The process of improvement and betterment is a continuing one and with changes in future, we will keep on upgrading and updating this document. Introduction

The University of Turbat (UoT) is located at Turbat (District Kech) in Makran Division. The people of the region had always longed for a university nearby. Their dream finally materialized in the shape of an independent University when the academic activities started in the institution in May 2013 as a full-fledged university.

Prior to getting status as a full-fledged University in 2012, it has been remained a HEC Recognized Sub Campus of the University of Balochistan (UoB) from 2009 to 2012.

The University of Turbat Act. 2012 was passed by the Provincial Assembly of Balochistan on 20th June, 2012, assented to by the Honorable Governor Balochistan on 26th in same year, and was notified in the Provincial Gazette on 28th June 2012.

After completion of entire required formalities including submission of feasibility report, visit of the HEC evaluation team, the University of Turbat was recognized by the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan as 168th Public Sector University in the country and Second Public Sector General University in Balochistan on 12th



March 2014.

The main objective of establishing this university is the provision of better opportunities of quality higher education to the students of entire province, mainly the remote and backward areas of Makran Division including district of Kech, Panjgur, Gwadar, and neigh-



boring district of Awaran, Kharan and Washuk (which cover around 1/5th of the total area of the province) to bring them at par with the other parts of the province/country in all walks of life. The university has been shifted from rented building to its permanent building situated at M-8 Ginna area in October 2017. The new building comprises all facilities for learning



including academic blocks, class rooms, lecture theaters, video conference hall, Computer labs, multipurpose hall, Chemistry labs, Cafeteria, Student facilitation Centre, admin blocks, Bachelors Hostels, Central Library, boy's hostel, girl's hostel, residential colony, sport complex, mosque, Model School, Banks and Medical Center. Despite the heavy odds and daunting challenges, University of Turbat is on way to bringing an educational revolution in the domain of higher learning in Mekran Division. The HEC, provincial

and Federal Government have ensured to expedite the process of Uplifting of Turbat University near future. Professor Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir and Professor Dr. Abdul Saboor Baloch took over the charge as first Vice Chancellor and Pro Vice Chancellor of the University respectively.

Within a short span of time Vice chancellor with the support of qualified faculty members and smart working administrative staff enlisted UoT in fast growing institution of higher education in the country.

Before transforming into an independent university three programs (BBA 4 years, BSCS 4 years, B.Com 2years)

were in progress in sub campus of UoB but now there are 23 programs in 11 departments including M.Phil./MS in Balochi and Chemistry in UoT.

With around 2500 students and 200 employees, the University of Turbat has been providing quality education and enhancing entrepreneurial skills of the students.

The university is providing financial assistance to its students through Prime Minister's Fee Reimbursement scheme, Balochistan Endowment Fund, HEC Need Based and merit based Scholarship, Kareem Dashti scholarship, Meer Ilahi Bakhsh Scholarship and many other scholarships sponsored by philanthropists.

The passed out graduates and alumni of University are expected to play a vigorous role in the activities of the projects under China Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) to bring about prosperity in the region.

University of Turbat believes to promote a culture of innovative and entrepreneurial, to foster and integrative thinking among students.

In this short span of time, University of Turbat earned a number of accolades which have been acknowledged by the people from all walks of life in the country.

Around 60 faculty members and scholars have been sent to different universities of Pakistan and abroad for M.Phil., MS, Ph.D. and MS leading to Ph.D under the Human Resource Development Program (HRD), Aghaz e Haqooq Balochistan Scholarship and other HEC scholarships scheme. Most of them, after completion of their degree have re-joined University and rest of them are expected to rejoin the university very soon. By the year 2020 the number of Ph.D. faculty is expected to raise up to fifty.

With 80 highly committed faculty members including 12 Ph.D. and 35 M.Phil./MS qualified, University of Turbat has grown to become a research led university, known for the excellence of its teaching, tradition, innovation and academic services being rendered to the people of Mekran, Balochistan and other provinces as well.

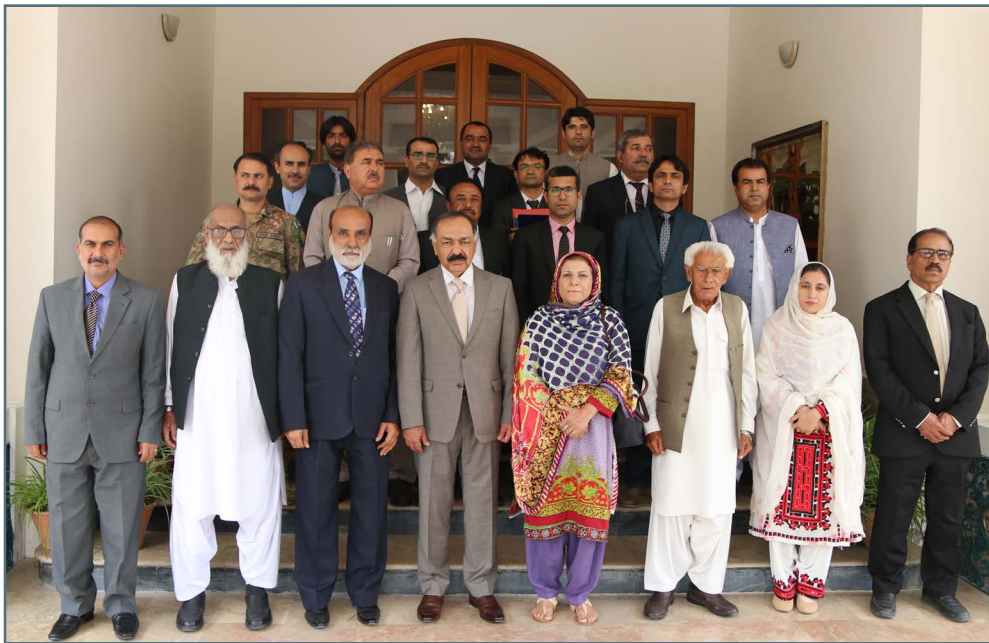
University of Turbat organized its 1st convocation in March 2017 which 220 graduates were conferred degrees and 12 position-winning graduates were also awarded gold medals. The management of UoT is planning to hold its 2nd convocation in March 2019.

The University succeeded to hold the meetings of its statutory and other bodies like Syndicate seven times, Academic Council eight times, Finance and Planning Committee eighth times, Academic Council eight time, Advanced Studies and Research Board (ASRB) Six times, selection board seven times, as well as all important meeting of the apex body the Senate three times.

Research and publications have been the defining distinction of the University of Turbat ever since its establishment. Earnest efforts are consistently made to promote a vibrant research culture and provide a favorable environment to both its faculty members and students for exploration and innovative market oriented higher learning.

University of Turbat launched its very own annual Research Journal GIDROSHIA for this specific purpose while IBLC also has initiated its research journal (MEERI) recognized by the HEC.





The Office of Research, Innovation, and Commercialization (ORIC) is striving to establish strong links with industry in order to facilitate the students for seeking internships and getting research projects for ensuring their future bright.

A bi-annual newsletter "KECH NEWS" from main campus and "ZERWAAN NEWS" from Gwadar campus are

another symbol of distinction for the University. Therefore, University of Turbat is enlisted as one of those successful general Universities which have achieved the enviable feat of publishing their Annual Research Journal, Bi-annual Newsletter, Annual Report, Prospectus and Convocation Booklet in such a short span of time. This is truly a big success story for a University in such a far flung and remote area. University of Turbat, being a student centric university, is extending all possible facilities to its students for quality higher learning, research, and extracurricular activities.

A video conference Hall has established by HEC to connect the university with national and international institutions of higher learning. Directorate of Information Technology, the backbone of the university, is one of the paramount achievements, connected to Pakistan Education and Research Network (PERN 2) by the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan, providing Wifi services to students, faculty members and administrative staff.

Besides seminar libraries in each department, university also has campus library and university public library with more than 40,000 books on different subjects, national and international research journal, publications, periodicals, and newspapers.

Directorate of Public Relations, a career counseling and student affairs cell have been established to help the students to resolve job related issues such as finding work and setting career goals.

The Quality Enhancement Cell (QEC) with the support of Quality Assurance Agency of Higher Education Commission of Pakistan is working effectively according to the needs of modern times in a changing world with the responsibility to ensure quality education with the futuristic mindset, encourage different academic activities, faculty training and development workshop, and preparing self-assessment report of different departments and faculty members. University of Turbat has signed a number of MOUs with leading national and international universities and educational institutions for promotion of higher learning and research skills and to exchange a framework of cooperation and facilities with the signatories.

University of Turbat has organized many seminars, workshops, training sessions, literary and academic events, international lecture series, certification courses in IT and entrepreneurialship, business galas, sport festivals and study tours. Completion of university permanent complex in record time, establishment of its sub campus at CPEC central city Gwadar, raising 3 departments to 11 along with 28 programs in four faculty starting M.Phil. Program, taking reliable security measures, cheating free examination system, launching IT academy in collaboration with HEC,

entering into MOUs with national and international universities, establishing smart computer labs, affiliating of three degree colleges of Makran division to university of Turbat, co-hosting national seminar on CPEC at Gwadar, conducting meetings of statutory body well in time, holding inter



university declamation contest, creating awareness against corruption, organizing IT and literary seminar, organizing Training workshops, international lecture series, annual Business Gala, various scholarships for students, national book fair and various extra-curricular activities in regular interval are among the considerable achievements of the university. Many ideas and projects are in pipeline as the part of short and long term strategic plan of the University. Establishment of more market oriented subjects, to set up another sub-campus in Panjgur, sending more scholars abroad for higher studies, training and refreshment courses, starting Ph.D., M.Phil. Diploma and certificate programs in different disciplines, starting Chinese, English and Balochi language program, affiliation of more degree colleges and educational institutions to university, hosting national and international conferences, launching housing scheme for its employees, setting up constituent Model High School and generating revenue by its own resources are among the main mission of future roadmap of the Turbat University.

- To impart Higher quality education to the least privileged region of the country by providing tertiary education at the door step of general population of Mekran in particular and Balochistan in general.
- To provide tertiary education facility in each field of science and arts at an international standard.

Video Conferencing Room

University of Turbat has established Video Conferencing Room with the collaboration of Higher Education Commission (HEC) Pakistan in Main Campus.



Financial Aid Office



The University of Turbat, Financial Aid office is dealing with the Need Based and Merit Based Scholarships for the students of University of Turbat. In this process the office is currently dealing with five Scholarship programs including HEC Need Based Scholarship, French Need Based Scholarship, Pakistan Bait-UI- Maal, Baluchistan Education Endowment Fund and Philanthropist. Under The HEC Need Based Scholarship program, the office has provided 54 Scholarship to the Batch 2015-2018, 69 Scholarships to the batch 2016-2019, 9 Scholarship to the Batch 2017-2020 and 37 Scholarship to the Batch 2018 –2021. These Scholarships were provided to the bachelor and master students of various disciplines within the UoT. Moreover, Under HEC- French Need Based Scholarship, 16 Scholarships were provided to the undergraduate students of various disciplines. Under the Pakistan Bait- UI- Maal Scholarship, 50 Scholarship were provided to the master and undergraduate students of various disciplines of UoT and under Baluchistan Education Endowment Fund 77 scholarship awarded to students of various disciplines. Additionally a new scholarship is created under the head of Karim Dashti Scholarship (KDS), where an initial amount of Rs.1 million has sought for the purpose.

Directorate of Information Technology

The Information and Technology departments is highlighted some of its achievements during the period of 2014. The milestones achieved are enormous.

Information Technology department is the backbone of any organization. Internet has made the world a global village. Information Technology is the gateway that global village. Organization are empowering their Information and Technology departments to meet the challenges of modern era.

One of the achievements after affiliation was to get connected to Pakistan Education and Research Network (PERN 2) by Higher Education Commission. On 1st Nov, 2014 The University was enlisted in PERN 2.

Matter related to Information Technology are overseen and regulated by Information Technology department. Inter-departments are provided technical assistance for smooth work progress. For better communication, Infrastructure for internet is developed. Fully furnished computer labs with latest specification, each system fully integrated with latest software and capable of running the up to date graphic tools such as Auto CAD and Maya etc. Wi-Fi Service is provided to students, faculty and administration. Students can access network and internet resources through different hotspots. For security measures Wi-Fi clients are



allowed to access internet with proper registration. Information Technology department enhances the collaboration of internal departments and administration with in University.

After two well functional computer labs, a third with the most advanced machines to date with the power of tackling most advanced engineering tasks and simulation has been established and been inaugurated by worthy CM Balochistan, Dr. Abdul Malik Baloch.

The National Education Research and Education Network, Pakistan (PERN 2).

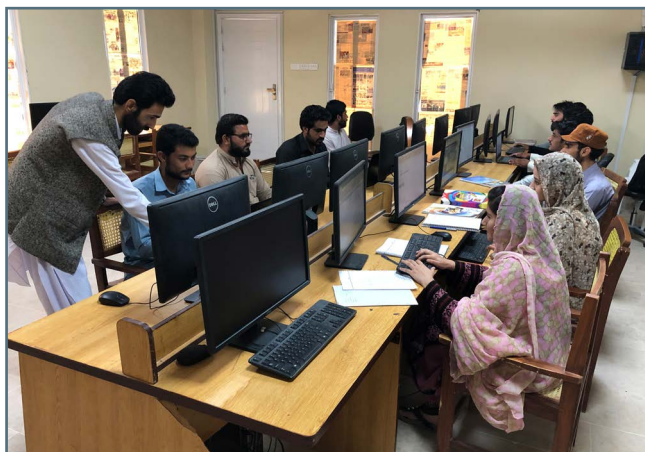
University of Turbat has achieved one its milestones being connected to PERN 2. Pakistan Education & Research Network is the only research and education network of Pakistan which as launched in 2002. The purpose of this national research and education network is to provide-communication infrastructure to the universities, institutions of higher learning and research organizations to meet their networking and internet requirements. The network has evolved significantly and is providing valuable services, like high-speed internet, audio/video conferencing, and access to digital library resources.

PERN Services

- Internet Services (Fastest Access to Information)
 - Intranet: Virtual Private LAN Service(Secure, Reliable Global Ethernet VPN Full-Mesh Solution)
 - National Digital Library
 - Video/ VoIP (Video Conferencing)
 - Local Content Hosting (Cloud Services)
 - Unified Communication (The Private Cloud technology as implemented is primarily aimed at providing Unified Communication solution including email services,office communicator etc.)
- Directorate of IT has connected departments and administrative offices through intranet connectivity on Fiber. User Login Authentication has also been implemented for each user with the campus. DIT also developed a new state-of-art Computer Lab in department of Computer Science. NAS Server and Mail Server are also activated for faculty member and administrative staff.

Computer Laboratories

The University of Turbat (UoT) has well furnished and equipped computer labs working under the Computer Science Department and IT section of the University, there are more than 200 latest new computers have been provided to the University Computer Laboratory. This service provides net services to the Central Library, departments, faculty and administrative offices 24 hours. In the Central Labs, PCs are provided, offering a range of standard office software for document creation and presentations. Specialist provision is available to support research and advanced study within the University. Computers in the campus are connected to the University's main server through a wide area network giving access via the internet to the major information, research and communications networks worldwide.



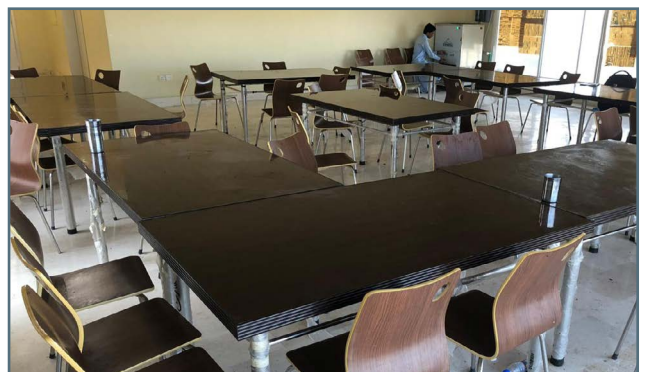
Campus Library

The books and reading material available in Library support not only every course in the curriculum i.e. Management Sciences, Computer Science, Commerce, Economic, Political Science, English, and Balochi but also include selected stock of general books and materials on History, Anthropology, Islamic Studies, Geography, Archeology, Regional Studies, languages and literature, published by National and International publishers, Library also has subscribed national and international periodicals, publications, newspapers in English, Urdu and Balochi etc. The whole library system at campus library is being computerized and HEC has been asked to provide facilities for online library service which will be available through a network after the completion of the computerization process. The library also has a reasonable number of internationally published Research Journals



Student Hostels

University of Turbat has students from all over Makran that are enrolled in different programs. Some of the students are not resident of Turbat City. For them, UoT has 3 buildings for hostels, which include 2 for boys and 1 for girls, with all basic needs and comfort in the campus. Each hostel has its own cook and mess, which is partially supported by the University. There are security guards on each hostel, and a female warden for the girl's hostel.



General Regulations for Resident Students in Hostels

1. Roll of resident students shall be called daily at specific hours prescribed by the Warden.
2. The student shall himself be responsible for the articles (Bed, Charpai, Almirah, Study Table, Chair or other such item etc.) issued to him / her and shall return these articles when leaving the Hostel. He/She shall also be responsible for making good any loss or damage of these articles.
3. Students must treat the Hostel staff politely. The Hostel staff shall not render any private service to any student. Manhandling / misbehavior with the staff shall be treated as most serious offence. Complaints regarding misbehavior of the Hostel staff should be reported to the Warden or Hall Superintendent.
4. The telephone provided in the Hostel shall be meant only for receiving calls.
5. Outdoor games shall not be allowed in the Hall's premises.
6. The allotment of a student who remains absent from the Hostel without prior permission for a period of two weeks shall be cancelled. However, he may seek re-admission as admissible under the rules.
7. No meeting of any kind (political / religious / social etc.) shall be allowed in the Hostel and its premises.
8. Every part of the Hostel shall be freely open to the Hostel authorities for inspection at any time.
9. No boarder shall indulge in any enjoyment that may disturb other boarders.
10. The resident students shall be allowed to use computers only for academic purposes.
11. No electric appliance (electric heater, air cooler, air conditioner, T.V., cassette / C.D. player, musical instruments and exhaust / pedestal fans etc.) other than electric light and ceiling fan shall be used in the Hostel. The use of electrical appliances shall be liable to lead to confiscation of the appliance along with a fine to be decided by the Warden. However, permission may be sought for the use of air cooler and exhaust / pedestal fan from the Provost or Warden on payment of extra charges to be prescribed by University authorities.
12. All electric articles must be switched off before leaving the room. Leaving the room with electric appliance switched on shall be an offence punishable with fine.
13. Firearms and other weapons shall not be allowed to be kept / used in the Hostel.
14. The residents shall not be allowed to gamble or to use any intoxicants and narcotics. Violation of this restriction shall render a resident liable to expulsion from the Hostel, in addition to any criminal proceedings that may be instituted against him under the Penal Law of Pakistan.
15. The residents shall be responsible for keeping their rooms neat and tidy. They shall not dispose off litter in the verandahs or other parts of the Hostel premises.
16. No notice / banner / advertisement etc of any kind can be displayed in Hostel and its premises without prior approval of Hostel authorities.
17. Defacing walls and fixtures shall be strictly prohibited.
18. Boarders shall be required to observe necessary precautions for the safe custody of their belongings/valuables. They must not leave their rooms unlocked. In theft cases, Hall administration shall not be responsible for any loss.
19. All cases of sickness must be reported to the Hostel authorities for necessary help.
20. A girl resident shall not leave the campus without written or verbal permission of the Hostel authorities.

Gymnasium & Sport Grounds

A gymnasium for indoor games and exercises is built for the students and staff. Football and Cricket grounds are also available in the main campus.



University Transportation

The University of Turbat has four buses, one coaster and 2 Vans to provide pick and drop facility to the students living in Turbat city and suburbs. The University also provides transport facility to its students for field work and annual picnics once a year to each department on need basis. The study tours for students are partly financed by the students and supplemented by the University, subject to availability of funds. UoT also has an ambulance for the students and faculties. And Ten vehicles for the administrative staff



Campus Cafeteria and Shops

The University of Turbat at its City Campus has a well-furnished Cafeteria having fast food and tea shop facilities only for campus students and faculty members.

Habib Bank Limited (HBL) and National Bank of Pakistan have their branches within the University campus providing assistant to students, faculty members and administrative staff of University of Turbat.



Basic Health Unit and Ambulance Services

University of Turbat has its own Basic Health Unit with the university premises and an Ambulance is on stand by for any emergency for the students and staff.



Seminar Hall

A seminar hall is also situated in the main campus for conducting seminars, exhibitions, lecture sessions and more. More than 100 participants may be seated in the seminar hall.



Students Affairs Section

This office plays the role of catalyst towards the integrity, excellence and good image of students. In accomplishment of the roles, In-charge Student Affairs is responsible to act as a bridge between the administrative staff and students. Office of Student Affairs, University of Turbat, is an administrative function section under the leadership of Committee of the University. The primary function of the committee is to inform the Deans of the concern departments about student problems or suggest courses of action or to recommend policy and to seek improvements for the development of students. The students that participate in the Student Affairs Committee are the liaisons between the department and the students, and the Dean's Office. Student affairs section is responsible for creating an environment for the students to express their concerns related to curriculum and non-curriculum activities and to provide them opportunities for their personal growth. Moreover, office attends to students' problems and coordinate students' activities for their personality grooming. In addition, the department arranges study trips, organizes sports events, Gala and debates that will help in nurturing the potential capacity of the students.

Students Code Of Conduct

University of Turbat is committed to provide high quality education that is compatible with changing needs of the world. University of Turbat has right to expect from students to maintain principle values, pursue exceptional conduct and character in campus. At the same time, students have the responsibility to conduct themselves in a lawful manner and in compliance with the University's standards. The purpose of this Code is to specify acts of student misconduct for which an offending individual will be subject to disciplinary sanctions under the University Disciplinary Procedures.

The Code of Conduct specifies behaviors that students should avoid as they are inconsistent with the essential values of the university. A student shall be held accountable through the University Discipline Process if he/she makes the decision to engage in these behaviors.

The Code of Conduct behaviors include, but are not limited to:

- **Abuse/Endangerment/Hazing of a person:**

Physically harming or threatening to harm any person, intentionally or carelessly causing harm to any person or creating a condition that endangers the reputation and safety of self or other students.

- **Voilation of Academic Integrity:**

Academic integrity is a basic guiding principle for all academic activity at University of Turbat, and all students of the University are expected to act in accordance with this principle. Students should act with personal integrity and respect other students' dignity and rights. Academic integrity includes a commitment not to engage in or tolerate acts of falsification, misrepresentation or deception.

- **Cheating:**

Cheating is an act or an attempted act of deception by which a student seeks to Copy of all or any portion of another's academic work and submitting it as one's own or allowing another person to copy one's own paper during Exam or Quizzes—whether intentionally or irresponsibly.

- **Involvement:**

A student shall not assist another student, group of students in committing or attempting to commit a violation of this Code of Conduct. A student who has knowledge that another person committing or attempting to commit a violation of the Code of Conduct, is responsible to stop him amicably or to convey such act/intention to the knowledge of University administration, and failure to do so when reasonable under the circumstances may be the basis for a violation of this policy.

- **False Information:**

Making a false or misleading oral or written statement that misrepresents the character, qualifications, or reputation of other students will be held accountable through the University Discipline Process.

- **Alcohol, Drugs and Smoking:**

University of Turbat has strictly prohibited Students to possess alcohol, using drugs and smoking in university campus and hostels; severe action shall be taken against those who found to be guilty in violation of the rule.

- **Dangerous Objects:**

The possession or use of any potentially dangerous object or weapon, including but not limited to: ammunition, hunting knives, swords, firearms, other explosives, is prohibited.

- **Damage or Destruction:**

Actions involving the students to endanger or actually harm or ruin University property are tantamount to breaching the code of conducts and shall be treated as a crime.

Code Of Honor

The University of Turbat Honor Code is at once an objective and ruling. University of Turbat established in the year of 2012 with a mission to provide quality education and committed to excellence, tradition and innovation that makes it unique institute of the province and as well as in the country. The injunction is simple that students must have to follow it in order to preserve the smooth running of university activities.

Students vow never to lie, steal or cheat and accept that the consequence for flouting this assurance is permanent dismissal from the University. Students have to face grave consequences if they found breaching or violating code of honor.

ATTENDANCE, STRUCKOFF AND READMISSION

1. Students shall have to be punctual and regular to attend all lectures/seminars, laboratory periods, and Field work as required for each course during the semester session. A student shall be eligible to appear in the terminal examination provided that he has attended not less than 75% (cumulative) of lectures/seminars delivered in all theory courses. He has to complete 75%attendance in the laboratory/field work for grading of laboratory/fieldwork course.
2. The name of a student will be stuck off if his monthly attendance is less than 25%.
3. The student will have to get himself/herself readmitted within one week with fee Rs.500/- and within further three (03) days with fee Rs.1000/-. On failure of readmission his admission shall stand cancelled.
4. There will be at the most three chances for readmission for a four years program and two chances for a two years program. A student readmitted 3/2 times during the session of study program shall not be allowed a further readmission and his/her admission shall stand cancelled.
5. A student seeking readmission shall not be exempted from the payment of readmission fee.
6. A student will not be allowed to sit for terminal examination of any semester unless he has no outstanding dues for the said semester. Accounts Branch of the University will issue a clearance certificate in this regard.

ACADEMIC STANDARDS AND COMPUTATION OF GRADES

1. A student must secure Grade D to promote in a course.
2. A grade F will be awarded to a student in a course for not achieving the desired competence. The student will have to reappear in all assignments, quizzes, mid-term and terminal examinations when offered subsequently. No special classes will be conducted by the Department for such students.
3. A student must maintain GPA of 2.00 on a cumulative basis during his/her academic program, any student with a GPA less than 1.50 will be dropped from the rolls of the University forthwith.
4. A student securing a GPA between 1.50 and 2.00 will be put on probation for one semester.
5. At the end of semester, student will be required to improve his/ her GPA and bring it up to the required minimum of 2.00.
6. If a probationer shows an improvement, but his GPA is still below 2.00 his/ her probation may be extended for another semester.
7. If he/ she still fail to bring his / her GPA to 2.00 by the end of the next semester he/ she will be dropped from the rolls of the University.
8. A student with Grade D can repeat the course, when offered by the department.
9. GPA is computed at the end of each semester.

Institute of Balochi Language & Culture (IBLC)

Introduction

The Institute of Balochi Language and Culture (IBLC) in the University of Turbat was first established as the Department of Balochi Language and Literature in 2013 to cater the needs of the students of Balochi language and literature. Soon after its establishment the department became one of the most popular departments of the University with enrolling more students in its first batch and proved itself to be the center of excellence for the study, teaching and research about Balochi language, history, literature and culture.

Seeing its popularity and feeling the need of time the university administration, on the wishes of the Ex-Chief Minister Balochistan Dr. Abdul Malik Baloch, upgraded the department of Balochi language and literature in the University of Turbat in 2016, to an Institute (Institute of Balochi Language and Culture) and its horizons were widened and broadened to research and work on Baloch history, language, literature, culture, oral traditions and a lot more which particularly pertain to Baloch and its culture.

Apart from offering BS (four years/eight semester) MA (two years/four semesters), and MPhil programs, the Institute is also planning to offer PhD programs shortly. Moreover, the institute is also running a chair attributed to legendary Baloch poet Mulla Fazul, named as 'Mulla Fazul Chair'. The institute is also publishing a research journal 'Meeri' in which the research papers from well-known authors and researchers regarding Balochi language, literature and culture are published in it. Meeri is also a recognized research journal from HEC.

The institute, apart from conducting and supervising scholarly and academic works on formation, classification and standardization of Balochi terminologies related to the different aspects of life, is also working on Indexation of Balochi research journals. The Institute has also setup a reference library, established a Museum, a Center for Translation studies & Culture, Oriental and Occidental Language Center, Collection of general Archives, and a Baloch Cultural Exhibition Center are in the pipeline. The Institute is also working on Balochi Music and on preservation of Balochi Oral traditions. The aim of the institute is to streamline Balochi language, literature, history, and culture with the national and international languages and cultures. Besides, the Institute also aims to sign MoUs with international organizations working on the national and international languages, literatures, and cultures.
