University of Turbat: A fast rising university in the country

The University of Turbat (UoT) is a multidisciplinary public sector general university, chartered by the government of Balochistan in 2012, located at M-8 Turbat district Kech of Makran division. The Charter of the University was passed by the Provincial Assembly of Balochistan on 20th June, 2012, assented by the Honorable Governor Balochistan on 26th in the same year, and was notified in the Provincial Gazette on 28th June 2012.

Before converting into an autonomous university, it was remained a Sub-Campus of University of Balochistan from 2009 to 2012 with three teaching departments started in a rented building at Airport Road Turbat. The Sub-Campus of Balochistan University (UoB) was upgraded into a full-fledged university in 2013 as university of Turbat due to the efforts and support of the campus employees, higher authorities of UoB, HEC, Federal & Provincial Governments, public representatives of the area and civil society.



Now the University has four faculties with fifteen departments including one institute IBLC (Institute of Balochi Language and Culture) in the main campus and eight departments in its sub campuses at Gwadar and Panjgur. University of Turbat was recognized by the Higher Education Commission (HEC) as 168th Public Sector University in the country and Second Public Sector General University in Balochistan on 12th March 2014.

Prof. Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir (TI) and Dr. Abdul Saboor Baloch took over the charge as first & founder Vice Chancellor and Pro Vice Chancellor of the University respectively. While Muhammad Hayat, Ghulam Farooq and Tanvir Ahmed served as first Registrar, Treasurer and Controller of Examinations respectively. Within a short span of time the Vice chancellor with the support of qualified faculty members and smart working administrative staff succeeded to enlist UoT among the fast rising institute of higher education in the country.

The main objective of establishing this university is the provision of better opportunities of quality higher education to the people of entire province, mainly the remote and backward areas of Balochistan including districts Kech, Panjgur, Gwadar, and neighboring districts of Awaran, Kharan and Washuk (which cover around 1/5th of the total area of the province) to bring them at par with other parts of the province/country in all walks of life. The UoT offers admission to the aspirants from across the country without any difference of caste, creeds, color and race.



The civil work of the 1st phase of the project Establishment of University of Turbat” was formally inaugurated by the then Chief Minister Balochistan Dr. Abdul Malik Baloch which was completed in a record period of five years while the civil work on 2nd phase approved by the CDWP has recently been inaugurated by the Prime Minister of Pakistan Mr. Imran Khan during his visit to the University of Turbat on 13th November 2020.

The university building comprises all facilities for learning including academic blocks, class rooms, lecture theaters, video conference hall, Computer labs, multipurpose hall, Science laboratories, Cafeteria, student facilitation center, admin blocks, bachelors hostels, central library, seminar



libraries, boy's hostel, girl's hostel, residential colony, sport complex, mosque, model school, banks, medical center, green built, botanical garden, standby power house, load-shedding-free university feeder as well as water and drainage facilities and internal roads and footpath networks.

The University of Turbat got a distinguished place among the list of best growing universities of the country in short span of time for its rapid growth due to the tireless efforts of the Vice

Chancellor Prof Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir and his dedicated team, support from federal and provincial government, HEC, Governor Balochistan, public representatives and civil society. The University has been at the frontline in the efforts to create new vistas of knowledge for the youth of the region, therefore, the students not only from Mekran division but also from all over Balochistan are keen to take admission in this rapidly rising university.

Around 200 highly qualified faculty members and administrative staff are making their utmost efforts in providing quality education and enhancing entrepreneurial skills of more than 3500 students. The faculty members are also engaged with dedication in providing research-led teaching to the students



enabling them to become exceptional individuals equipped with advanced knowledge for playing vibrant role in national development. The University has organized many seminars, workshops, training sessions, Paigham-e-Pakistan events, literary and academic events, international lecture series, certification courses in IT and entrepreneurship, business galas, sport festivals, book fairs, CSS preparatory classes, study and exposure visits.

The university through Financial Aid Office is providing financial assistance to its students through Ehsaas Undergraduate Scholarship, BEEF scholarship, HEC Need Based scholarship, UoT merit based Scholarship, Pakistan Baitul-mal, Kareem Dashti scholarship, Meer Ilahi Bakhsh Scholarship and other scholarships sponsored by philanthropists and organizations. The University has the distinction for organizing two graduating ceremony in short span of time.



1st Graduating Ceremony was chaired by the then Governor Balochistan Muhammad Khan Achakzai and Ex-Chief Minister Balochistan Dr. Abdul Malik Baloch held on 8th March 2017 in which 220 graduates were conferred degrees and 12 position-winning graduates were awarded gold medals.



The University accomplished another milestone in short span of time by organizing its 2nd Graduating Ceremony on 22nd April 2019. Presiding over the 2nd convocation, Governor Balochistan Justice (R) Amanullah Khan Yasinzai awarded gold medals to 22 position holders, and degrees to more than 300 graduating students including seven M.Phil. Scholars from department of Balochi.

The graduates of the University are expected to play an active role in the activities of the projects under CPEC to bring about prosperity in the region. A good number of graduates of the University are serving in different departments of public and private sectors in Balochistan and other parts of the country.

Research and publications have been the defining distinction of the University ever since its establishment. Research activities got more momentum in university after starting M.Phil./MS



programs in the department of Balochi, Chemistry and Management Sciences. University of Turbat launched its very first annual research journal GIDROSHIA for this specific purpose while IBLC has also initiated its research journal (MEERI) duly recognized by the HEC. The department of Management Sciences is also planning to launch its research journal very soon.

Around 50 faculty members and scholars have been sent to different universities of Pakistan and abroad for MS, Ph.D. and MS leading to Ph.D. under the Human Resource Development Program, Aghaz e Haqooq Balochistan and other HEC scholarships scheme. Some of them, after completion of their studies have re-joined University and rest of them are expected to rejoin the university in near future. By the year 2023 the number of Ph.D. faculty is expected to raise from sixteen to fifty.



The University succeeded to hold the meetings of its statutory bodies well in due course of time.

The UoT conducted meeting of Syndicate ten times, Academic Council eleven times, Finance and Planning Committee eleven times, Academic Council eleven time, Advanced Studies and Research Board (ASRB) ten times, Selection Board eight times, as well as the most important meeting of the apex body, the Senate five times.

Directorate of Information Technology, the backbone of the university, connected to the Pakistan Education and Research Network (PERN). It provides Wifi and other IT related services to students, faculty members and administrative staff. The availability of IT facilities enhanced the university's crisis management functions. It helped university to become more responsive to face any crisis like COVID-19. This IT facilities enabled university to manage online classes and distant e-learning. Students are being taught through latest technology which can create a set of skill that will help students throughout their future careers. A video conference Hall has been established by HEC to connect the university with national and international institutions of higher learning.

Besides dedicated libraries in each departments, university also has a central campus library in main campus and a public library in the main city with more than 40,000 books on different subjects.

The Quality Enhancement Cell with the support of HEC is working effectively according to the needs of modern time with the responsibility to ensure quality education. Besides conducting faculty training & development workshops, the QEC also prepares self-assessment reports of the faculty members.

University has signed a number of MOUs with leading national and international universities and educational and research institutions for exchange of research skills, knowledge and expertise.

After seven years of its commencement, the university has achieved another distinction in the country by establishing its two campuses in Gwadar and Panjgur.

The academic activities in Gwadar campus were started from January 2017. The HEC has granted formal accreditation to the campus in September 2018.

Government of Pakistan and HEC had already decided to upgrade the same campus into a full-fledged university in near future. The charter of University of Gwadar was approved by the CM Jam Mir Kamal Aliyani led Balochistan Assembly in November, 2018.

Turbat University accomplished another achievement by establishing its second campus at Panjgur in 2019. Academic activities in Panjgur Campus was started from spring 2020 semester. After the visit of Accreditation & Attestation Committee in December 2020, the HEC granted NoC to the Panjgur Campus in January 2021.

The Office of Research, Innovation, and Commercialization (ORIC) is striving to establish strong links with industry in order to facilitate the students for seeking internships and getting research projects for ensuring their future career.

A bi-annual newsletter "KECH NEWS" from main campus and "ZERWAAN NEWS" from Gwadar campus are another symbol of distinction for the University. A career counseling and students affairs cell have been established to help the students to resolve job related issues such as finding work and setting career goals.

Many ideas and projects are in pipeline as the part of short and long term strategic plan of the University. Introducing new science and market oriented programs of study, sending more faculty members abroad for higher study, training and refreshment courses, starting MS and Ph.D. programs in different disciplines, starting Chinese, English and Balochi

language courses, affiliation of more degree colleges and educational institutions with university, hosting national and international conferences, launching housing scheme for its employees, setting up constituent Model Higher Secondary School and generating revenue by its own resources are among the main mission of future roadmap of Turbat University.

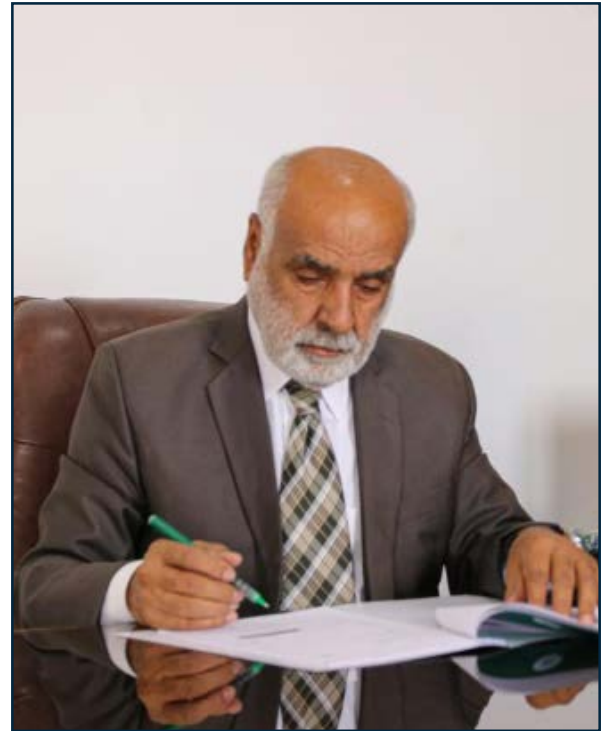

Institute of Balochi Language & Culture (IBLC)

Introduction

The Institute of Balochi Language and Culture (IBLC) in the University of Turbat was first established as the Department of Balochi Language and Literature in 2013 to cater the needs of the students of Balochi language and literature. Soon after its establishment the department became one of the most popular departments of the University with enrolling more students in its first batch and proved itself to be the center of excellence for the study, teaching and research about Balochi language, history, literature and culture.

Seeing its popularity and feeling the need of time the university administration, on the wishes of the Ex-Chief Minister Balochistan Dr. Abdul Malik Baloch, upgraded the department of Balochi language and literature in the University of Turbat in 2016, to an Institute (Institute of Balochi Language and Culture) and its horizons were widened and broadened to research and work on Baloch history, language, literature, culture, oral traditions and a lot more which particularly pertain to Baloch and its culture.

Apart from offering BS (4 years/8 semester) MA (2 years/4 semesters), and MPhil programs, the Institute is also planning to offer PhD programs shortly. Moreover, the institute is also running a chair attributed to legendary Baloch poet Mulla Fazul, named as 'Mulla Fazul Chair'. The institute is also publishing a research journal 'Meeri' in which the research papers from well-known authors and researchers regarding Balochi language, literature and culture are published in it. Meeri is also a recognized research journal from HEC.

The institute, apart from conducting and supervising scholarly and academic works on formation, classification and standardization of Balochi terminologies related to the different aspects of life, is also working on Indexation of Balochi research journals. The Institute has also setup a reference library, established a Museum, a Center for Translation studies & Culture, Oriental and Occidental Language Center, Collection of general Archives, and a Baloch Cultural Exhibition Center are in the pipeline. The Institute is also working on Balochi Music and on preservation of Balochi Oral traditions. The aim of the institute is to streamline Balochi language, literature, history, and culture with the national and international languages and cultures. Besides, the Institute also aims to sign MoUs with international organizations working on the national and international languages, literatures, and cultures.

UoT IT section revamped and launched the website of the university on 2020-08-10.

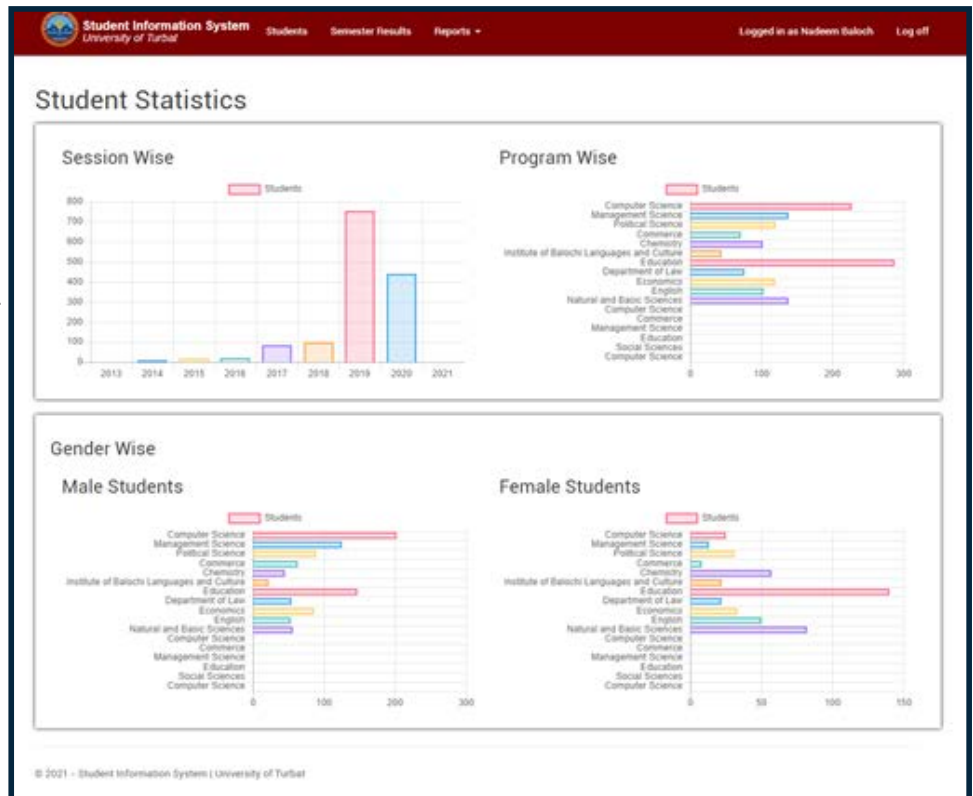
The new website is much improved with a ton of new features, including

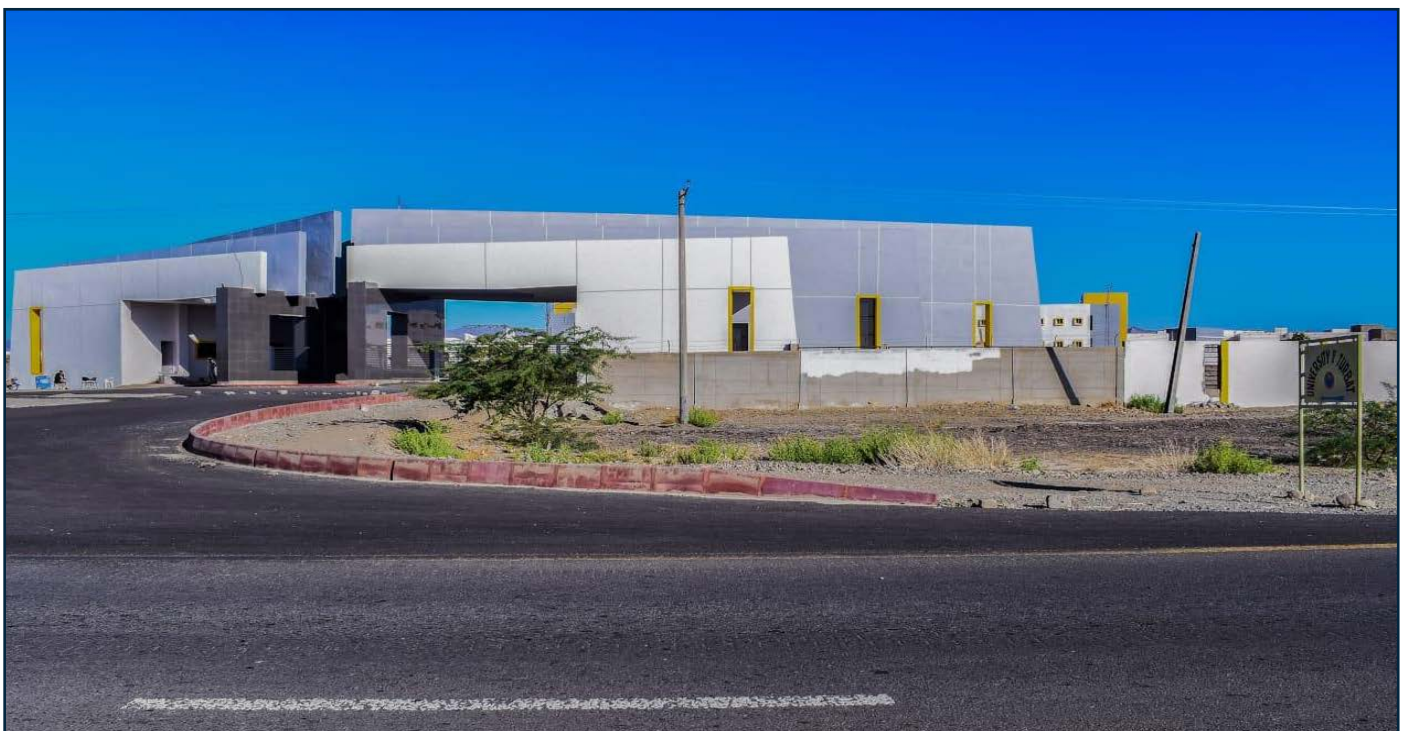
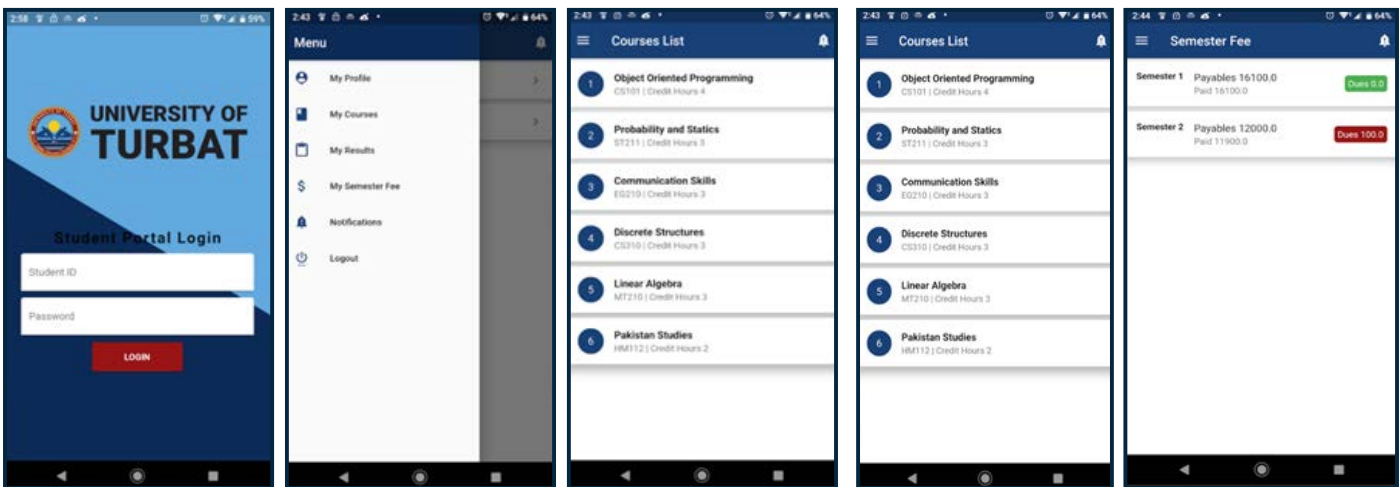
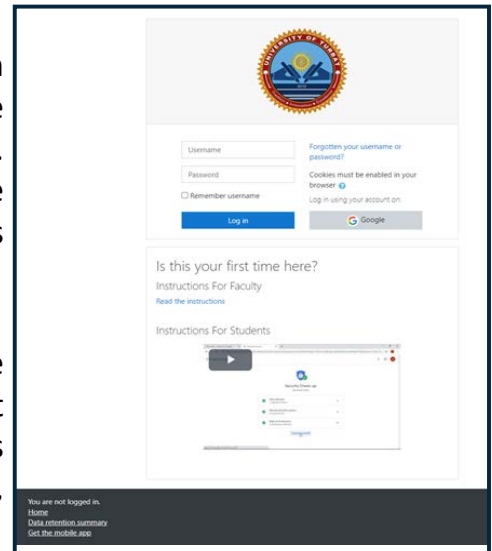


4. Learning Management System (LMS)

Photo Desk, on the request of concerned sections and after the prior approval of the Competent Authority will arrange the photo coverage of functions and activities of various departments/ sections of the University for Press, university website and social media for publicity and image building of the university. It will also prepare photographs for exhibitions and maintains photo albums.

Press and Publicity Desk

This desk will arrange press conferences and press briefings, and keeps liaison with print & electronic media. This desk will be entrusted with the task of issuing of press releases, photographs and video footages regarding various events conducted at university to local and national media.

Production Desk

Besides coordinating in publishing publicity literature like Calendar, Datebook, Diary, Telephone

Directory of university employees, this desk in collaboration with IT section also helps to publish booklets, brochures, annual report, newsletter, posters, hoardings and other promotional tools from time to time pertaining to important achievements and the campaigns of university. It will also make arrangements for production of short video documentary on university achievements, future programs and other events organized by the University.

Advertisement Desk

The Advertisement Desk will offer its services to win the attention of the people toward University of Turbat through advertisements in print/electronic media, local cable TV network and social media. The advertisement desk will facilitate to release university classified advertisements/ announcements/ public service messages in press and local Cable TV Network on approved government rates.

Library and Exhibition Desk

This Desk will deal with maintaining a small library, wherein Clipped News Items pertaining to UoT, Periodicals, Magazines, Daily Newspapers and Publications are kept and preserve in safe hands. This Desk will be responsible to maintain the record of Magazines, Periodicals, Newspapers, Pamphlets and all sort of publications receives to this office from the other institutes of the country and abroad.

It will have a direct association with the university central library. It will also make arrangements for organizing Photo-Exhibitions for Faculty Members/Students and other stakeholders.

Social Media

In today's world, most of the communication takes place through number of social networking services which are very quick and effective. Mir Bahad Protocol Officer, Salman Essa PRO, Naseer Muhammad Office Assistant and Aftab Aslam Assistant Registrar will operate social net-working service for UoT and its Sub-campus at Gwadar and Panjgur. The UoT's website and WhatsApp group will be operated/managed by Web Developer Junaid Qadir and PSO to VC respectively. All UoT's information will be communicated through official media by abovementioned admin.

Introduction

Quality Enhancement Cell started working vigorously in 2013 under the kind supervision and patronage of the Vice Chancellor. The Vice Chancellor provided required space and necessary equipment for getting more effective and efficient working. QEC started working with the staff appointment. Current QEC staff include Professor Doctor Gul Hassan as Director QEC, Mr. Noman Shakeel as Data Analyst and Mr. Ganjbaksh Lal as Office Assistant.

A quality culture has been developing in the University of Turbat. Almost all degree Programs offered by teaching departments of the University in different subjects in the process of accreditation by the respective accreditation bodies.

Mission

QEC is committed to assure and enhance the quality of higher education at University of Turbat with respect to good teaching strategies, sound infrastructure, outcome based education, positive students' perception, valid programs assessment tools and a learning environment conducive to research activities.

Objectives

- To collate data through feedback forms and course outlines/ plans from the respective departments.
- To conduct trainings on regular basis for the Program & Assessment Team in order to generate awareness regarding self-assessment process.
- To assess the current status of educational provision at departmental level by holding meetings with the Program & Assessment Team.
- To critically examine the data and formulate recommendations in consultation with the concerned Head/Chairperson/ In-charge of the department.
- To follow the progress of the corrective actions highlighted in the Self-Assessment Report (SAR) by the respective departments.
- To affirm whether curriculum, subject and staff development, research and other scholarly activities are conducted as per the HEC criteria.
- To facilitate the respective departments in getting accreditation certificate from the councils/ bodies prescribed by Higher Education Commission.
- To acquire the membership of the international agencies working in the domain of quality assurance.
- To verify whether Institutional Performance Evaluation Standards (IPES) devised for the betterment of Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) are in accordance with the HEC guidelines.
- To make sure that the university abides by the rules & regulations set by HEC in terms of faculty appointment, admission to MS/M.Phil. and Ph.D. programs and last but not the least, plagiarism detection service by utilizing Turnitin Software.

University of Turbat Gwadar Campus:

After the establishment of Gwadar campus university of Turbat at Gwadar the QEC section of the campus was also established. During the visit of the Director QEC at Gwadar campus officially announced the foundation of the QEC section at Gwadar campus and soon after that the notification issued by the registrar university of Turbat for the coordinator QEC. It has been three years that the QEC Gwadar section is running properly according to the departmental mission and vision. During this short time period the QEC Gwadar campus section has achieved many milestones under the leadership and guidance of worthy vice chancellor Prof. Dr. Razzaq Sabir and Director QEC Prof. Dr. Gul Hassan. The Current staff of the QEC at Gwadar campus include: Muhammad Irshad coordinator QEC Gwadar campus.

University of Turbat Panjgur Campus:

After the successful establishment of Gwadar campus, the University of Turbat has established its second campus at Panjgur. The academic activities in Panjgur campus has been started and recently the admission for its second batch has also been announced. Under the leadership of worthy Vice Chancellor, the University of Turbat Panjgur campus has admitted three hundred plus students in its first batch. Soon after the beginning of academic activities at Panjgur Campus and with the directives of the Director QEC Prof Dr. Gul Hassan the QEC setup for QEC has also been established and Mr. Safar Khan Qumi, Lecturer Management Sciences UoT Panjgur Campus has been nominated as QEC Focal Person.

QEC Academic Section

QEC intends to improve the standard of academic quality by developing a healthy liaison with HEC and with all faculties of UoT. Most of the projects which are currently executing under QEC are major part of it. These include:

- Self-Assessment Reports of all Faculties
- MS/PhD Program Reviews
- Institutional Performance Evaluation (IPE)
- NOC of any new MS and PhD Programs from HEC
- National & International Rankings (HEC, QS, Times Higher Education)
- Pakistan Qualification Register (PQR)
- Provision of Roadmap of Academic Programs and their Approvals.

Other than aforementioned tasks, QEC is also aimed to provide assistance to all faculties of UoT regarding their memberships and accreditations with major National and International bodies.

All processes which are under the domain of academia need to be formulated and validated by the QEC e.g. to validate the number of HEC approved research papers for promotion criteria. To formulate the unframed process (e.g. the research policy), this division will integrate with the parent department (the owner of process) and assists them in framing and approving the process.

Other projects which can be initiated under this division can be QS Ranking Application Process and Times Ranking Application Process.

Data Analytics Section

This section intends to collect and analyze the data and come up with various reports, which can be used to improve the quality of academia and services. The core projects of this division may include formulation of online surveys by integrating with main departments. These surveys may include:

- 1) Student Satisfaction Survey
- 2) Faculty Satisfaction Survey
- 3) Alumni Survey
- 4) Employer Survey
- 5) Survey of Graduating Students
- 6) Course and Teachers Evaluation Survey

Collaboration with IBA Sukkur

On the onset of Covid-19 Pandemic and as per the Guidelines of Higher Education Commission, The Quality Enhancement Cell, University of Turbat in Collaboration with IBA Sukkur has successfully launched the e learning platform for distance education delivery / online education.

SELF-ASSESSMENT REPORTS OF TARGETED DEGREE PROGRAM (2019 – 2021)

The Self- Assessment of Degree programs at University of Turbat for the Academic year 2019 – 2021 has been started and the departments were requested to nominate Program Team Members that will be responsible for the preparation of self-assessment report.

QEC EVALUATION

The QUALITY ENHANCEMENT CELL in collaboration with the department of computer science designed an open source survey tool, and deployed the same within the local server of UoT. This survey tool is accessible within the intranet environment of UoT and campuses connected with UoT network. The Quality Enhancement Cell has so far conducted online Teacher evaluation survey, student course evaluation survey, Survey of graduating students, & Alumni survey in which a total of more than eighteen hundred students have participated.

INSTITUTIONAL PERFORMANCE EVALUATION (IPE 2019 - 2021)

The Institutional Performance Evaluation (IPE) is a set of eleven standards called the quality standards designed by the Higher Education Commission's Quality Assurance Agency in order to improve the performance of higher educating institutes. The QUALITY ENHANCEMENT CELL, University of Turbat started conducting of self - institutional performance evaluation (IPE) for the fiscal year 2019 – 2020.

Recurring Grant

Soon after being recognized by HEC, the University of Turbat started receiving annual recurring grant from HEC w.e.f September, 2014. It received total grant of Rs. 45 (M) during 2014-2015, Rs. 101 (M) during 2015-2016, Rs. 138 (M) during F/Y 2016-2017, 2017-18 Rs. 129 (M), during F/Y 2018-2019 Rs. 136 (M), during F/Y 2019-2020 Rs. 121 (M), and for the current FY 2020-2021 Rs. 183.22(M).

Endowment Fund

The former CM of Balochistan Dr. Abdul Malik Baloch had announced during the stone laying ceremony of the UoT Project on 6th Feb, 2014 to provide funds for establishment of UoT’s endowment funds. Accordingly, an amount of Rs. 50 (M) was received from GoB during last quarter of F/Y 2013-2014 which was invested in three years’ term deposit in NBP @ 11.75% p.a after obtaining comparative rates of interest through open and transparent bidding.

After maturity the original amount plus 50% of the profit were invested in Habib Bank Limited (HBL)@ 10.70 for one year and @7.45% for further one year in HBL after obtaining comparative rate of interest to “AAA” rating Banks.

This fund was meant for investment in the long term deposit/securities in order to meet long term financial needs of the University and the profit/interest will be utilized for providing scholarships and other benefits to the students.

Grant in aid

The honorable Governor Balochistan/ Chancellor PSU’s of Balochistan has very kindly granted a total amount of Rs. 145.81 (M) during the six years i.e. 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019 as Grant in Aid. The Provincial Government Enhanced the Grant in Aid allocation to Rs. 1500 (M) for FY 2019-20 and formed Universities Finance Commission for its distribution.

Accordingly, the University of Turbat is granted Rs. 152.274 for FY 2019-20 and 152.488 for FY 2020-21 which have been spent for the heads and purposes prescribed by the Government of Balochistan. Provincial Government has also released a grant of Rs. 50 (M) each for the Gwadar Campus and Panjgur Campus for the year 2020-21.

Future Plans

The Management of University of Turbat is determined to make the University finically health and stable in the long run. To achieve this objective, it aims in enhancing its revenue earning capacity on the one hand and strengthening financial discipline and governance on the other hand. The university has already started the process of affiliating all the colleges and other institutions within its jurisdiction as well as to register Private Candidates. It is expected that this will bring in significant revenues during subsequent years. There are a number of other plans in pipeline aimed at making the organization financially self-sustaining.



Office for Research, Innovation & Commercialization (ORIC)



Introduction

The office of research innovation and commercialization (ORIC) at University of Turbat has been established in line with the aims of Higher Education Commission (HEC) that attempts to make a major contribution to economic prosperity, national well-being and the expansion of knowledge.

Mission

The mission of the Office for Research is to develop, expand, enhance and manage the university's research programs and to link research activities directly to the educational, social and economic priorities of the university and its broader community. The office is also responsible for assuring that the quality of research reflects the highest international standards and advances the stature of the university among the world's best research institutions. Moreover, the office aims to be the best research center of the region and build and sustain productive relationship and linkages with the governmental agencies, international academic and governmental agencies, private sectors, industries, elementary and secondary schools and colleges. Further, innovation and production of ideas, patents and innovation would remain as the core values of the office.

In pursuit of this mission the Office of Research has the responsibility of guaranteeing that all research programs and policies reflect the core values of academic freedom, professional integrity and ethical conduct and full compliance with all policies, legal requirements and operational standards of the university.

Objectives of ORIC

The main objectives of the ORIC at UOT are as follows

- To formulate and support university's strategic research direction and policies.
- To enhance and diversify research funding.
- To create an environment so that research remains an integral component of academic activities at UOT.
- To ensure that high quality research of direct relevance to Pakistan's needs.
- To facilitate establishment of linkages between UOT and the industry.
- To provide information about research funding opportunities to faculty and students.
- To encourage and assist UOT researchers/faculty in obtaining research grants from the Public / Private Sector.
- Facilitate timely completion of funded research and development projects.
- Maintain efficient and productive communication channels with funding agencies.
- Facilitate and support UOT researchers for publication and presentation of their research work through participation in research activities so as to cater for industry requirements.
- To improve/ Strengthens university- industry relationship.
- To conduct national and international conferences/seminars/sessions
- To help students to obtain funds for their research projects.

Core Activities of the year 2020

• ORIC - University of Turbat organized one day Lecture session on topic titled: SOCIO-ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF PAKISTAN; THE ROLE OF YOUTH, held on Friday, 31st January, 2020 at Video Conference Room, University of Turbat.

The resource person for the event was Mr. Sikander Bizenjo, he is an Economist and a development practitioner with analytical and research skills. He is currently heading a project named “URBAN YOUTH PROJECT” at Karachi Schools of Business and Leadership. The project that he is heading has an ambition to economically and socially empower individuals to become job creators.

• The ORIC-UOT organized a lecture session on “IDENTITY AND IDEOLOGY OF GLOBAL POLITICS: RESENTMENT AND ASSERTION FOR RECOGNITION”, by Dr Manzoor Ahmed Baloch, held on 21st Feb, 2020 at Video Conference room-UOT.

Dr. Manzoor Ahmed Baloch is the Dean Faculty of Management and Social Sciences and Associate Professor of Department of Economics at Lasbela University of Agriculture, Water and Marine Sciences (LUAWMS). He is a PhD from Durham University UK, his research works include; dynamics of Ethno-Nationalism, Federalism and Economic Development in Balochistan.

• The ORIC UOT organized a two day workshop titled Turbat University Workshop and Competition held on 11th and 12th August 2020. The panelists were Dr. Yarjan Abdul Samad, Dr. Warda Inam, Dr. Waqas Rashid, Mr. Benjamin Ting, Ameer Hamza and Abdullah and the participants of the workshop were students. The panelists joined online via video link with the student at the Video Conference Room, University of Turbat. The purpose of the workshop was to motivate the students of UoT to bring new business ideas and find the solution to the problems. Also, they make themselves ready for startup competition and avail funds in Pakistan and different countries. The workshop was headed by the Dr. Haneef ur Rehman Director ORIC. In the first day, the panelists were Dr. Yarjan Abudal Samad, Dr. Warda Inam and Abdullah.

• ORIC-University of Turbat hosted an Awareness Session conducted by National Incubation Center-Quetta (NIC-Quetta) on 13th October 2020.

The awareness session was regarding Business Incubation Program (Cohort 4) by NIC Quetta, which is a six (06) months incubation program where startups will work on turning their ideas into business with the technical support and mentorship of NIC Quetta. Upon successful completion of the Incubation Program, startups will be eligible to make pitches in Investor’s Summit, where they may get funding/investment for scaling up their businesses.

• The ORIC-University of Turbat organized a session titled: “Water Management and Sustainable Future”. The guest speaker of the session was MS. Simi Kamal. who is the program head of Pakistan Poverty Alleviation Fund (PPAF) and have wide experience in working on different sectors such as; Water Management, Climate Change and Social Development.

Ms. Simi Kamal shared her extensive thirty (30) years’ experience on the water management, her linkages throughout the world in dealing with water issues, climate matters. Further, she emphasized students to take self-initiatives in dealing with climate changes, protect the environment starting from the very individual level.

Financial Aid Office (FAO)



Financial Aid Office, University of Turbat, was established in order to facilitate talented and less privilege students for grant of scholarship on merit and need bases.

Mr. Abdul Jabbar, Lecturer Department of Management Sciences is the focal person of the Students Financial Aid Office, University of Turbat.

The University of Turbat, Financial Aid office is dealing with multiple Need Based and Merit Based Scholarships. The Financial Aid office is currently dealing with four major Scholarship programs including HEC Need Based Scholarship, Ehsaas Undergraduate Scholarship Project, Balochistan Education Endowment Fund (BEEF) and Pakistan Bait-UI-Maal. Under The HEC Need Based Scholarship program, the office has provided 190 Scholarship to the students from session 2015 to 2020, These Scholarships were provided to the bachelor and Master students of various disciplines within the UoT. Under Ehsaas Undergraduate Scholarship Project, the office has provided 654 scholarship to BS students of various discipline. Moreover, under Baluchistan Education Endowment Fund Merit Based Scholarship program, 250 students were awarded scholarships of announced policy of 2017-2018 and 2018-2019. Furthermore, Pakistan Bait-UI Mall is provided 50 scholarships to needy students.

Section of Botanical Gardens



The section of Botanical Garden university of Turbat has been established in 2018. The aim of the section is to maintain and enhance the lawns and greenery of the university which will result in a human friendly ecosystem in the campus. It plays key role in plant conservation. It is place of collection of living plants grown for educational, recreational, economic medicinal scientific purpose. Mr. Muzaffir Hussain (Assistant Professor Department of Political Science) was the first incharge of the Botanical Garden Section and currently Mr. Ghous Bakhsh (Assistant Registrar General) has been assigned the charge of Botanical Garden Section. The section has initiated different programs for plantation, awareness regarding plantation, awareness regarding cleanliness and safe health. The University has as many as 16 grassy lawns.

The plantation in the University of Turbat's new campus was inaugurated by the Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir. All the faculty members, students from all departments and the administration are taking active part in the plantation process. The section has already planted more than 3000 plants from 2018-2020 and commits to achieve the target of planting more than 10,000 plants at the main campus university of Turbat and Law department city campus up to 2022.

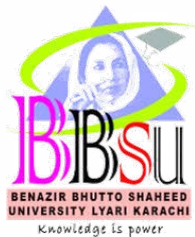

Computer Laboratories

The University of Turbat (UoT) has well furnished and equipped computer labs working under the Computer Science Department and IT section of the University, there are more than 200 latest new computers have been provided to the University Computer Laboratory. This service provides net services to the Central Library, departments, faculty and administrative offices 24 hours. In the Central Labs, PCs are provided, offering a range of standard office software for document creation and presentations. Specialist provision is available to support research and advanced study within the University. Computers in the campus are connected to the University's main server through a wide area network giving access via the internet to the major information, research and communications networks worldwide. A new lab having around 40 latest computers has been established in the department of Management Science during 2020.



Campus Library

The books and reading material available in Library support not only every course in the curriculum i.e. Management Sciences, Computer Science, Commerce, Economic, Political Science, English, and Balochi but also include selected stock of general books and materials on History, Anthropology, Islamic Studies, Geography, Archeology, Regional Studies, languages and literature, published by National and International publishers, Library also has subscribed national and international periodicals, publications, newspapers in English, Urdu and Balochi etc. The whole library system at campus library is being computerized and HEC has been asked to provide facilities for online library service which will be available through a network after the completion of the computerization process. The library also has a reasonable number of internationally published Research Journals.



Student Hostels

University of Turbat has students from all over Makran that are enrolled in different programs. Some of the students are not resident of Turbat City. For them, UoT has 3 buildings for hostels, which include 2 for boys and 1 for girls, with all basic needs and comfort in the campus. Each hostel has its own cook and mess, which is partially supported by the University. There are security guards on each hostel, and a female warden for the girl's hostel.



University Transportation

The University of Turbat has four buses, one coaster and 2 Vans to provide pick and drop facility to the students living in Turbat city and suburbs. The University also provides transport facility to its students for field work and annual picnics once a year to each department on need basis. The study tours for students are partly financed by the students and supplemented by the University, subject to availability of funds. UoT also has an ambulance for the students and faculties. 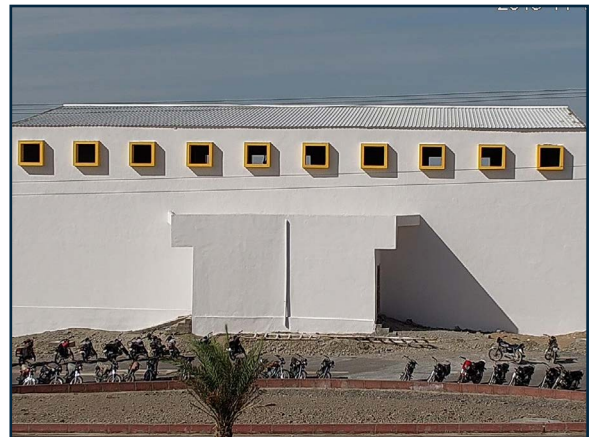
Mosque

The idea of establishment of a Sub Campus of Turbat University (UoT) in Gwadar was initiated by the Vice Chancellor (VC) Prof Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir in 2015. A team of expert led by the VC, prepared and tabled the proposal of establishment of Gwadar Campus in Syndicate in its third meeting as item No.6 held on May 30, 2015 for approval. The expert team was comprised on Director IBLC and Dean Faculty of Arts and Social Science Dr. Abdul Saboor Baloch, Ex- PD of UoT Manzoor Ahmed Baloch, DF/Registrar Ghulam Farooq Baloch, Muhammad Hayat, Director Public Relation Ijaz Ahmed and chairpersons of various department. The Finance and Planning Committee also endorsed and approved the idea of establishment of Gwadar Campus in its fourth meeting as item No.5 held on June 29, 2015 held at Karachi.

After thorough discussion and approval of recommendation towards establishment of Gwadar Campus from different meetings and statutory bodies the proposal was presented in the UoT's apex statutory body (the Senate) during its first meeting chaired by Ex-Governor Balochistan/Chancellor PSUs Muhammad Khan Achakzai, held on March 30, 2016 at University Public Library Turbat.

In pursuance of principle approval by Ex- Governor Balochistan, the Higher Education Commission Pakistan issued a notification on July 4, 2016 to set up a Sub Campus of University of Turbat at CPEC central city Gwadar.

Finally in order to supplement commercial/economic activities under CPEC, the UoT had initiated educational and training activities by establishing its campus at Gwadar under the Umbrella Project of "Establishment of Sub Campuses of Public Sector Universities at district level (phase-1)" initiated by HEC. Academic activities were started from January 2017. The Federal Government has already decided to upgrade the campus into a full fledged University.



i. Current building and departments in UoT's Gwadar campus

The university campus started its academic activities from January 2017 in a part of Govt. Boys Degree College building for interim period with four BS programs in the fields of Management Sciences, Computer Science, Education and Commerce. Besides a portion of College building for academic activities, two other buildings for hostels were also taken on rent.

ii. Enrollment and faculty

The first admissions in four BS Programs were announced on August 31, 2016 while applications for the position of Lecturer were invited on October 18, 2016. At present more than 421 students are enrolled in the Campus. The number of regular faculty members is 15 while 20 teachers are providing services on part time basis.

iii. No Objection Certificate to Campus by HEC

The HEC accorded formal recognition of the campus in September 2018. Here it's worth mentioning that among all the university's Sub Campuses of Balochistan established same umbrella project, Gwadar campus has the credit for being first campus which recognized by HEC.

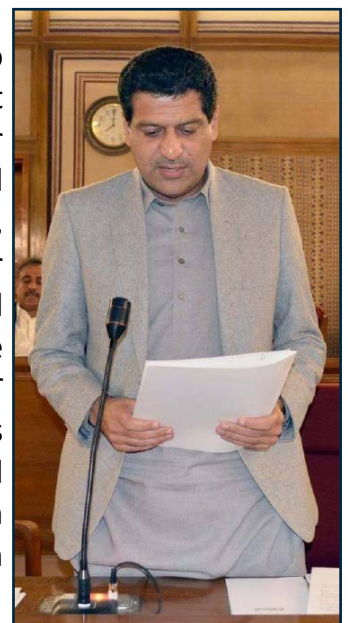
Progress towards establishment of University of Gwadar

Here it is pertinent to mention that Government of Pakistan had decided to establish a University at Gwadar under CPEC and accordingly a project titled “Establishment of University of Gwadar” was included in Federal PSDP 2016-2017, and 2017-18. Then Prime Minister of Pakistan during his visit to Gwadar, formally inaugurated the project of University of Gwadar on 1st September 2016 amid other projects of CPEC. At the same time Federal Government/HEC asked VC Turbat University:

1. To prepare Charter of University of Gwadar (completed in time).
2. To prepare PC-1 for Gwadar University (completed in time).
3. To ask local administration for allotment of state land for University of Gwadar (completed in time).
4. To establish UoT’s campus at Gwadar (as future university of Gwadar (completed in time).

Charter of University of Gwadar

Meanwhile the HEC requested University of Turbat in July 2016 to prepare the Charter of the University of Gwadar. Accordingly the draft charter was prepared by UoT and submitted to HEC in March 2017. After betting the Charter by HEC and concerned forums, it was finally passed by the CM Jam Kamal led Balochistan Assembly on 3rd November, 2018, and the same was assented by the Governor Balochistan/Chancellor Public Sector Universities (PSUs). The bill was presented by the provincial minister Mr. Zahoor Ahmed Buledi. Governor Balochistan Honorable Justice (R) Amanullah Khan Yasinzai during meetings with VC UoT assured to take every possible steps for development of Gwadar Campus and establishment of University of Gwadar. Earlier VC UoT Prof Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir along with Director Gwadar Campus Mr. Ijaz Ahmed, on 7th September 2018 has given a detailed briefing to the CM Balochistan regarding Gwadar University Project.



PC-1 /Feasibility Study of University of Gwadar (PC-II)



On the request of HEC, a PC-I was also prepared by University of Turbat at a cost of Rs. 5.727 (Billion) and submitted to HEC in the end of 2016. Meanwhile a meeting was held in HEC on 29th November 2016 in which it was decided that instead of PC-I, a PC-II should be prepared to conduct the academic feasibility of the University. Accordingly a PC-II was approved by the CDWP on April, 2017. Feasibility study completed and submitted to HEC in April 2018. The PC-1 will be prepared by HEC on the basis of the recommendations of feasibility study. According to feasibility study, the Gwadar University will be a residential university. The University is conceived to be a special purpose university which shall produce high quality human resource for CPEC.

Land for University of Gwadar

A piece of state land measuring 500 acres located in Mouza Shabi Tehsil & District Gwadar under khasra No.20, 21, had been allotted in favor of University of Gwadar in September, 2018. However the efforts are underway to acquire a piece of land for Gwadar University in education enclave earmarked in newly launched Gwadar master Plan.

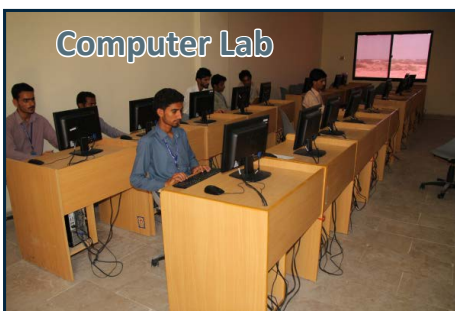

University of Turbat Panjgur Campus



Introduction

The University of Turbat (UoT) in its endeavor to fulfill its charter obligation to disseminate knowledge and to ensure access to Higher Education to all students so that deserving students are not deprived access to quality education has decided to establish its campus at Panjgur, Balochistan.

As per the directives from the honorable Governor Balochistan Justice(R) Amanullah Khan Yasinzai and Chief Minister Balochistan Jam Kamal Khan Alyani, a preliminary survey of the area was conducted and the concept of establishing a Sub Campus in Panjgur was found to be feasible. A PC-1 has been prepared and submitted to the Government of Balochistan for approval. The University of Turbat also sent formal request to the Divisional and District administration for allocation of temporary building & allotment of land for the campus.



The University of Turbat in the leadership of the Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir and with the dedicated faculty and admin staff continues its success stories. After establishing a Sub Campus at Gwadar in September 2016, the management of University of Turbat had decided to establish the 2nd Sub Campus of UoT at Panjgur in 2019, keeping in view the very fertile grounds for higher education in district Panjgur. The UoT management had also decided to start academic activities in Panjgur Campus from 15th March 2020 after fulfilling all legal formalities and pre-requisites. The advertisement to fill various academic and administrative positions was published in November 2019 in various daily newspapers.

As a matter of fact, on receipt of directives from the Governor's Secretariat, the University of Turbat had carried out a detailed visit of District Panjgur on 1st December, 2018 and discussed the matter with all stakeholders as well as the authorities of District Administration. It was the collective opinion of all stakeholders that a Sub Campus of University of Turbat should be established in Panjgur as early as possible. The team also visited an un-utilized portion of Government Boys Degree College Panjgur, which was very suitable for the Sub Campus in the initial stage.



Establishment of the University of Turbat Sub Campus at Panjgur has been approved by the entire statutory bodies of the University of Turbat. The Academic Council of UoT in its meeting held on 7th February 2019 and Finance and Planning Committee of the University of Turbat in its meeting held on 14th February, 2019, Syndicate of the UoT in its meeting held on 4th March 2019 recommended the proposal of establishment of Panjgur campus. Finally during UoT's 4th meeting of Senate held on 8th April, 2019, chaired by H.E Justice (R) Amanullah Khan Yasinzai Governor Balochistan/Chancellor UoT approved the proposal of establishment of a Sub Campus of University of Turbat at Panjgur.

Following objectives of Panjgur Campus are envisaged

- a) To provide an opportunity to the students of District Panjgur and adjoining districts / other areas for higher education.
- b) To introduce Programs which are aimed to meet the technological and academic requirements of the region.
- c) To provide more job opportunities to the youth of the area.
- d) To link higher education with industry and R & D institutions.

Academic Courses/Programs to be started in Panjgur Campus

a) BACHELOR PROGRAMS

- 1. B.S Botany (4 years 8 Semesters)
- 2. B.S English (4 years 8 Semesters)
- 3. B.S Computer Sciences (4 years 8 Semesters)
- 4. B.Ed (Honors 4 years) (4 years 8 Semesters)

b) New disciplines will be introduced as and when required by the University Administration. The M.Phil and Ph.D. Programs will be introduced in the campus after availability of qualified faculty.

The Campus, by meeting Technical and professional requirements of the region and other mega Projects being envisaged including CPEC, would generate a number of Social and economic activities, enhance sustainability of the area, promote national cohesiveness and integration and thus contribute in the overall socio-economic development of the area.

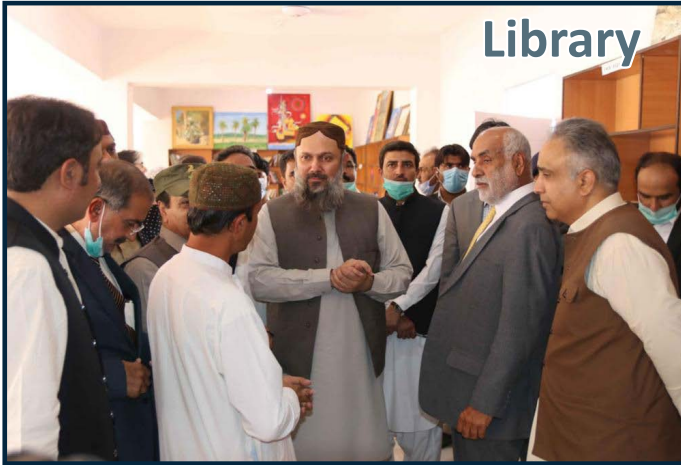

All SOPs prescribed by the Government against Coronavirus were observed during entry test.

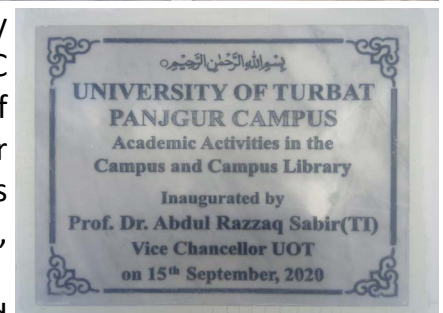
