OUR UNIVERSITY

District Kech of Makran division with a population of around 12 lacs, the land of a romance legend, has always been a place of importance for its geographical location, and famous for its production of date fruit. It has been, and still is, the center of Makran region; geographically, socially, administratively and politically.

This institution first set up as a Sub-Campus of University of Balochistan in November 2009 with three programs of study; BBA 4 years, BSCS 4 years and B.Com two years and was granted university status in May 2013 under University of Turbat Act 2012. After completion of entire required formalities including submission of feasibility report, visit of the HEC evaluation team, the University of Turbat was recognized by the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan as 158th Public Sector University in the country and Second Public Sector in General University in Balochistan on 12th March 2014.

The University of Turbat, an institution of teaching and learning was founded for the sheer purpose of providing quality, accessible higher education to the people of the region.

The Second General University in public, chartered by the government of Balochistan Vide Act 2012 passed by the Balochistan Provincial Assembly in May 2012.

Prof Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir took the charge as first Vice Chancellor and Dr. Abdul Saboor Baloch as first Pro Vice Chancellor of the University. The main objective of establishment of University of Turbat in the Makran region in Balochistan is to provide better opportunities of Higher Education to the students of Kech and adjoin districts including Panjgor, Gwadar and Awaran.

With the establishment of the University of Turbat, substantial number of students enrolled initially from different parts of province mainly from Mekran which will have a direct effect on the social environment of the families of the students and indirectly to the society.

The University of Turbat is fast growing to become centre of a learning to cater the future needs of people from remote parts of the province.

It has steadfastly held on to its vision of a modern University that harvests and maximizes human potential through practical degree programs

and hands on research oriented disciplines since its inception in 2012. The University has particularly been effective in filling an educational void in Mekran and its adjacent areas. It has ensured that higher education is no longer a distant dream but a practical reality.

With the introduction of market valued subjects, job opportunities would be created directly benefiting the social wellbeing of a segment of the population in the region. Keeping in views today's changing socio-business environment and increasing globalization have created an international community demanding global management. Turbat University today, is equipped with the young, energetic and talented faculty, better structure and systems to support its mission to teach and train the students positively.

Despite the heavy odds and daunting challenges, University of Turbat is on way to bringing an educational revolution in the domain of higher learning in Mekran Division. Soon after taking oath as Governor Balochistan, Honorable Muhammad Khan Achakzai and Ex-Chief Minister Balochistan Dr. Abdul Malik Baloch extended exceptional support and assistance for the development of Turbat University. 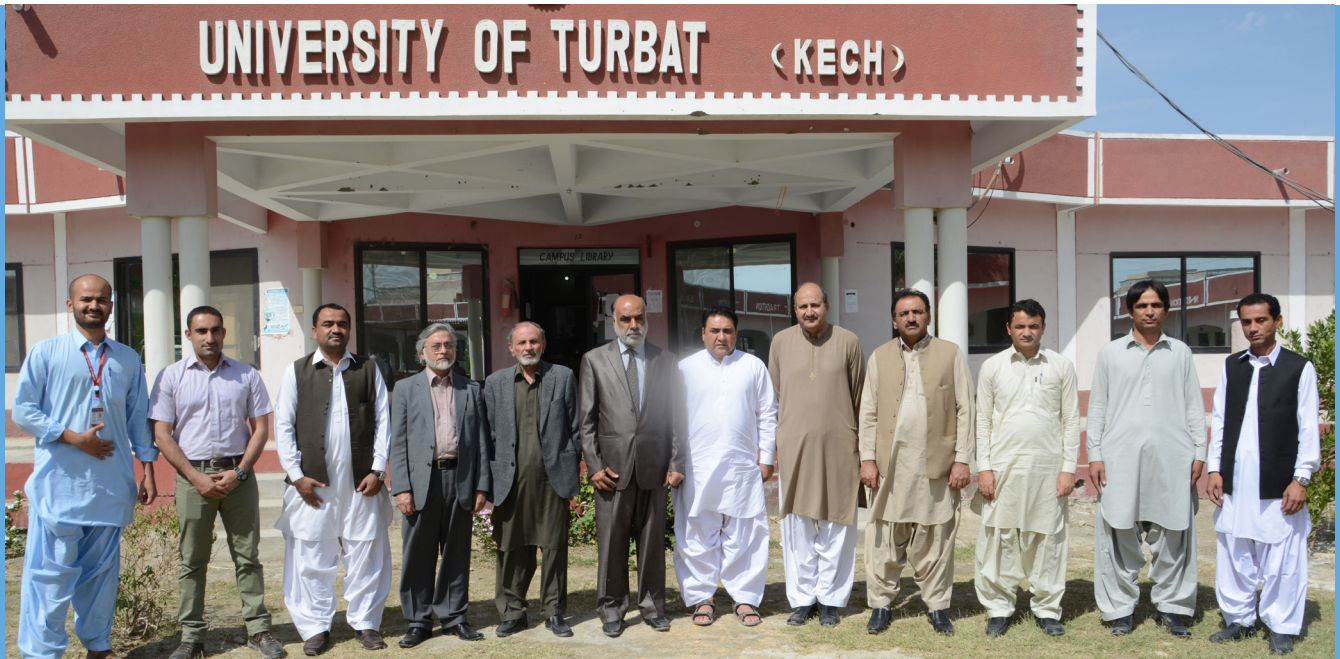
Quality Enhancement Cell

This requirement brought into fulfilment by the support of the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan in association with the Quality Assurance Agency (QAA) of Higher Education Commission of Pakistan. Since the establishment of the QEC, the section has performed many academic and extra-curricular activities in the University.





HEC Delegation visits UoT

A delegation from Higher Education Commission on 24-25 Feb visited University of Turbat to review the good governance and quality assurance proceedings at UoT. The review panel headed by Dr. Khuwaja Azam Ali (ex DG (QAA) HEC), consisted of three other members including experienced academicians and experts namely Dr. Abdul Majeed Cheema from Punjab University, Dr. Muhammad Ismail DG (QAD) and Dr. Rafiq Baloch DG (QAA) of Higher Education Commission of Pakistan. Despite the under construction University Complex at Ginna area, some 15 km away from Turbat City, the members of review panel also went around various components of present rented building of the University.

Earlier, the university's vice chancellor Prof. Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir briefed the visiting team about background of the university establishment, meetings of the statutory bodies, infrastructure, university's achievements, development projects, governance system, its academics programs, enrollment of students, future plan and capacity building activities of faculty members, administrative staff and the students. During this two-day visit the team members also engaged in hours long different interactive sessions with faculty members, administrative staff and students' separately to discuss different matters relating to role of university teachers in quality assurance, good governance, university and campus management, career counseling and opportunities for acquiring various scholarships for higher studies.

Finance

Salient Features

The main sources of funding of UoT are Development Grants and Recurring Grants being received from the Federal govt through HEC. HEC is also providing dedicated funds for specific purposes such as to meet security requirements , to provide in house training etc. Apart from the above, the honourable Governor Balochistan also allocates some funds to the University as Grant in aid for specific purposes. The University's own revenues from Tuition Fee, exam fee and other heads are contributing in its Revenue- Pool to some extent.

The UoT Project

The Project titled "Establishment of University of Turbat" was approved by ECNEC during May 2011 at a total cost of Rs. 1580.39 (M). Although the commencement year of the Project given in the PC-I was 2011-12; however the Project was actually started from the F/Y 2013-14 after induction of full-time VC and other Senior officers. Since July 2013, the work of the construction of new Campus is continuing without any break and by Jan 2016, almost 70% of the works have been completed. Apart from Civil works the Project cost also includes other components such as scholarships for higher studies, Purchase of equipments, Furniture & Fixtures, books and Journals, Transport and Security system etc. Due to delay in starting of the Project, law and order problems and other reasons the cost of Project increased beyond the permissible limit of 15% ; as such a Revised PC-I was prepared and approved by the Govt at a cost of Rs. 2820.62(M) during January 2016. A total amount of Rs. 768 (M) have already been spent from the Project funds by 31st January 2016.

Budget for F/Y 2016-17

The Tentative Budget for the next F/Y 2016-17 was considered by the Finance & Planning Committee of UoT in its meeting held on 13th Feb 2016 according to which the total volume of next year's budget would be Rs. 254 (M) out of which about Rs. 70 (M) will be met from internal sources and grants from provincial govt; while the HEC has been requested to meet the shortfall of Rs. 184 (M). The final budget would be formulated after knowing about the actual allocations from HEC.

Endowments Fund

The former Chief Minister of Balochistan Dr. Abdul Malik Baloch, had announced during the stone laying ceremony of the UoT Project on 6th February 2014, to provide funds for establishment of UoT's Endowment fund. Accordingly an amount of Rs. 50 (M) was received from GoB during last quarter of F/Y 2013-14 which was invested in three years term deposit in NBP @ 11.75 % p.a after obtaining comparative rates of interest through open and transparent bidding. This fund is meant for investment in the long term deposit/securities in order to meet long term financial needs of the University and the profits/interest are utilized for providing scholarships and other benefits to the students.

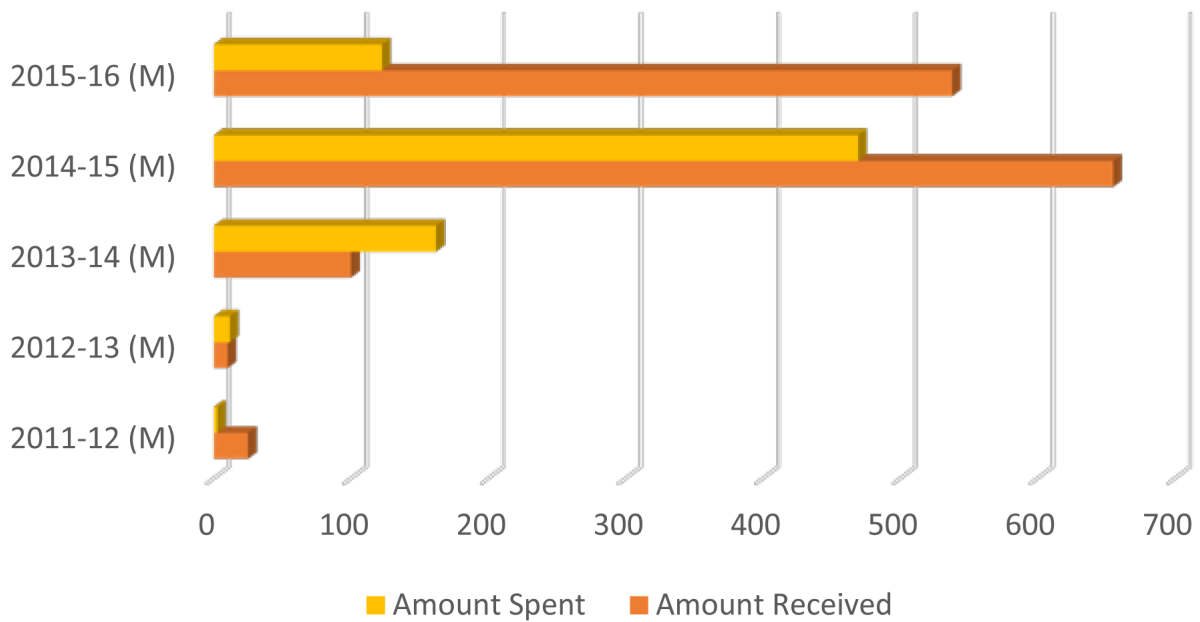
Grant in aid

The honorable Governor Balochistan/Chancellor PSU 's of Balochistan has very kindly granted a total amount of Rs. 28 (M) during the last two years i.e. 2013-14 and 2014-15 as Grant in aid which have been fully spent for the heads and purposes prescribed by the Government of Balochistan. A request for allocating an amount of Rs. 40 (M) to UoT for the current F/Y 2015-16 is pending with the concerned quarters.

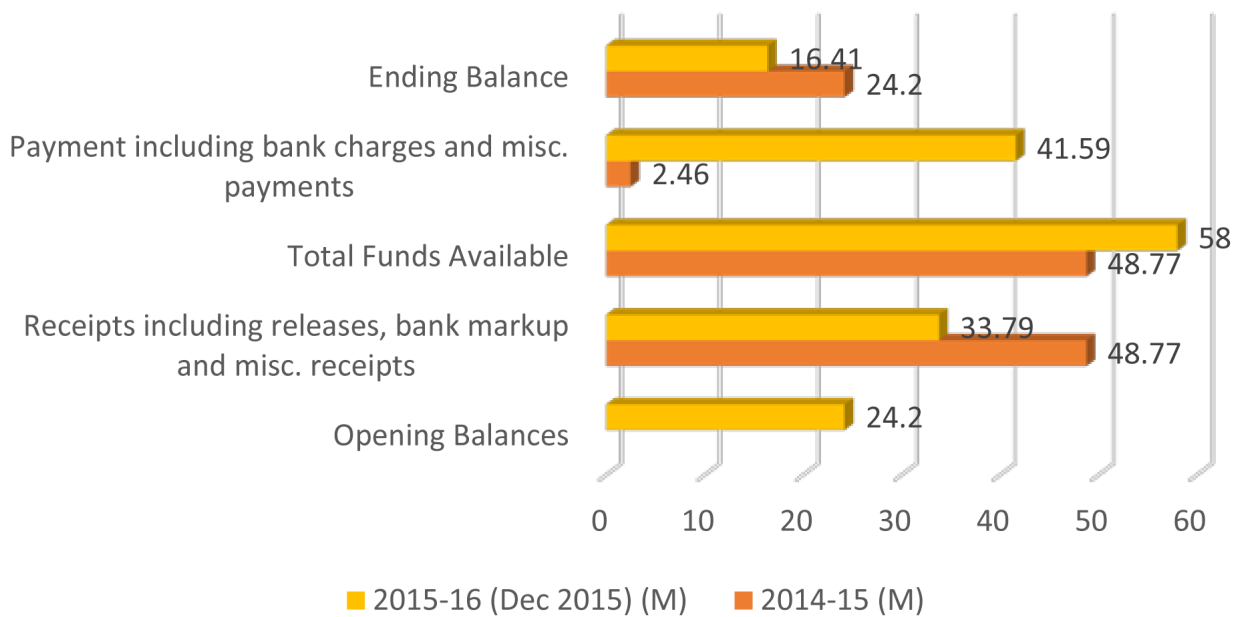
Future Plans

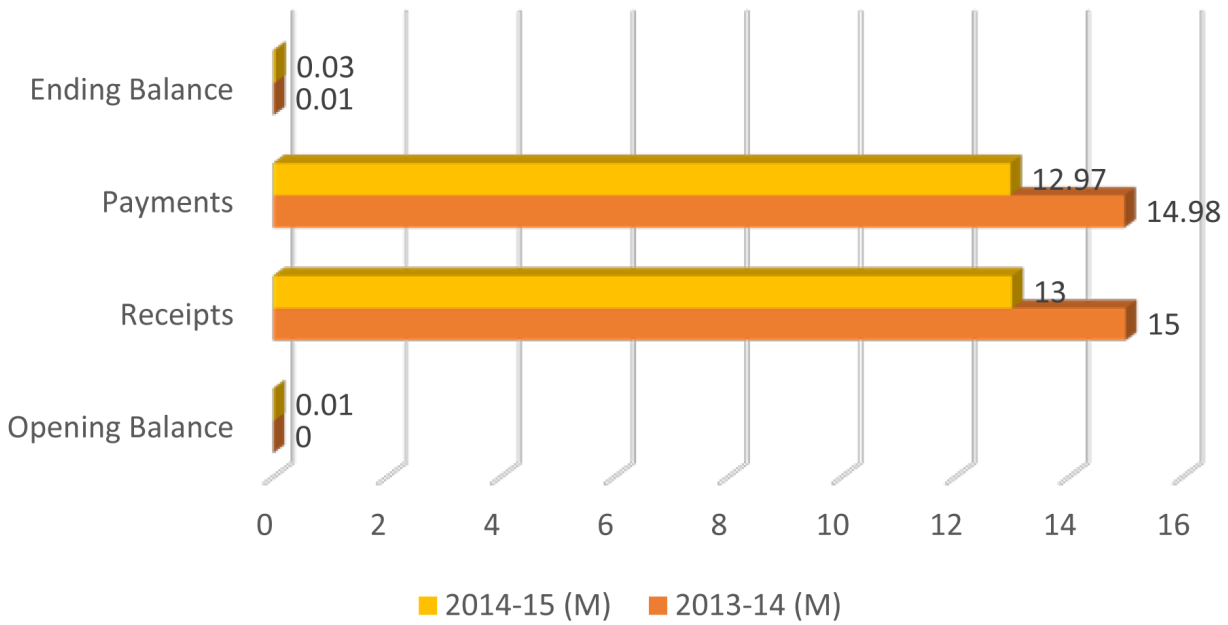
Development Grants Receipts and Expenditures



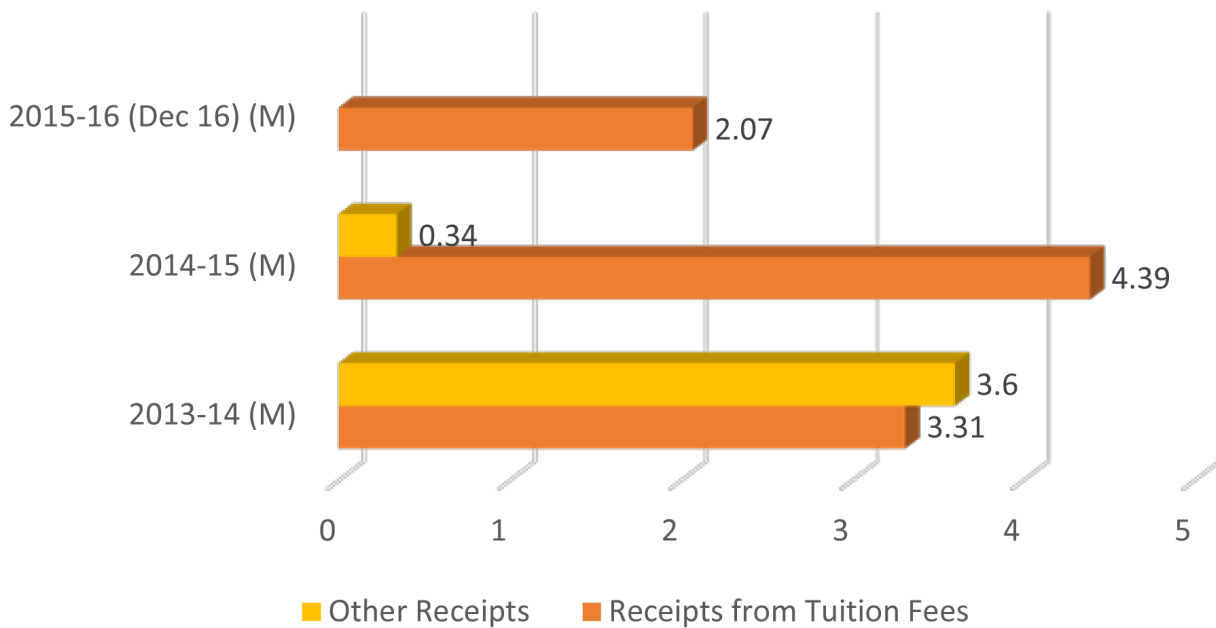

Speaking to aspirants for admission in Gwadar Campus he said 500 acres land have been acquired for a university in Gwadar and construction and civil work will be started very soon.

He said, “ all efforts underway to make UoG at par with country’s advanced university where market oriented subjects and programs of study will be offered”. Federal Minister said, “On behalf of Prime Minister Muhammad Nawaz Sharif let me congratulate the people of Gwadar on this memorable occasion of establishing University of Gwadar where people from this

part of country would get greater opportunity for higher education at their door steps”.

He was also accompanied by provincial minister for health Rahmat Saleh Baoch, DG GDA Dr. Sajjad Baloch and chief engineer Rafiq Ahmed Baloch during visit to campus.



Establishment of Gwadar Campus

The idea of establishment of a Sub Campus of Turbat University in Gwadar was originated by the Vice Chancellor University of Turbat Prof Dr Abdul Razzaq Sabir in 2015. A team of expert led by the Vice Chancellor prepared and tabled the proposal of establishment of Gwadar Campus at statutory body Syndicate in its third meeting as item no.6 held on May 30, 2015 for approval.

The Finance and Planning Committee also endorsed and approved the idea of establishment of Gwadar Campus in its fourth meeting as item no 5 held on June 29, 2015 at Karachi.

After thorough discussion and approval of recommendation of establishment of Gwadar Campus from different meetings statutory bodies the proposal was presented in the apex statutory body of UoT the Senate during its first meeting chaired by Governor Balochistan/ Chancellor University of Turbat Muhammad Khan Achakzai, held on March 30, 2016 at University Public Library.

In pursuance of principle approval by Honorable Governor Balochistan/ Chancellor University of Turbat Muhammad Khan Achakzai, the Higher Education Commission Pakistan issued a notification on July 4, 2016 to set up a Sub Campus of University of Turbat at CPEC central city Gwadar.

The Sub-Campus of University of Turbat was established at Gwadar under the Umbrella Project of "Establishment of Sub Campuses of Public Sector Universities at district level (phase-1)".

The Sub Campus in CPEC central city Gwadar will be transformed into a full fledged university of Gwadar at par with international standard in near future. Prime Minister Muhammad Nawaz Sharif inaugurated the project of University of Gwadar on September 1, 2016 at Gwadar amid inaugurating a string of development projects. Around 500 Acre land has been proposed for the University of Gwadar at Gwadar.

The admissions in four BS Programs were announced on August 31, 2016 while applications for the position of Lecturer were invited on October 18, 2016.

Soon after the establishment of Gwadar Campus , a delegation led by

Federal Minister for Planning, Development and Reforms, Mr. Ahsan Iqbal visited Gwadar Campus (future University of Gwadar) on September 23, 2016 to see the progress.

Initially, BS Programs in BBA, BSIT, B.Ed (Hons), ADE and B.Com are approved by the statutory bodies for Gwadar Campus and classes will commence from January 16, 2017. Besides establishing a Sub Campus at Gwadar, University of Turbat has also been assigned the task by HEC to prepare a PC-1 of University of Gwadar, and submit the Charter of UoG to concern forum for approval. A team of experts led by the Vice Chancellor UoT Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir has prepared the PC-1 of University of Gwadar and submitted the Charter of UoG at concern forum for approval.

In today's changing socio-business environment and increasing globalization it has become unavoidable to provide students with knowledge, skills and attitudes that should help them begin their career anywhere in the world and to ensure that they will have the education to meet their goals in their perspective field. In this context the Gwadar campus of Turbat University is all set to provide students with a broad and thorough knowledge of the main features of respective discipline of study and current comprehensive analysis of theory and practice along with promotion of students understanding with apply innovative learning and teaching practices. It is highly anticipated that in the leadership of Vice Chancellor prof Dr Abdul Razzaq Sabir and the efforts put in by energetic and talented faculty members and Campus Administration, the students of Gwadar Campus are expected to get familiar with both the theoretical background and the practical techniques of their relevant field in their life. The process of recruitment of faculty members for Gwadar Campus is under process. Under the banner of Turbat University, Gwadar Campus is working on a plan to introduce a culture of innovation and entrepreneurialship to foster integrative thinking among students so that they could contribute in the projects under CPEC for the economic prosperity of Pakistan in general and Balochistan in particular.

This was expressed by Prof. Dr. Nek Muhammad Buzdar, California State University USA, while delivering a lecture on “Root cause of poverty and economic backwardness in Balochistan” in connection with UoT International Lecture Series organized by Department of Economics at UoT city campus.

He added that the objectives of economic growth and improved living conditions for the people of Balochistan cannot be achieved without completely overhauling the existing education system and introducing major reform programs. He was of the opinion that the issue is not that Balochistan has been knocked down economically, the issue is whether Balochistan can get back up. “Pick yourself up, dust yourself off and start your journey again.”

He recommended to introduce free and compulsory elementary education, compensate poor parents for each child, free lunch at school, increase teacher salaries and benefits, decentralize education system, replace dishonest and incompetent teachers, create self confidence among children for the development and prosperity of Balochistan.

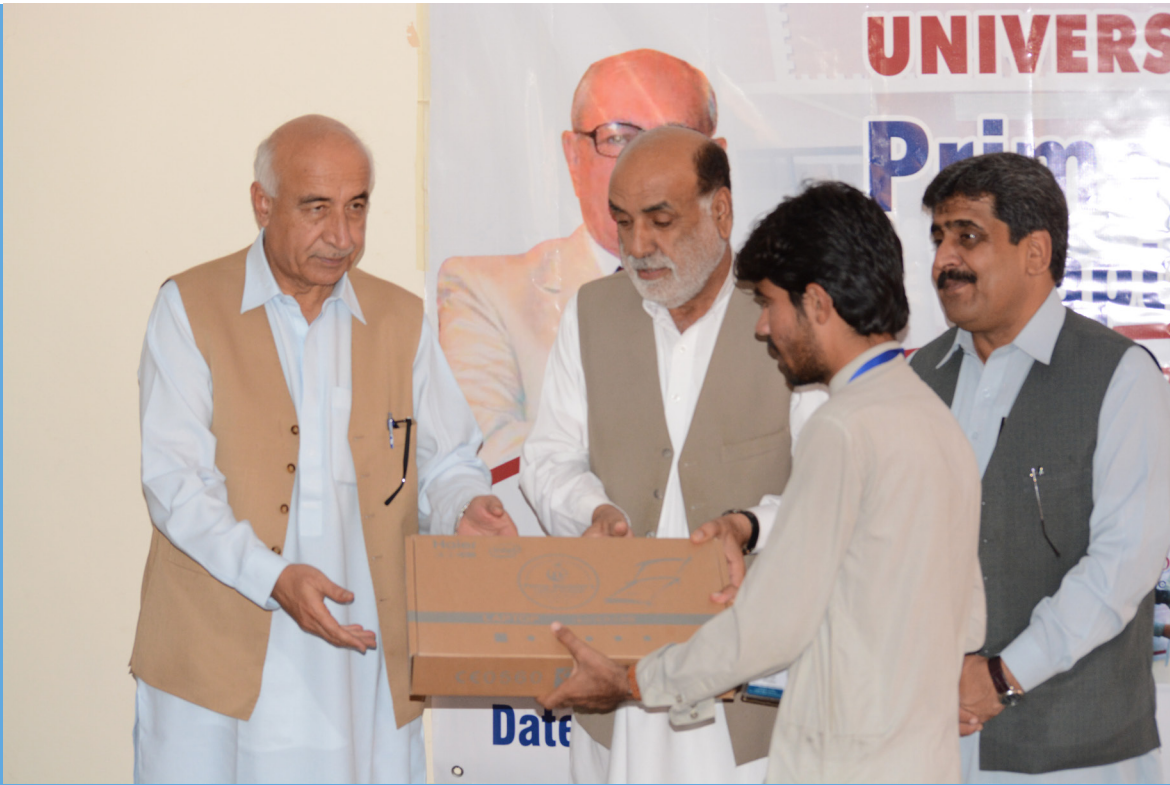


Two day Entrepreneurial Challenge Comes to an End

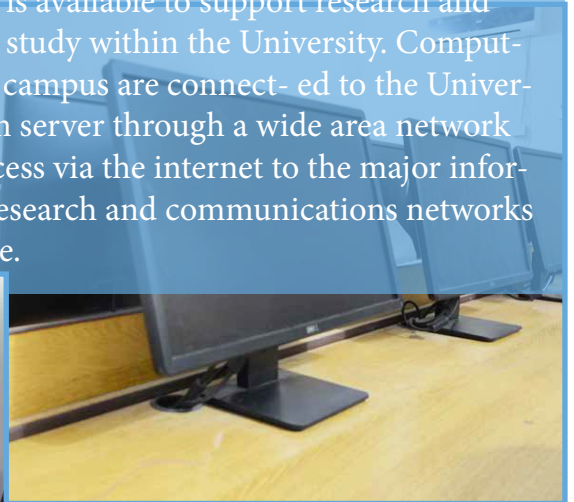


Univeristy Facilities



Computer Laboratories

The University of Turbat (UoT) has a well furnished and equipped computer labs working under the Computer Science Department and IT section of the University, there are more than 200 latest new computers have been provided to the University Computer Laboratory. This service provides net services to the Central Library, departments, faculty and administrative offices 24 hours. In the Central Labs, PCs are provided, offering a range of standard office software for document creation and presentations. Specialist provision is available to support research and advanced study within the University. Computers in the campus are connect- ed to the University's main server through a wide area network giving access via the internet to the major information, research and communications networks worldwide.



Campus Library

The books and reading material available in Library support not only every course in the curriculum i.e. Management Sciences, Computer Science, Commerce, Economic, Political Science, English, and Balochi but also include selected stock of general books and materials on History, Anthropology, Islamic Studies, Geography, Archeology, Regional Studies, languages and literature, published by National and International publishers, Library also has subscribed national and international periodicals, publications, newspapers in English, Urdu and Balochi etc. The whole library system at campus library is being computerized and HEC has been asked to provide facilities for online library service which will be available through a network after the completion of the computerization process. The library also has a reasonable number of internationally published Research Journals available.



Campus Cafeteria

The University of Turbat at its City Campus has a well-furnished Cafeteria having fast food and tea shop facilities only for campus students and faculty members.

The Cafeteria has seating for more than 30 students at a time with separate seats for male and female students or faculty members. Photocopy facility is provided by the Cafeteria owner within the campus for facilitating students of UoT, especially females.



Student Hostels

University of Turbat has students from all over Makran that are enrolled in different programs. Some of the students are not resident of Turbat City. For them, UoT has hired 3 buildings for hostels, which include 2 for boys and 1 for girls, with all basic needs and comfortable, secure locations in the city. Each hostel has its own cook and mess, which is partially supported by the University. There are security guards on each hostel, and a female warden for the girl's hostel.



University Transportation

The University of Turbat has four buses to provide pick and drop facility to the students living in Turbat city and suburbs. The University also provides transport facility to its students for field work and annual picnics once a year to each department on need basis. The study tours for students are partly financed by the students and supplemented by the University, subject to availability of funds. UoT also has an ambulance for the students and faculties.

Doda Rasheed Memorial Football Tournament at UoT

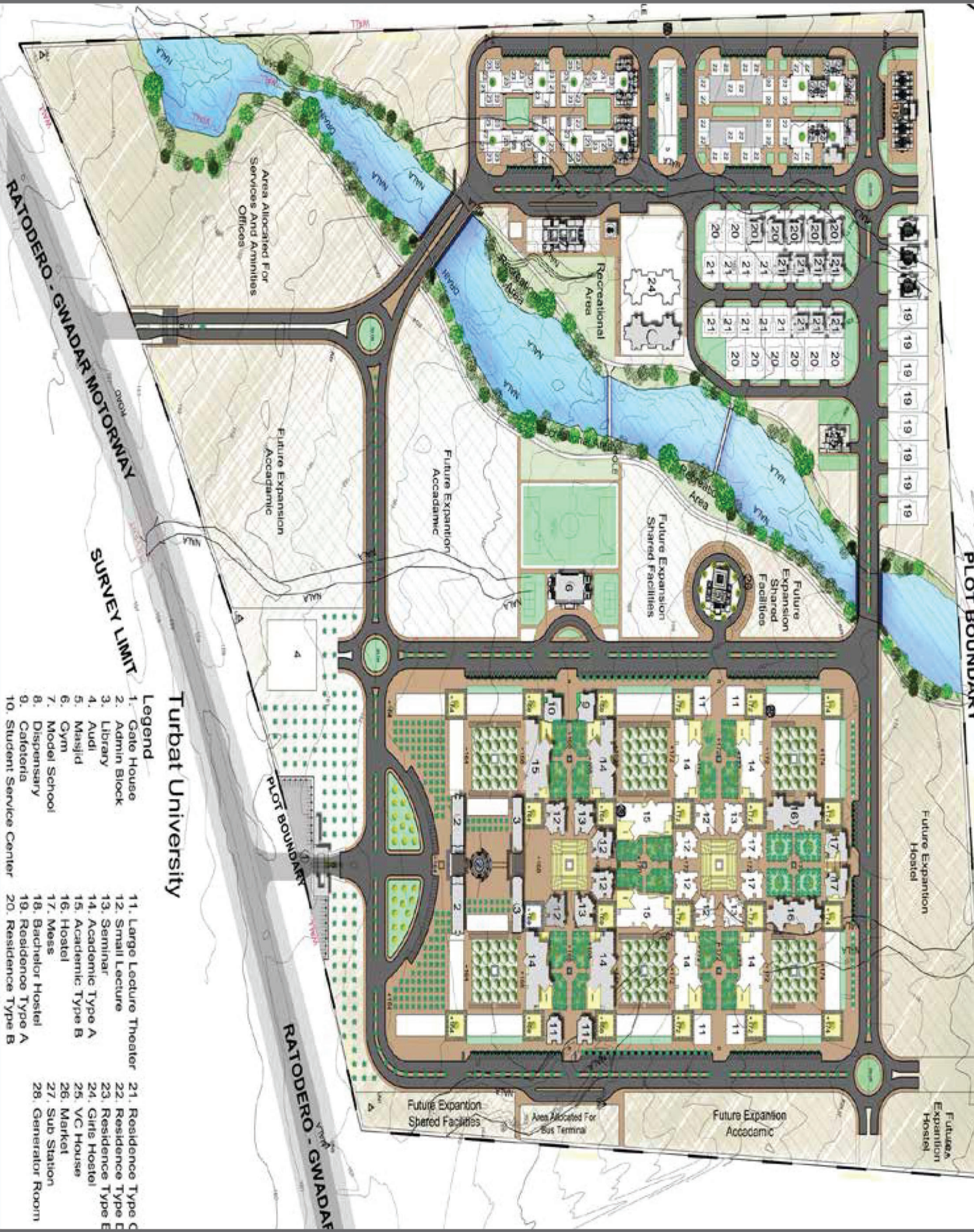
