Introduction



The University of Turbat is a multidisciplinary public sector general university, chartered by the Government of Balochistan in 2012. Previously, it was a sub-campus of the University of Balochistan from 2009 to 2012. The Sub-Campus of Balochistan University at Turbat was upgraded into a full-fledged university in 2012 as “University of Turbat”. After completion of all required formalities, the University was recognized by the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan in March 2014.

Professor Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir and Professor Dr. Abdul Saboor Baloch were the founding Vice Chancellor and Pro Vice Chancellor of the University respectively, while Prof. Dr. Jan Muhammad joined the University as 2nd Vice Chancellor in March 2021. Dr. Mansoor Ahmed joined UoT as the 2nd Pro Vice Chancellor in December 2021.

The main objective of establishing this university is to provide better opportunities of higher education to the students of entire province and rest of the country, mainly from the remote and backward areas of Makran Division and neighboring districts in order to bring them at par with the people of other parts of the country in all walks of life. The academic activities of the university have been shifted from rented building to its permanent building situated at M-8/CPEC Road during October 2017.

Within a short span of time, the Vice Chancellor with the support of qualified faculty members and administrative staff uplifted the UoT as a fast growing institution of higher education in the country. With 4000 plus students and around 200 teaching faculty of the University, has earned a number of accolades which have been acknowledged throughout country.

The university has been providing financial assistance to its students through various scholarships. Research and publications have been the defining distinctions of the University ever since its establishment. Earnest efforts are consistently being made to promote a vibrant research culture and provide a learning environment for students as well as faculty members. The University launched its first annual Research Journal GIDROSHIA for research purpose while Institute of Balochi Language & Culture (IBLC) also has initiated its Research Journal (MEERI) recognized by the HEC. The other teaching faculties are planning to initiate their Research Journals very soon. Around 50 plus faculty members are doing/have done M.Phil/MS/PhD/ and MS leading to PhD in different universities of Pakistan and abroad under the Human Resource Development Program (HRD), Aghaz e Haqooq Balochistan Scholarship, HEC scholarships and other Cultural Exchange Scholarship Programs. Most of them, after completion of their degree, have re-joined the University and rests of them are expected to join back the university in due course of time.

The University organized its 1st convocation in March 2017, while 2nd convocation was organized on 22nd April 2019. The passed out graduates and alumni of the University are instrumental to play a vibrant role in the society for the Progress and prosperity of the country. The Office of Research, Innovation & Commercialization (ORIC) is operational since the inception of the University. The ORIC provides operational support in preparing, submitting, and presenting research proposals to the teaching faculty & students. In addition, this office plays a key role in facilitating the University-Industry linkages for the commercialization of the research works of the students and teachers of the university. A video conference Hall has established by the HEC to connect the University with the other national and international institutions of higher learning. Directorate of Information Technology, the backbone of the university, is one of the paramount achievements, connected, with Pakistan Education and Research Network (PERN 2) by the HEC, providing Wifi services to students, faculty members and administrative staff at main

campus and hostels. Besides, Seminar libraries in each department, University also has a central library at main campus and a public library at City Campus with more than 40,000 books on different subjects, national and international research journals, publications, periodicals, and newspapers. The establishment of Quality Enhancement Cell, Career Counseling and Student Affairs Section, completion of The First Phase of University infrastructure, increasing 13 departments from 3 departments along with 28 academic programs in four faculties, establishment of its sub campus at Gwadar & Panjgur with eight departments, starting M.Phil. Programs in Balochi, Chemistry and Business Administration, vigilance security measures at campus and hostels, transport section, launching IT academy in collaboration with HEC, entering into MOUs with national and international universities/institutes, establishing smart computer labs, affiliating all degree colleges of Makran division, co-hosting national seminar on CPEC at Gwadar, conducting meetings of statutory body on time, organizing inter-university declamation contest, social services to society, creating awareness against corruption and drugs, organizing IT and literary seminar, Training workshops, international lecture series, Annual Business Gala, organizing first international conference on Sustainable Development Goals, various scholarships for students, national book fair and various extra-curricular activities in regular interval are among the considerable achievements of the University. The Gwadar Campus of University of Turbat absorbed/converted into a full-fledged university as "University of Gwadar" in October, 2021. The University Model School is fully functional now which is increasing available facilities to the children and future generations. The Panjgur Campus of the University has the potential to be declared as a full-fludged university as its act has recently been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Balochistan. University The University of Turbat under the leadership of Prof. Dr. Jan Muhammad, Vice Chancellor is on the way to implement and achieve its short and long term strategic plan. Converting UoT and its sub campuses in to automation, transforming campuses into solar system, enhancing research funds, upgrading internet facilities and IT related services, strengthening linkages between industries and university, establishment of more market oriented programs of studies, sending more scholars abroad for higher studies, training and refreshment courses, starting

PhD/M.Phil/Diploma/certificate programs in different disciplines, commencement of Chinese/English/Balochi language program, hosting national and international conferences, initiating housing scheme for its employees, and generating revenue by its own resources are among the main mission of future roadmap of the University.

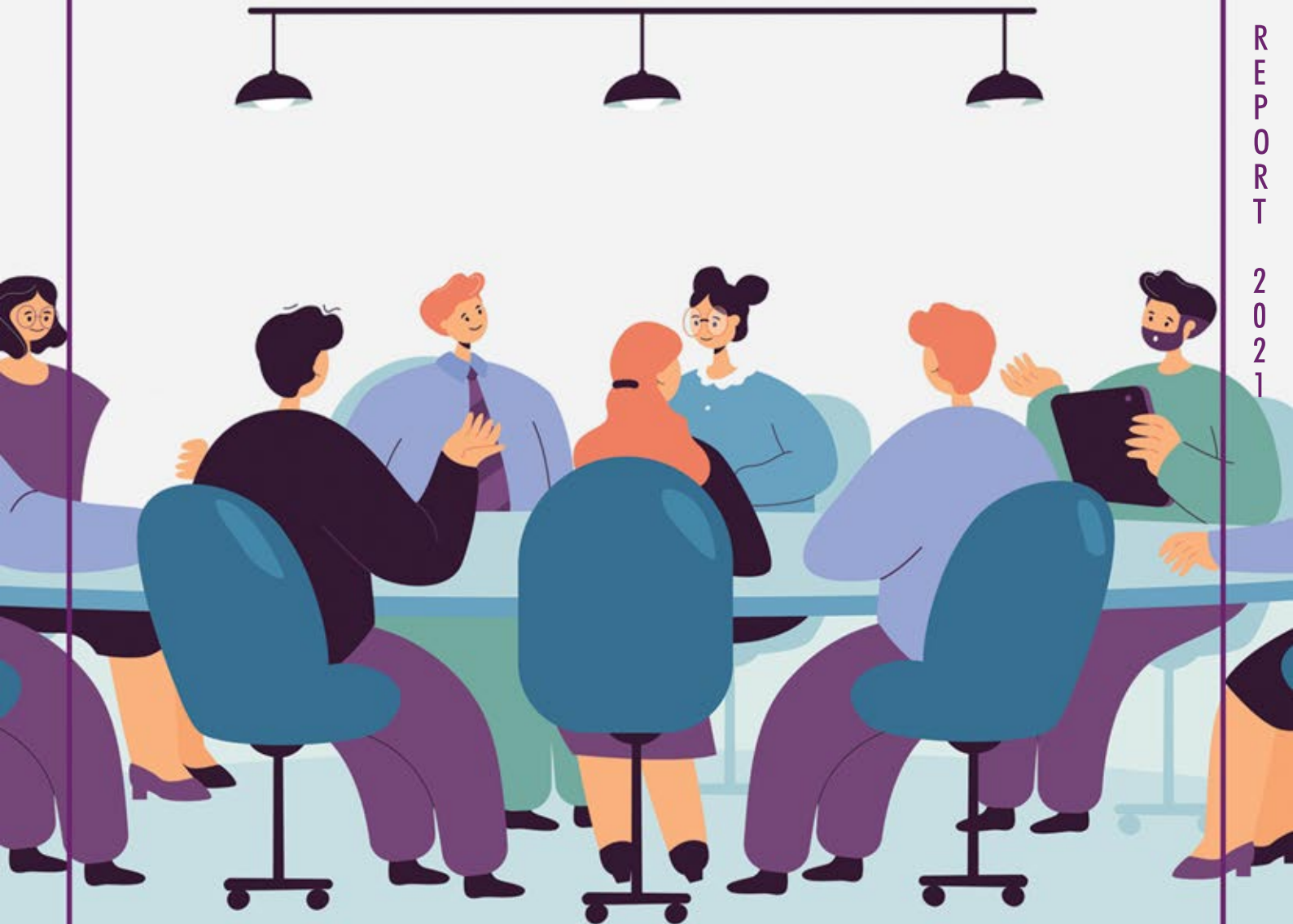
UoT holds 12th meeting of Finance and Planning Committee

Introduction

The Office of Research Innovation and Commercialization (ORIC) at University of Turbat has been established in line with the aims of Higher Education Commission (HEC) that attempts to make a major contribution to economic prosperity, national well-being and the expansion of knowledge.

Objectives of ORIC

The main objectives of the ORIC at UOT are as follows:

- To formulate and support university's strategic research direction and policies.
- To enhance and diversify research funding.
- To create an environment so that research remains an integral component of academic activities at UoT.
- To ensure that high quality research of direct relevance to Pakistan's needs.
- To facilitate establishment of linkages between UOT and the industry.
- To provide information about research funding opportunities to faculty and students.
- To encourage and assist UoT researchers/faculty in obtaining research grants from the Public / Private Sector.
- Facilitate timely completion of funded research and development projects.
- Maintain efficient and productive communication channels with funding agencies.
- Facilitate and support UoT researchers for publication and presentation of their research work through participation in research activities so as to cater for industry requirements.
- To improve/ Strengthens university- industry relationship.
- To conduct national and international conferences/seminars/sessions.
- To help students to obtain funds for their research projects.

Core Activities of 2021

1. The ORIC University of Turbat hosted an Awareness Session conducted by National Incubation Center (NIC) Quetta on 2nd April 2021.
2. The ORIC organized an awareness session at UoT main campus on 30th March 2021 for the faculty regarding the University of Turbat Research Fund (UOTRF), which is funded by Government of Balochistan to Universities for the purpose of doing applied research.
3. The ORIC organized a "Two Days Capacity Building Program on Mobile journalism (MoJo) at UOT's Main and Gwadar Campus on 17th-18th and 21st-22nd June 2021 respectively. This 2-day session on Mobile Journalism is part of "Governor's (Balochistan) Pehchan Program for Youth", which is being executed by the INDIVIDUALLAND (IL) Pakistan. "Governor Pehchan Program for YOUTH" launched in Balochistan to help students acquire modern technological skills and allow them to pursue their dreams.
4. The ORIC at UoT launched University of Turbat Research Fund (UOTRF), the UOTRF is a research fund granted by Government of Balochistan to UoT for the purpose of doing research on local, governmental and societal issues.
ORIC called for Research Proposals from UoT faculty, in which total 33 proposals submitted. To evaluate the research proposals, a team of expert panel was invited on 7th and 8th June 2021 at UoT main campus to evaluate the research proposals and select the best ones. A total of 18 projects were selected and being funded grants under UOTRF.

5. A lecture session was organized by the ORIC on 1st & 2nd September 2021 at UoT's Main Campus and Gwadar Campus respectively, in which Mr. Iqbal Waheed, a consultant and businessman was the guest speaker.

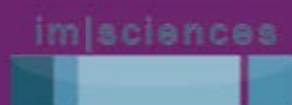

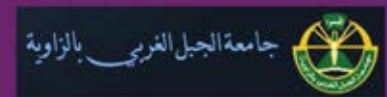

The University of Turbat (UoT) has well-equipped central and departmental computer labs working under the Computer Science Department and IT section of the University. This service provides net services to the Central Library, departments, faculty and administrative offices round the clock. In the Central Labs, PCs are provided, offering a range of standard office software for document creation and presentations. Computers in the campus are connected to the University's main server through a wide area network giving access via the internet to the major information, research and communications networks worldwide.

Taking further our vision to digitize departmental workflows, we have completed some projects and are being used in different offices and more are in pipeline and will go on production soon.

Here is a run-down of all the projects:

In Production

●Survey tool for QEC

The Quality Enhancement Cell wanted to make their work for surveying students a bit easier than traditional paper + Excel sheets, which are error-prone and not the best way to conduct surveys. The survey tool we deployed for the QEC is helping the section in many ways.

●Online Admission Portal

Last year, we launched the portal on a pilot-basis to allow new students to submit their applications for admission. This year it is more polished and refined and makes creating an account and applying to different programs really easy for the applicants.

●Alumni Directory

The University wanted to stay in touch with their graduated students and inform them about different events on campuses, Pass-out students are welcome to register and receive news and information regarding different events organized by the university.

●Library Management System

As the university students are growing, it is becoming difficult for the library to manage the in and out flow of books. To counter that, we have deployed an Integrated Library System that allows the Library Staff to manage the circulation process of books, magazines, or any other item available in the library, upload books in PDF format, download books, manage batch details of users (student/teacher), make cataloguing easier by using different protocols like Z39.50 and SRU, generate reports automatically, send notifications via SMS and email both, generate barcode labels, and library cards. The automation provided by the system not just improves the working process of library but is a sort of ease for students too.

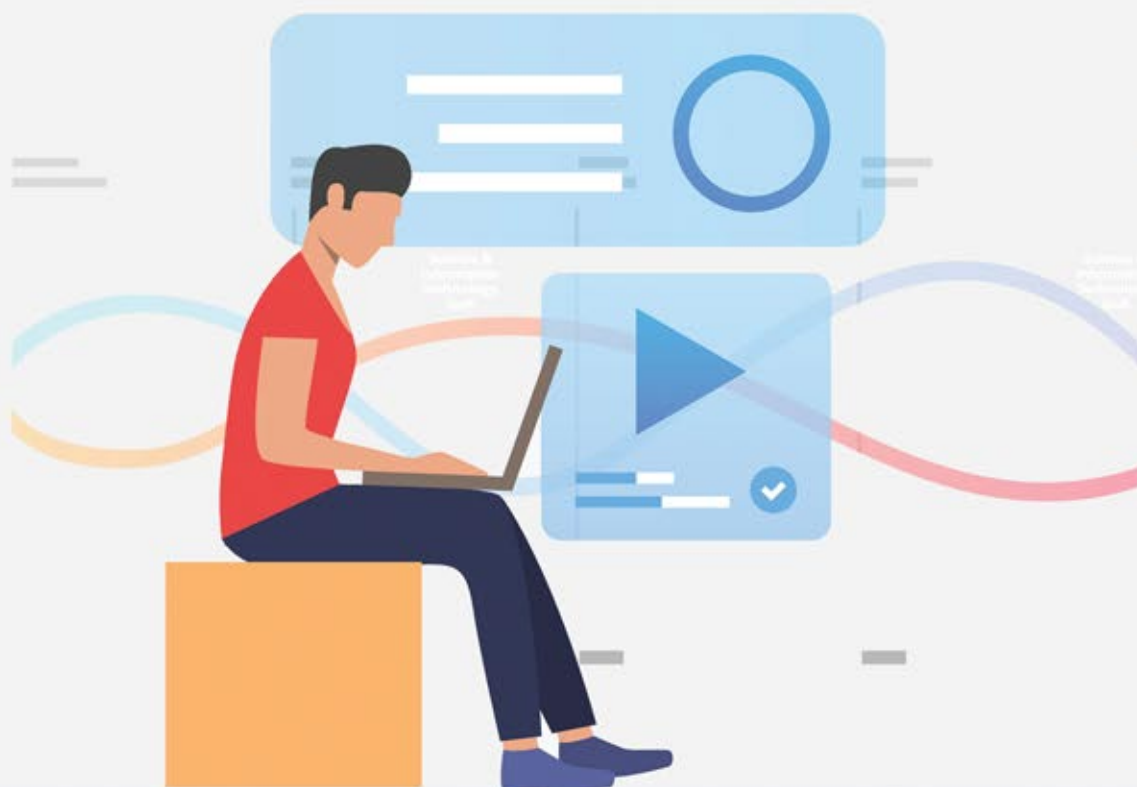
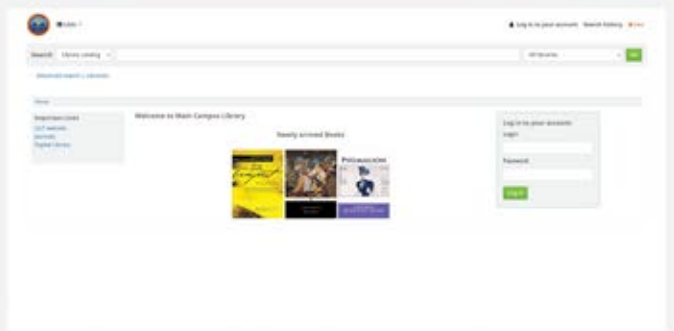
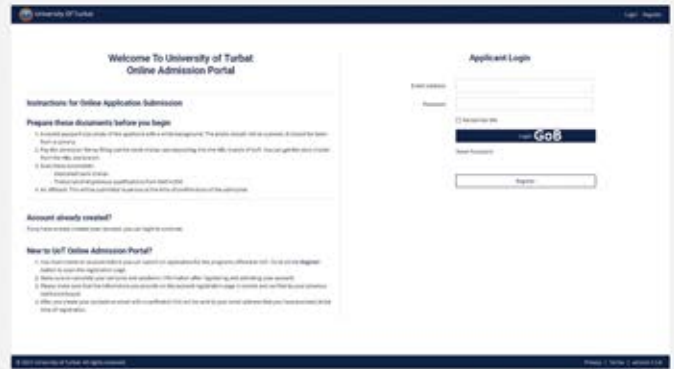
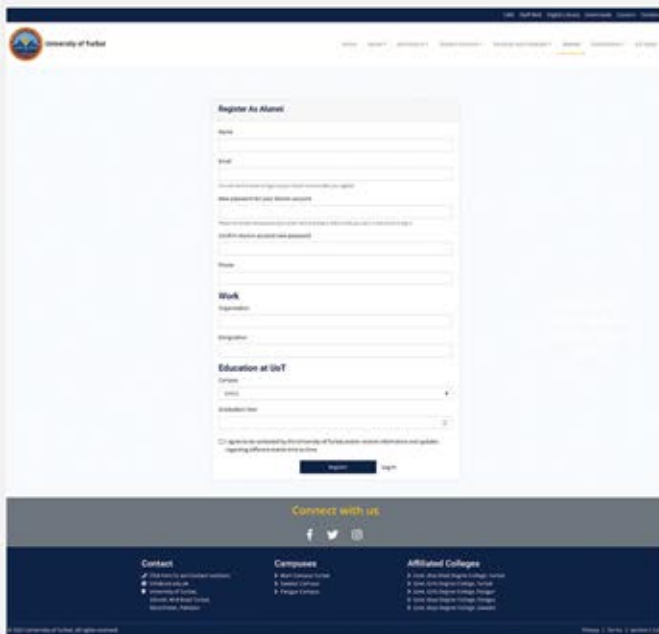
●Biometric Attendance

DIRECTORATE OF FINANCE

Directorate of Finance

Salient Features

The main sources of funding of UOT are Development Grants and Recurring Grants being received from Federal Government through HEC. HEC is also providing dedicating funds for specific purposes such as to meet security requirements, for Covid-19 and to provide in houses training, Workshops, Seminar etc. Apart from above, The Provincial Government also allocates funds to the University as Grant in aid for specific purposes. The University's own revenue from tuition fee, exam fee and other heads are also contributing in its revenue Pool to some extent. UoT has started taking examination of students of affiliation colleges from which significant revenue are being generated.

Recurring Grant

Soon after being recognized by HEC, the University of Turbat started receiving annual recurring grant from HEC w.e.f September, 2014. It received total grant of Rs. 45 (M) during 2014-2015, Rs. 101 (M) during 2015-2016, Rs. 138 (M) during F/Y 2016-2017, 2017-18 Rs. 129 (M), during F/Y 2018-2019 Rs. 136 (M), during F/Y 2019-2020 Rs. 121 (M), and for the current FY 2020-2021 Rs. 183.22(M).

Endowment Fund

The former CM of Balochistan Dr. Abdul Malik Baloch had announced during the stone laying ceremony of the UoT Project on 6th Feb, 2014 to provide funds for establishment of UoT's endowment funds. Accordingly, an amount of Rs. 50 (M) was received from GoB during last quarter of F/Y 2013-2014 which was invested in three years' term deposit in NBP @ 11.75% p.a after obtaining comparative rates of interest through open and transparent bidding.

After maturity the original amount plus 50% of the profit were invested in Habib Bank Limited (HBL)@ 10.70 for one year and @7.45% for further one year in HBL after obtaining comparative rate of interest to "AAA" ra ng Banks.

This fund was meant for investment in the long

term deposit/securities in order to meet long term financial needs of the University and the profit/interest will be utilized for providing scholarships and other benefits to the students.

Grant in aid

The honorable Governor Balochistan/ Chancellor PSU's of Balochistan has very kindly granted a total amount of Rs. 145.81 (M) during the six years i.e. 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019 as Grant in Aid. The Provincial Government Enhanced the Grant in Aid allocation to Rs. 1500 (M) for FY 2019-20 and formed Universities Finance Commission for its distribution. Accordingly, the University of Turbat is granted Rs. 152.274 for FY 2019-20 and 152.488 for FY 2020-21 which have been spent for the heads and purposes prescribed by the Government of Balochistan. Provincial Government has also released a grant of Rs. 50 (M) each for the Gwadar Campus and Panjgur Campus for the year 2020-21.

Future Plans

The Management of University of Turbat is determined to make the University finically healthy and stable in the long run. To achieve this objective, it aims in enhancing its revenue earning capacity on the one hand and strengthening financial discipline and governance on the other hand. The university has already started the process of affiliating all the colleges and other institutions within its jurisdiction as well as to register Private Candidates. It is expected that this will bring in significant revenues during subsequent years. There are a number of other plans in pipeline aimed at making the organization financially self-sustaining.

Progress on UoT's Project (Civil Works)

Establishment of University of Turbat

The project titled "Establishment of University of Turbat" was approved by ECNEC during May 2011 at a total cost of Rs. 1580.39 (M) which was revised on January 2016 with the cost of Rs. 2820.62(M). Although, the commencement year of the project given in the PC-1 was 2011-12; however the project was actually started from the F/Y 2013-14 after induction of full-time VC and other senior officers. Since July 2013, the work of the construction of new campus is continuing without any break. The academic and other activities have already been shifted to the new campus. Apart from Civil works, the project cost also includes other components such as scholarships for higher studies, Purchase of equipment, furniture and fixtures, books and journals, transport and security system etc.

The entire civil works included in the Revised PC-I have been awarded. These were awarded in three phases. The works awarded in the 1st two phases (17 works) have been completed.

The works which were awarded in the 3rd phase like VC House, Large Lecture Hall & Library etc. have also been completed except the work of Senate Hall which will be completed till March 2022. The tender of I T infrastructure in permanent building like "Networking, Computerization and Automation System" has been floated.

The Lab equipment balance work has also been tendered and supply is being received from firm for both Computer Lab and Chemistry & Botany Labs. A well-equipped Gymnasium has been established and now it is operational. Under Green UoT Program, the plantation work on the campus land is in progress.

Establishment of University of Turbat Phase II

University of Turbat Project titled "Establishment of University of Turbat" Phase II amounting to Rs. 1.456 Billion has also been approved in PSDP 2020-21. The Phase II includes Academic Blocks, Residences, External Development works, Student Hostels, Common facilities, Lab Equipment, Books, Furniture and Fixtures, Office & Teaching Equipment, Networking Computerizing and Automation etc.

The Phase-II Project was approved by CDWP on June-2020 at cost of Rs.1.456 (B). The process of hiring Consultant for Phase-II has been completed and Consultant has been hired. Furthermore tenders has been floated and evaluations of the "Technical Proposals" and "financial proposals" have been completed.

Rests of Components of phase-II like Solarization of Campus & PM Green Program are in pipeline and will be started as soon as possible.





DIRECTORATE OF PUBLIC RELATIONS

Directorate of Public Relations

In this fast growing communicative world higher education institutions across the world are committed to create and maintain a very positive image amongst their stakeholders. This is equally important for every institute including universities to know what their clients and stakeholders are thinking about them, what they like and dislike, and what concerns and satisfies them. Therefore, the University of Turbat established the Directorate of Public Relations in the University during the year 2015 for having strong linkages with all stakeholders and media to enhance the positive image of the University in society. Mr. Ijaz Ahmed Baloch has been assigned the charge as Director of this section. This Directorate functions under the supervision and guidance of Vice Chancellor. With the support of employees, students and alumni, this directorate had achieved considerable successes in creating harmony between institution and its stakeholders. This directorate has a clear objective to cooperate with teaching and non-teaching departments in improving the programs and services of the university.



Directorate of Public Relations

Photo Desk

On the request of concerned sections and after the prior approval of the Competent Authority this section of the Directorate of Public Relations will arrange the photo coverage of functions and activities of various departments/ sections of the University for Press, university's website, publications and social media for publicity and image building of the university. It will also prepare photographs for exhibitions and maintains photo albums as well as photo gallery.

Press and Publicity Desk

This desk will arrange press conferences and press briefings, and keeps liaison with print & electronic media. This desk will be entrusted with the task of issuing of press releases, photographs and video footages regarding various events conducted at university to local and national media.

Production Desk

Besides coordinating in publishing publicity literature like Calendar, Datebook, Diary, Telephone Directory of university employees, this desk in collaboration with IT section also helps to publish booklets, brochures, annual report, prospectus, newsletter, posters, hoardings and other promotional tools from time to time pertaining to important achievements. It will also make arrangements for production of short video documentary on university's achievements, future programs and other events organized by the University.

Advertisement Desk

The Advertisement Desk will offer its services to win the attention of the people toward University of Turbat through advertisements in print/electronic/social media and local cable TV network. The advertisement desk will facilitate to release university classified advertisements/ announcements/ public service messages in press and local Cable TV Network on approved government rates.

Library and Exhibition Desk

This Desk will deal with maintaining a small library, wherein Clipped News Items pertaining to UoT, Periodicals, Magazines, Daily Newspapers and Publications are kept and preserve in safe hands. Computer Laboratories

The University of Turbat (UoT) has well furnished and equipped computer labs working under the Computer Science Department and IT section of the University, there are more than 200 latest new computers have been provided to the University Computer Laboratory. This service provides net services to the Central Library, departments, faculty and administrative offices 24 hours. In the Central Labs, PCs are provided, offering a range of standard office software for document creation and presentations. Specialist provision is available to support research and advanced study within the University. Computers in the campus are connected to the University's main server through a wide area network giving access via the internet to the major information, research and communications networks worldwide. A new lab having around 40 latest computers has been established in the department of Management Science during 2020.

Student Hostels

University of Turbat has students from all over Makran that are enrolled in different programs. Some of the students are not resident of Turbat City. For them, UoT has 3 buildings for hostels, which include 2 for boys and 1 for girls, with all basic needs and comfort in the campus. Each hostel has its own cook and mess, which is partially supported by the University. There are security guards on each hostel, and a female warden for the girl's hostel.

University Transportation

The University of Turbat has 4 coasters, 9 buses and 3 vans and 6 buses (on rent) denoted by IGFC (South) Balochistan to provide pick and drop facility to the students living in Turbat city and suburbs. The University also provides transport facility to its students for field work and annual picnics once a year to each department on need basis. The study tours for students are partly financed by the students and supplemented by the University, subject to availability of funds. UoT also has an ambulance for the students and faculties. And Ten vehicles for the administrative staff.



Mosque

A mosque is constructed with unique design within the University main Campus for offering prayers. The newly built Main Masjid building named “Jameh Masjid Jameha Turbat” (Main Mosque University of Turbat) was formally inaugurated on Friday, September 18, 2020 (Safar 1, 1442 AH), by Vice Chancellor University of Turbat, Prof. Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir.

Gymnasium & Sport Grounds

A gymnasium for indoor games and exercises is built for the students and staff. Football and Cricket grounds are also available in the main campus.



Campus Cafeteria and Shops

The University of Turbat at its Main Campus and sub-campuses have well-furnished Cafeterias having fast food and tea shop facilities only for campus students and faculty members. The Cafeteria has seating for more than 30 students at a time with separate seats for male and female students or faculty members. Photocopy facility is provided in the shops within the campus for facilitating students of UoT, especially females.

Seminar Hall


A seminar hall is also situated in the main campus for conducting seminars, exhibitions, lecture sessions and more activities. More than 250 participants may be seated in the seminar hall.

BOTANICAL GARDEN

Botanical Garden and Green Built

The section of Botanical Garden and Green Built was established in 2018 under the leadership of Prof. Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir, Ex. Vice-Chancellor of the UoT. The purpose of the establishment of the section is to maintain and enhance the lawns and greenery of the university which will result in a human-friendly ecosystem on the campus. It is the place of collection of living plants grown for educational, recreational, economic medicinal scientific purposes. Mr. Ghous Bakhsh (Assistant Registrar General) has been nominated as the In-charge of the Section. In his supervision, the section has initiated different programs for plantation, and awareness campaigns to maintain the greenery and cleanliness of the campus under the directives of the Worthy Vice-Chancellor Prof. Dr. Jan Muhammad. A land of almost 100 acres has been selected for a fruit orchard and greenery grove attached to the boundary wall of the university and the plantation work has already been initiated. The University has as many as 20 grassy lawns. The Plantation and Green Campus drive was inaugurated by Prof. Dr. Jan Muhammad, UoT's Vice-Chancellor. Faculty members, admin staff, and students from all departments are taking an active part in the plantation process. The section has already planted more than 6000 plants from 2018-to 2021 and is committed to achieving the target of planting more than 30,000 plants at the main campus Turbat and its sub-campuses including the Law department up to 2023. Another project of plantation on 30 acres of land is underway in collaboration with the Forest Department, Government of Balochistan where around 10,000 trees have been planted up to December 2021.

GWADAR CAMPUS OF UNIVERSITY OF TURBAT
(September, 2016 to October, 2021)

Introduction

Transformation of UoT's Gwadar campus into University of Gwadar

The Gwadar Campus of University of Turbat was formally absorbed / converted into a full-fledged university as University of Gwadar (UoGr) on 25th October 2021 and Honorable Governor of Balochistan appointed Prof. Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir as the vice chancellor of University of Gwadar vide notification No. SGB/2-31/UoG/2021/2108-15 dated 25th October, 2021. Prof. Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir assumed the charge as the first vice chancellor of University of Gwadar on 29th October, 2021.

Transferring of the assets of UoT's Gwadar Camps to the University of Gwadar

An agreement was signed between vice chancellor, University of Turbat Prof. Dr. Jan Muhammad and vice chancellor, University of Gwadar, Prof. Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir on 11th November, 2021 at UoT for transferring of the assets of University of Turbat's Gwadar Camps to the University of Gwadar. In accordance with the University of Gwadar Act 2018, the vice chancellor of either universities agreed to transfer the properties, staff, buildings, books, furniture & fixture, rights, liabilities and other assets of University of Turbat's Gwadar Campus to the University of Gwadar.

Background

The Gwadar Campus of University of Turbat was established during September 2016, under the project "Establishment of Sub Campuses of Public Sector Universities at District Level Phase-I" initiated by HEC with a vision that the same campus will be upgraded as a full-fledged university, as "University of Gwadar" of international standard in the near future. Academic activities were started from 16th January 2017 at Gwadar Campus of UoT in a portion of the building of Govt. Boys Degree College Gwadar. Initially, four BS programs in the fields of BBA, BSIT, B.Ed. (Hons) and BS Commerce were started in the campus.

Enrollment and faculty

Up-to now (October, 2021), the number of regular faculty members is 15 while 27 teachers are providing services on part time basis as visiting teachers. At present around 400 students are enrolled in the Campus.

No Objection Certificate (NoC) to Campus by HEC

The HEC accorded formal recognition of the campus in September 2018. Here it's worth mentioning that nine sub campuses of different universities were set up in Balochistan under this project by the HEC, the Gwadar Campus was the first one which was issued NOC by the HEC and included in the list of recognized campuses of Public Sector Universities of HEC.

Efforts taken by University of Turbat for "Establishment of University of Gwadar"

i. In order to supplement commercial/economic activities under CPEC, the Federal & Provincial Government and HEC have already decided to upgrade the UoT's Sub Campus at Gwadar in to a full-fledged state-of-art university in the future.

ii. Meanwhile, a project titled "Establishment of University of Gwadar" was inaugurated by the then Prime Minister of Pakistan on 1st September 2016.

iii. The Prime Minister of Pakistan during his visit to Gwadar on 6th March 2017 announced to allocate land for the "Establishment of a University at Gwadar".

iv. A project titled "Establishment of University of Gwadar" was reflected in the Federal PSDP (HEC) 2016-17 and PSDP F/Y 2017-18 with a tentative cost of Rs. 500.00 million and Rs. 750.00 million tentatively as an unapproved project.

At the same time, the Federal Government/HEC assigned following tasks to the University of Turbat:

- Preparation of Charter of University of Gwadar.

- Preparation PC-1 of University of Gwadar.
 - Coordination with provincial and local administration for allotment of land for University of Gwadar.
- Operationalization of a Sub Campus of University of Turbat at Gwadar (as foundation of University of Gwadar).

Charter of University of Gwadar

The charter was prepared by UoT's management and submitted to HEC in March 2017. After getting the Charter by the HEC and concerned forums of provincial authorities, the Provincial Assembly has passed the Act of University of Gwadar during November, 2018 vide its notification No. PAB/Legis: V (31)/2018/2117 dated 20th November 2018. The same was also assented by the Governor Balochistan/Chancellor Public Sector Universities (PSUs). The bill was presented by the provincial minister Mr. Zahoor Ahmed Buledi in the Assembly.

Earlier, ex-vice chancellor, University of Turbat Prof Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir along with ex-director Gwadar Campus Mr. Ijaz Ahmed has given a detailed briefing to the CM Balochistan regarding the project of "Establishment of University of Gwadar" on 7th September 2018 at CM secretariat Quetta

PC-I /Feasibility Study of University of Gwadar (PC-II)

On the request of HEC, a PC-I was also prepared by the University of Turbat's management at a cost of Rs. 5.727 (billion) and submitted to HEC during end of the year 2016. Meanwhile a meeting was held in HEC on 29th November 2016 in which it was decided that instead of PC-I, a PC-II should be prepared to conduct the academic feasibility of the University. Accordingly, a separate PC-1 was approved by the CDWP in its meeting held on April 11, 2017, at a cost of Rs.19.699 million for conducting the academic feasibility study of the proposed University. The academic feasibility study has been completed by HEC in April 2018 and submitted to Planning Commission. Upon the request of HEC/Provincial Authorities, a committee chaired by UoT's vice chancellor, Prof. Dr. Jan Muhammad, prepared a revised draft of PC-1 worth Rs. 5,331.717 millions for Establishment of University of Gwadar and submitted to HEC and provincial relevant authorities during May 2021 for further process.

Land for University of Gwadar

The Board of Revenue, Balochistan on 11th September 2018 has transferred a piece of land measuring 500 acres located at Mouza Shahbi, Tehsil and District Gwadar under khasra No.20, 21, in favor of University of Gwadar. However, the UoT took concrete efforts to acquire a piece of land for the city campus of University of Gwadar nearer to city or in education enclave earmarked in newly launched Gwadar Master Plan.

Conclusion

The University of Turbat, as an executing agency for establishment of University of Gwadar, has completed its all tasks assigned by HEC/Federal Government well in time. Finally, the UoT's Gwadar Campus was converted into the University of Gwadar on 25th October, 2021, thanks to the personal interest of the Governor Balochistan, Syed Zahoor Ahmed Agha and efforts taken by the University of Turbat, HEC, federal & provincial government, public representatives, parliamentarians, politicians, local leadership, civil society and students.

Introduction

The University of Turbat (UoT) in its endeavor to fulfill its charter obligation to disseminate knowledge and to ensure access to Higher Education to all students so that deserving students are not deprived access to quality education has established its campus at Panjgur, Balochistan.

Establishment of the University of Turbat's Sub Campus at Panjgur has been approved by the entire statutory bodies of the University of Turbat. The Academic Council of UoT in its meeting held on 7th February, 2019 and Finance and Planning Committee of the University of Turbat in its meeting held on 14th February, 2019, Syndicate in its meeting held on 4th March 2019 recommended the proposal of establishment of Panjgur campus. Finally during UoT's 4th meeting of Senate held on 8th April, 2019, chaired by the then H.E Justice (R) Amanullah Khan Yasinzai Governor Balochistan/Chancellor UoT approved the proposal of establishment of a Sub Campus of University of Turbat at Panjgur.

The academic activities at Panjgur Campus were started on 15th September 2020 after fulfilling all legal formalities and pre-requisites. Chief Minister Balochistan Jam Mir Kamal Khan Alyani along with Provincial Minister Mir Assad and cabinet members Baloch formally inaugurated the UoT- Panjgur Campus on 8th October 2020.

After completion of entire required formalities, visit of the HEC Accreditation/Inspection Committee on 15th December 2020, the University of Turbat-Panjgur was recognized by the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan as a Public sector University Campus.

The main objective of establishing this university Campus is the provision of quality higher education to the students of district Panjgur and its adjacent districts to develop the human resource for taking active and leading part in elevating the socio-economic indicators of province and country.

The Campus building comprises of all facilities for learning including academic block, class rooms, lecture theaters, conference hall, Computer labs, multipurpose hall, Botanical lab, Cafeteria, Student facilitation Centre, Bachelors Hostels, Central Library, and boy's hostel.

Presently, BS Programs are being offered in Campus in which there are seven (07) programs offered in four (04) different departments (Computer Science, Botany, English, and Education) at Panjgur Campus. The campus has enrolled two batches and has around 500 students with 20 high qualified faculty members providing quality education and enhancing entrepreneurial skills of the students. The Panjgur Campus of the University has the potential to be declared as a full-fledged University as its act has recently been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Balochistan.
