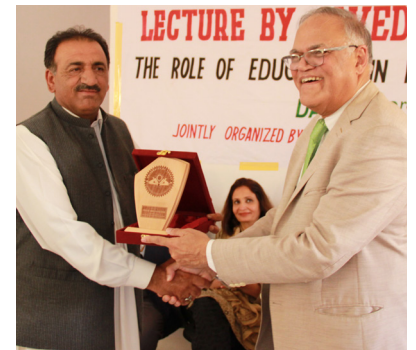
## Students of UoT Main Campus and Gwadar Campus receive laptops

In versifying the landscape, Atta Shad universalized his poetry by expanding the horizons of Balochistan.

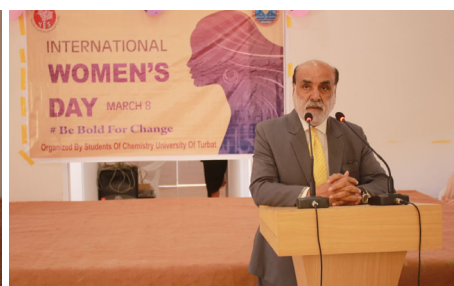
## Justice Hashim Khan Kakar visits School of Law UoT
