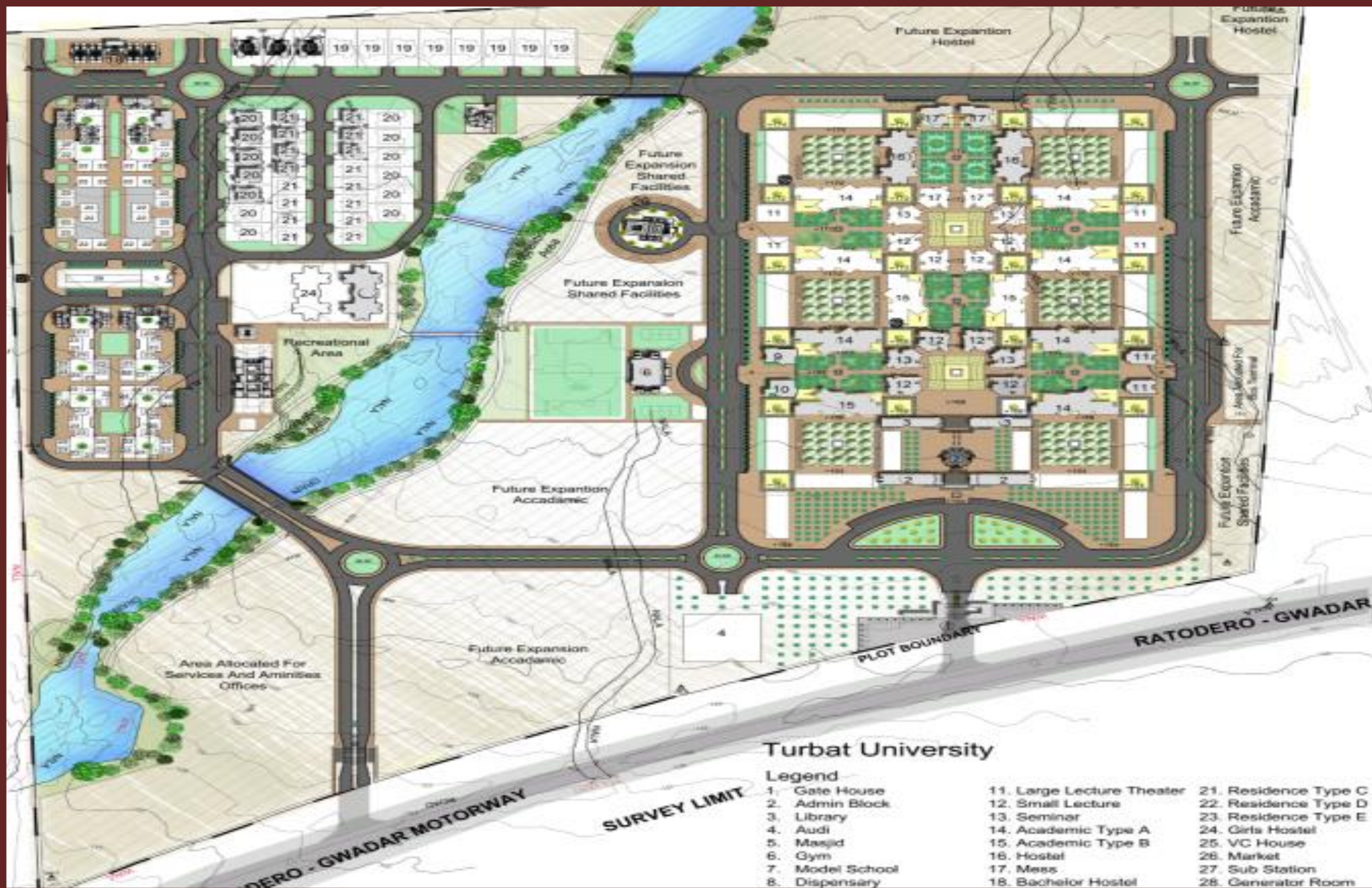
