About the University



The University of Turbat is a multidisciplinary public sector general university chartered by the Government of Balochistan in 2012. Previously, it was a sub-campus of the University of Balochistan (UoB) Quetta from 2009 to 2012. The Sub-Campus of Balochistan University at Turbat was upgraded into a full-fledged university in 2012 as University of Turbat. After completion of all required formalities, the University was recognized by the Higher Education Commission (HEC) of Pakistan in March 2014. Professor Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir and Professor Dr. Abdul Saboor Baloch were the founding Vice-Chancellor and Pro Vice-Chancellor of the University respectively. The academic activities of the university were shifted from a rented building to its permanent complex situated at M-8, CPEC Road Turbat in October 2017. Prof. Dr. Jan Muhammad joined the University as 2nd Vice-Chancellor in March 2021, while Dr. Mansoor Ahmed joined the university as the 2nd Pro Vice-Chancellor in December 2021. The passed-out graduates and alumni of the University are instrumental in playing a vibrant role for the progress and prosperity of the country. With around 4000 students and more than 200 teaching faculty and administrative staff, the university is moving forward and has been achieving milestones in the fields of teaching and research. Earnest efforts are consistently being made to promote a vibrant research culture and provide a learning environment for students and faculty members in the university. The university launched its first annual Research Journal Gidrosia for research purposes while the Institute of Balochi Language & Culture (IBLC) also initiated its Research Journal (Meeri) which has been recognized by the HEC. The other teaching faculties are planning to initiate their Research Journals very soon .Many faculty members have done M.Phil/ MS/PhD/ and MS leading to PhD in different universities of Pakistan and abroad under the

Development (HRD) Program, Aghaz e Haqooq Balochistan Scholarship, HEC scholarships, and other Cultural Exchange Scholarship Programs while some are still pursuing different Degree programs under the above mentioned scholarship opportunities. Most of them, however, having completed their studies, have re-joined the University, and others are expected to join back the University in due course of Time. Moreover, many research projects are in progress in the university under the University of Turbat Research Fund (UoTRF), HEC, Government of Balochistan, and other organizations. The university has been providing financial assistance to its students through various scholarship programs. The Directorate of Information Technology, a crucial component of the university, is connected with the Pakistan Education and Research Network (PERN 2) through the HEC, providing WIFI services to students, faculty members, and administrative staff at its all campuses and hostels. Besides, Seminar libraries in each department, University also has a central library at the main campus and a public library at City Campus with more than 45,000 books on deferent subjects, national and international research journals, publications, periodicals, and newspapers. Within the four years of its establishment, the university had set up its campuses at Gwadar & Panjgur. The Gwadar Campus and Panjgur Campus were upgraded into full-fledged universities in October 2021, and June 2022 respectively. Moreover, the University Model School is fully functional and providing elementary education facilities to the children of the university's employees and residents of the area. The University of Turbat, under the vibrant leadership of Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Jan Muhammad is on the way to implementing and achieving its short and long-term goals. Ensuring quality in teaching and research through QEC, converting university campuses into automation, transforming campuses into the solar system, enhancing research funds, upgrading internet facilities and IT-related services, setting up an IT park, strengthening linkages between industries and universities are among the important projects of the university. Besides, other long term strategic goals include sending even more faculty members abroad for higher studies, switching campuses to eco-friendly by plantation and zero carbon emission project, organizing training and refreshment courses for faculty and admin staff, and starting more PhD/M.Phil. Undergraduate, Diploma and certificate programs in different disciplines are very important projects for the university. In addition to that, other objectives pertain to hosting national and international conferences, initiating a housing scheme for its employees, and generating revenue by own resources as a part of its future roadmap of the University are under-implementation.



FACILITIES AT THE UNIVERSITY

Student Hostels



The students from far flung areas are provided with hostel facilities within the campus. The university has two buildings with 4 blocks for male and 1 building with 3 blocks separate for the residence of female students with capacity to accommodate 700 students. New buildings for male and female students are under construction. Hostels are well equipped with basic requirements such as internet, study area, play area, TV lounge, tuck-shop and mess, telephone, basic health unit and ambulance service. Round the clock security arrangements are ensured in each hostel.

University Transport Fleet



The University of Turbat's transport fleet has 11 buses including one bus on rent), 04 coasters, 03 vans, and 05 buses donated by FC South on temporary basis. The purpose of transport fleet is to provide pick and drop facilities to the students residing in Turbat city and surrounding areas and employees of the university on need basis. The University also provides transport facility to its students for field work and study trip on need basis, subject to availability of resources. The study tours and exposure visitsfor students are sponsored by university (60%) subject to availability of funds with university and students (40%). Besides, an ambulance for the students and employees, the University also has 19 staff and pool vehicles, 08 motorcycles and 01 tractor in its transport fleet. Efforts are underway for further strengthening the transport fleet of the University.

University Masjid



A Masjid is constructed with a unique design at the Main Campus of the University for Offering Prayers. The newly built "Jameh Masjid JamehaTurbat" It has a beautiful hall without any pillars that make it distinguished. Approximately, more than 500 people can offer prayers in the Masjid at a time. Two religious scholars namely Mufti Zuhair Ahmed and Molana Hafiz Muhammad Mukhtar are serving as Paish Imam and Naib Paish Imam respectively. A session on the teaching of the Quran and Nazra is also organized for children in the evening at the Masjid.

University Gymnasium





The Gymnasium of the university was inaugurated by the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Jan Muhammad on 22nd November 2021. It is equipped with modern facilities including gymnasium hall, bodybuilding and strength enhancing machines, badminton courts, treadmills, weight bars, pull up towers, lat pull-down, dumbbells, inclined benches, and other facilities. The floor has been carpeted with gym floor tiles and badminton floor mat. The formation of the gym will enhance the overall development of the students and staff, as they will be exposed to many types of exercises to improve their fitness and endurance power. Annual sports galas, badminton tournament, fitness training, different pro-health activities and other indoor games are organized in the gym. Timings: Gymnasium opens 6 days a week from 3pm to 9pm. Different timing has been scheduled for students and staff.

Campus Cafeteria and shops





The University of Turbat has well-furnished shops, tuck shops, and cafeterias having health friendly fast food and other refreshment facilities only for campus students and faculty members. The cafeterias have separate seating arrangements for male and female students and faculty members. Photocopy facilities are also provided in the shops within the campus for facilitating students.

Branches of Banks



Habib Bank Limited (HBL) and National Bank of Pakistan have their branches within the university campus providing assistance to students, faculty members and administrative staff of University of Turbat.

Seminar Hall



A seminar hall is also situated in the main campus for conducting seminars, exhibitions, lecture sessions and other academic and nonacademic activities. More than 300 participants may be seated in the seminar hall.

Multipurpose Hall



The University has a Multipurpose Hall with a seating capacity of 1500 at Main Campus and another Multipurpose Hall with a seating capacity of 300 at its Law Campus.

Barber Shop





The University of Turbat (UoT) opened it's first-ever On-Campus barbershop on the 7th of March, 2022 for students and staff. Under the leadership of Prof. Dr. Jan Muhammad, VC UoT, the administration of the University is committed to providing all basic amenities to the students and University staff residing at the University colony.



LIBRARY

Central Library



Besides, seminar libraries at each teaching departments, the university has also a campus library in main campus and a public library in its Law campus at city with thousands of books. Library building plays a vital role for the students and researchers for their academic activities. Varieties of books and reading materials related to different disciplines including Management Science, Commerce, Economics, Computer Science, Political Science, Law, English literature, Chemistry, Bio-technology, Bio-Chemistry, Botany, History, Philosophy, Psychology, Archeology, Anthropology, Islamic History, Regional Studies, and other books of users choice published by national and international publishers, are available at the library.

Library Services & Facilities

Digital library facility

The entire library system at campus is being computerized, and HEC has been requested to provide facilities for online/digital library services which will be available through a network after the completion of computerization process.

International subscribed research journals
The library also has a reasonable number of international subscribed research journals such as, The Economist, Harvard Business Review, American Scientist, Maximum PC, National Geographic, New Scientist, Practical Electronics, Science Focus UK, Entrepreneur, World Finance.

Circulation Services

All books and other reading materials shall be issued and returned from circulation counter/table. Any students can be issued or renewed book after due date.

Reference Services

Library consists of reference resources library instructions for user while studying, awareness service about current affairs, and guideline for new publications, newsletters, monthly feedback of library services and staff behaviors.

Discussion Room Services

Central library of UoT provide separate room for group discussion for students of the same departments and researchers after the permission from librarian.

Interlibrary Loan (ILL) Services



The book which is not available before checking the book carefully, library will provide interlibrary service to borrow it from another library within the city/ country and make available it for students.





HEALTH AND COMMUNITY SERVICES

Basic Health Unit (BHU)



The University of Turbat, in collaboration of District Health Department has established a BHU at main campus. Besides local population of nearby areas, the BHU also provides basic health facilities to the UoT's students, employees and their families and dependents. The BHU played a leading role in fighting against the Corona virus in the difficult times by providing the Corona Test and vaccination facilities for the local population, employees and students of the university.

Ambulance Services

The University of Turbat has standby Ambulance Services for students and staff in case of any emergency.



Free Eye Medical Camp



The University of Turbat (UoT) in collaboration with Al-Ibrahim Eye Hospital (sponsored by King Salman Humanitarian Aid and Relief Center) has organized a one day free eye medical camp on 15th December 2022 at UoT. Hundreds of eye patients including senior citizens, men, women, and children from nearby community visited the camp and received eye screening facilities and appropriate treatment by ophthalmologists and senior doctors of Al-Ibrahim Eye Hospital. As per the condition of the patient, some of them were provided with eyeglasses and medicines after proper NOVATION screening and checkup, while other patients were referred to the Teaching Hospital Turbat where their eyes were further treated and operated from 16-19 December 2022.







Blood Donation Camp



The Regional Blood Center (RBC) Kech in collaboration with the University of Turbat organized a one-day blood donation camp at UoT on 20th September 2022.On the occasion, around 95 bags of blood were collected. Deans, Registrar, directors, faculty members, administrative staff, and male & female students of the University participated in the camp and donated blood voluntarily and wholeheartedly for the emergency needs in the Teaching Hospital Turbat. The students of the Department of Natural and Basic Sciences, Education, and Social Sciences attended the camp as volunteers and facilitators.

Introduction

UoT got Membership of United Nation Academic Impact (UNAI)



- The Office of Botanical Garden and Plantation is maintaining a nursery to germinate and nurse plant for the Green Drive Project.


UoT conducts its self-Postgraduate Programs Review

In the central labs, PCs are provided, offering arange of standard office software for document creation and presentations. Computers in the campus are connected to the University's mainserver through a wide area network giving access via the internet to the major information, research, and communications networks worldwide.

Taking further our vision to digitilize departmental workflows, we have completed some projects and are being used in different offices and more are in pipeline and will goon productionsoon.

Video Conference Room

The University of Turbat, in collaboration of Higher Education Commission (HEC) Pakistan has established a video conference room with all necessary features including high speed internet and audio/visual facilities at UoT's Main Campus. Online meeting, national and international lecture series, seminars and conferences and other video link activities are held at video conference room.

Survey tool for QEC

The Quality Enhancement Cell wanted to make their work for surveying students a bit easier than traditional paper + Excel sheets, which are error-prone and not the best way to conduct surveys. The survey tool we deployed for the QEC is helping the section in many ways.

Online Admission Portal

Last year, we launched the portal on a pilot-basisto allow new students to submit their applications for admission. This year it is more polished and refined and makes creating an account and applying to different programs easy for the applicants.

Alumni Directory

The University wanted to stay in touch with their graduated students and inform them about different events on campuses, Pass-out students are welcome to register and receive news and information regarding different events organized by the university.

Library Management System

As the university students are growing, it is becoming difficult for the library to manage the in and out flow books. To counter that, we have deployed an Integrated Library System that allows the Library Staff to manage the circulation process of books, magazines, or any other it em available in the library, upload books in PDF format, download books,manage batch details of users (student/teacher), make catalogue in easier by using different protocols like Z39.50 and SRU, generate reports automatically, send notifications via SMS and email both, generate barcode labels, and library cards. The automation provided by the system not just improves the working process of the library but is a sort of ease for students too.

Biometric Attendance

Manual attendance of the university staffis unreliable and hard to manage. To tackle the challenges of tracking staff attendance, overtime, staff leaves be it casual leaves, sick leaves or earn edl aves, we have deployed a central biometric attendance system.

Journal for Department of Management Sciences

In 2022, on the request of the department, we deployed a Journal hosting platform as required by HEC, so that they can host their journals, call for papers and follow journal publication and editorial workflows.


Uot and VU launched Digital Skills Courses at UoT

STRENGTHENING PHYSICAL INFRASTRUCTURE

Directorate of Planning and Drevelopment



The entire civil works included in the Revised PC-I have been awarded. These were awarded in three Phases. The works awarded in the 1st two Phases (17 works) have been completed. The works which were mostly awarded in the 3rd Phase like VC House, Large Lecture Hall & Library and Senate Hall. The academic and operational activities are already going on in the new campus since 2017-18. The Phase-I Project was completed on September 2022. The infrastructure and main "Networking, Computerization and Automation System"work has also been started and Phase-I portion is also completed. The Lab equipment balance supply has been received from Supplier for both Computer Lab and Chemistry & Botany Labs. Plantation work in the land of campus has been Completed. The Phase-II Project was approved by CDWP on June-2020 at cost of Rs.1.456 (B). Thetender of Phase-II main packages have been completed and the work orders have been awarded for 6 Packages and remaining tenders are in pipe line to be floated very soon. The tender for the solarization of the campus of Phase-II has been floated and scrutiny is underway. While a tender of Grassy of Admin & Academic portions has been completed from PM Green Program head and other will be processed in due course of time.





REVENUE, RESOURCES AND FINANCE

Salient Features:

The main sources of funding of UOT are Development Grants and Recurring Grants being received from Federal Government through HEC. HEC is also providing dedicating funds for specific purposes such as to meet security requirements, for Covid-19 and to provide in houses training, Workshops, Seminar etc. Provincial Government also allocates funds to the University as grant in aid for specific purposes. The University's own revenue from tuition fee, exam fee and other heads are also contributing in its revenue pool to some extent. UoT has started taking examination of students of affiliation colleges from which significant revenue are being generated.

Recurring Grant:

Soon after being recognized by HEC, the University of Turbat started receiving annual recurring grant from HEC w.e.f September, 2014. It received total grant of Rs. 45 (M) during 2014-2015, Rs. 101 (M) during 2015-2016, Rs. 138 (M) during F/Y 2016-2017, 2017-18 Rs. 129 (M), during F/Y2018-2019 Rs. 136 (M), during F/Y 2019-2020 Rs.121 (M), and for the current FY 2020-2021 Rs. 183.22(M).

Endowment Fund:

The former CM of Balochistan Dr. Abdul Malik Baloch had announced during the stone laying ceremony of the UoT Project on 6th Feb, 2014 to provide funds for establishment of UoT's endowment funds. Accordingly, an amount of Rs. 50 (M) was received from GoB during F/Y 2013-2014 which was invested in three years' term deposit in NBP @ 11.75% p.a after obtaining comparative rates of interest through open and transparent bidding.

After maturity the original amount plus 50% of the profit were invested in HBL @10.70 for one year and @7.45% for further one year in HBL after obtaining comparative rate of interest to "AAA" ranking banks. This fund was meant for investment in the longterm deposit/securities in order to meet long term financial needs of the University and the profit/interest will be utilized for providing scholarships and other benefits to the students.

Grant in aid:

The honorable Governor Balochistan/ Chancellor PSU's of Balochistan has very kindly granted a total amount of Rs. 145.81 (M) during the six years i.e. 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017,2017-2018, 2018-2019 as Grant in Aid. The Provincial Government enhanced the Grant in Aidallocation to Rs. 1500 (M) for FY 2019-20 and formed Universities Finance Commission for its distribution. Accordingly, the University of Turbat is granted Rs. 152.274 for FY 2019-20 and 152.488 for FY 2020-21 which have been spent for the heads and purposes prescribed by the Government of Balochistan. Provincial Government has also released a grant of Rs. 50 (M) each for the Gwadar Campus and PanjgurCampus for the year 2020-21.

Future Plans:

The Management of University of Turbat is determined to make the University finically healthy and stablein the long run. To achieve this objective, it aims in enhancing its revenue earning capacity on the one hand and strengthening—financial discipline and governance on the other hand. The university has already started the process of affiliating all the colleges and other institutions within its jurisdiction as well as to register private candidates. It is expected that this will bring in significant revenues during subsequent years. There are a number of other plans in pipeline aimed at making the organization financially self-sustaining.

This initiative is geared towards providing a streamlined & consolidated service to all students with regards to their academic matters in order to ease the process involved while making it easier for both students & staff to manage as well as conduct the necessary services needed for the academic framework. This new central platform will be tasked to provide an efficient service with the utilization of holistic and comprehensive outlook while maintaining a perspective pillared on the values of efficiency, integrity, professionalism, commitment & problem-solving initiatives for the benefit of all

The Directorate of Academics at the University of Turbat continuously puts forth the effort to efficiently process and complete the postgraduate programs. In a short period of time, the office successfully managed the Advanced Studies and Research Board meetings, where the august forum framed policy-related matters, particularly the formulation of graduate rules and thesis guidelines. In addition, presently the Directorate engaged in the framing PhD policies and undergraduate academic rules of the University. Directorate has also timely and successfully processed the scholars' theses for evaluation and so far conducted thirty six viva voce. Similarly, the Directorate has organised and facilitated different professional development workshops and has committed to conducting a series of research workshops in the coming days.

Financial Aid Office (FAO), University of Turbat, was established in order to facilitate the talented and less privilege students for grant of scholarship on merit and need basis.



An Orientation Session on CSS Examination





Parliamentary Secretary for Women Development meets VC UoT





Students of Economics Department visit industries




