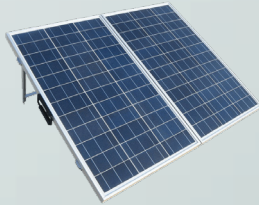

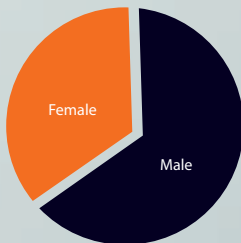

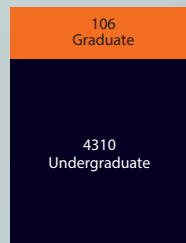

INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

An Overview of Phase II of the UoT’s Project

The project titled “Establishment of University of Turbat (Phase-II)” was approved at a cost of Rs. 1,456.140 Million. The major construction activities outlined in the plan include the construction of academic block complexes, hostels, common facilities buildings, faculty and staff housing, and external development works. Additionally, the project encompasses various components such as networking, computerization, automation, office and teaching equipment, furniture and fixtures, books and journals, project staff for project execution, transportation, and laboratory equipment.




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
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
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HONORS, AWARDS, AND ACHIEVEMENTS

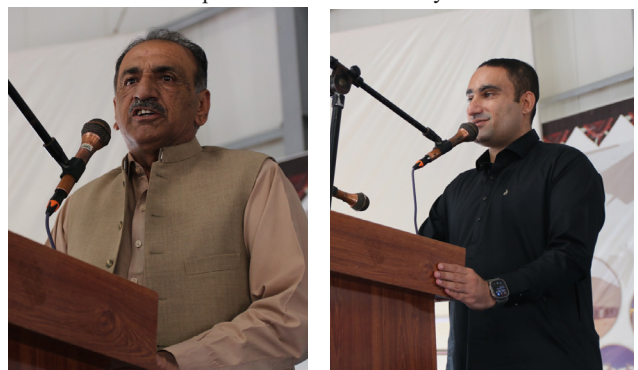
The 6th-semester students of the Education Department at the University of Turbat (UoT) organized a Sociolinguistics Program on November 14, 2023.
