## Governor of Balochistan Assures to Address Key University Challenges

**Prof. Dr. Gul Hasan, Vice Chancellor of the UoT, called on the Hon'ble Governor Balochistan.**

Prof. Dr. Gul Hasan, Vice Chancellor of the University of Turbat (UoT), called on the Hon'ble Governor Balochistan and Chancellor of Public Sector Universities Sheikh Jaffar Khan Mandokhail, and discussed various matters pertaining to higher education, including financial issues, revised formula of funds distribution among provincial

universities, and rescheduling of university convocation. The Vice Chancellor extended his gratitude to the Governor Balochistan for his keen interest in resolving the issues and challenges the provincial universities face. The Vice Chancellor of the University of Makran, Panjgur, Prof. Dr. Mumtaz Baloch, was present on the occasion.



## Governor Balochistan Chairs Meeting of University Vice-Chancellors

The Governor of Balochistan, Sheikh Jaffar Khan Mandokhail, chaired a meeting of Vice Chancellors and Pro Vice Chancellors from various universities in Balochistan at the Governor House, Quetta, on May 19, 2025. During the meeting, the Governor urged universities to provide quality education, promote skill-based learning and field research, and focus on market-driven disciplines. He also announced that the second Vice Chancellors' Conference would be held at the Governor House shortly after Eid-

The participants urged the government to immediately withdraw the decision, considering the specific socio-economic needs of the province. The Vice Chancellor assured that their concerns would be conveyed to the relevant authorities and encouraged all stakeholders to seek resolution through legal and constitutional means.

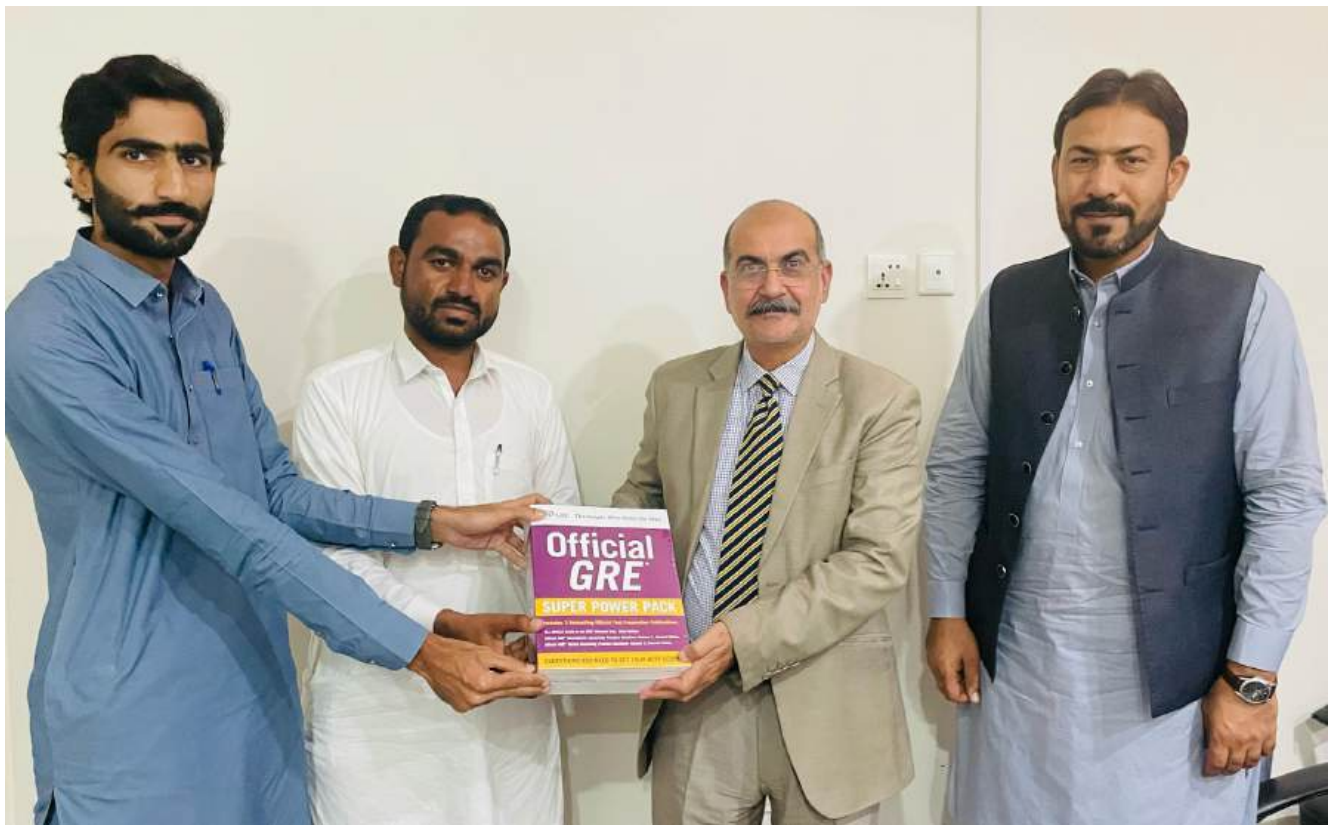
