Governor Balochistan Inaugurates Solar Project And Data Center At UoT

Governor Balochistan/Chancellor Public Sector Universities, Malik Abdul Wali Khan Kakar, paid a visit to the Turbat University (UoT) here on 8th May 2023. He was warmly welcomed by the university's Vice-Chancellor and his team. Besides, inaugurating the first phase of the 1,000-kilowatt solar project, and data center, Governor Balochistan also planted a sapling at the university.

During his interaction with the faculty members and administrative staff, Malik Abdul Wali Khan Kakar said that if we do not pay serious attention to all the public sector universities in Balochistan to generate their own resources and make them financially self-sufficient, it would be difficult to run all the higher education institutions of the province in the coming years.

During interaction with students, he urged the male and female students of the UoT to use all their hidden abilities to acquire modern education and bring positive change in society. In their welcome remarks, Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Jan Muhammad, and other officials of UoT briefed the Governor about the university's project, academic, and infrastructure growth of the University during the last ten years. VC informed him that multiple projects worth Rs. 2 billion are being executed at the university, and the completion of these projects would help to solve the problems of the university and open new academic programs.

In the end, Vice Chancellor presented souvenirs, paintings, and Balochi Chadir to the Governor of Balochistan and other guests.

His research focuses on chloroplast DNA sequences and genetic information on four date varieties, namely Begum Jangi, Aleeni, Shakar, and Mozathi.

Department Of Natural And Basic Sciences Workshop Sheds Light On Biosecurity

A two days' workshop on "Biosafety and Biosecurity Practices: Emphasis on Personal Safety of a Lab Biologist" organized by the Department of Natural and Basic Sciences (NABS), University of Turbat (UoT) in collaboration with Pakistan Biological Safety Association (PBSA) at UoT, has concluded here on 3rd March 2023. The workshop was aimed at creating awareness regarding theoretical and practical aspects of biosafety and biosecurity, safety measures for protecting laboratory workers, public and environment from potentially hazardous biological agents.


