
Justice (R) Ammanullah Khan Yasinzai sworn in as Governor Balochistan

VC UoT Prof Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir, on 7th September 2018 has given detailed briefing to the CM Balochistan regarding Gwadar University Project saying, feasibility report regarding the project has been prepared, PC1 will be prepared after approval of the project from Cabinet and assembly and allotting land for the University.

Secretary Higher Education Balochistan Abdullah Jan, SMBR Shoaib Gola and Director Gwadar Campus Ijaz Ahmed were also present at this occasion.
